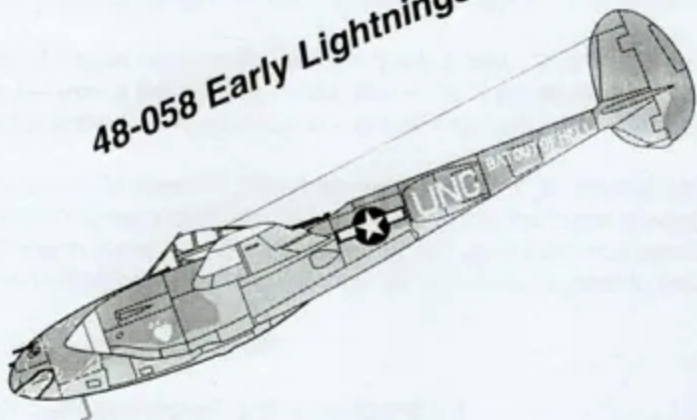

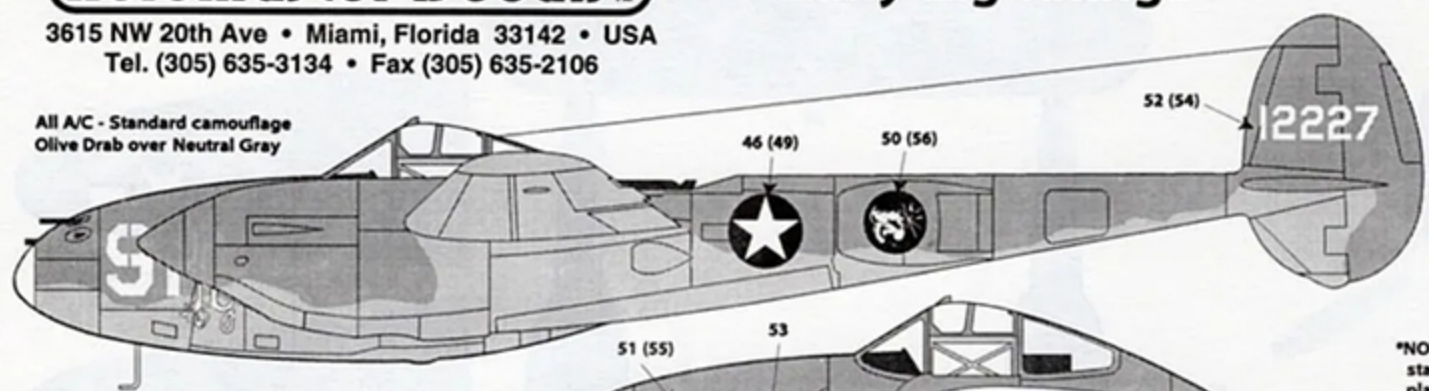

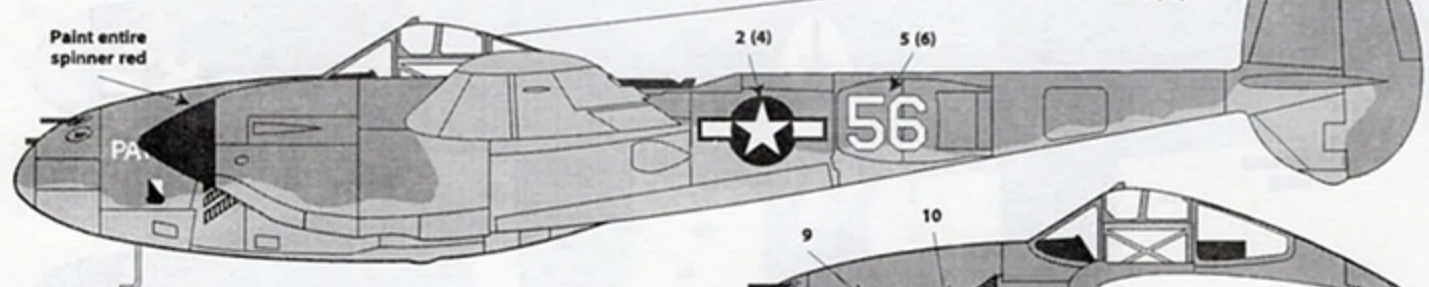

Spring 1943

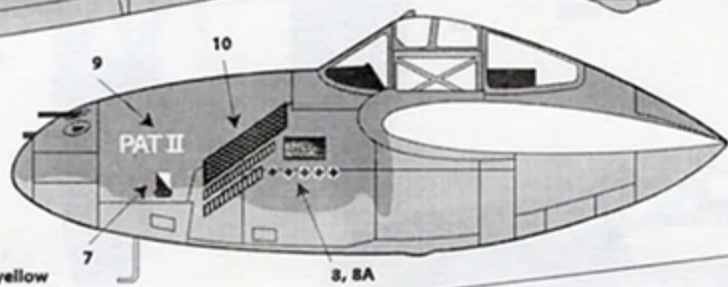


Paint entire spinner red

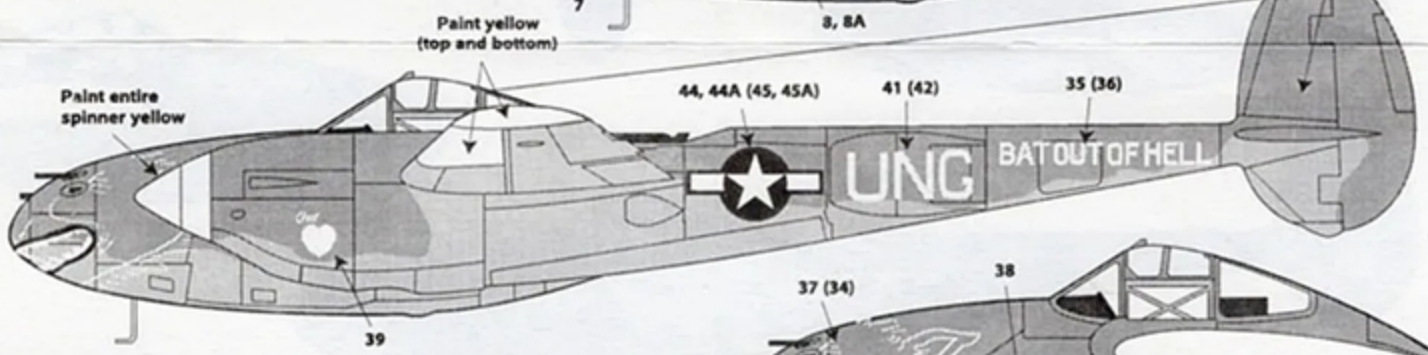


Inner vertical stabilizer decal(s)

April 1944



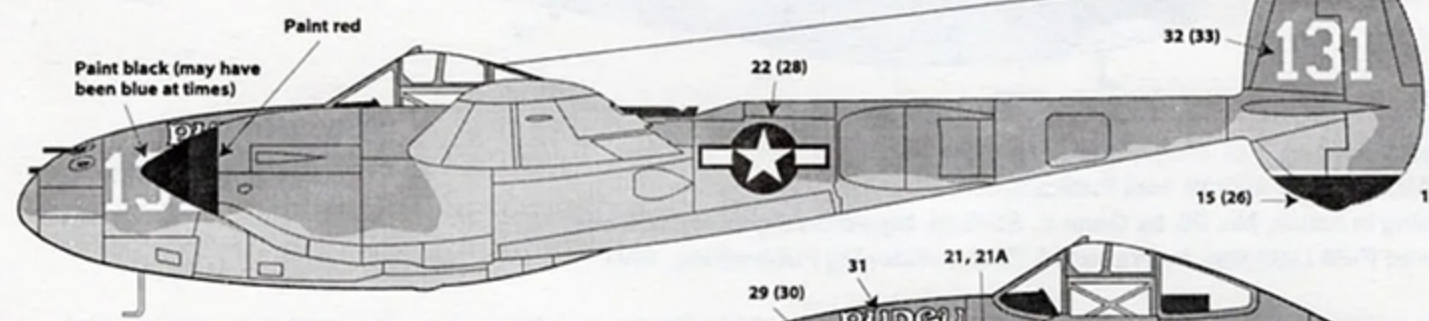
Serial number covered by extensive exhaust staining.

Sardinia 1943

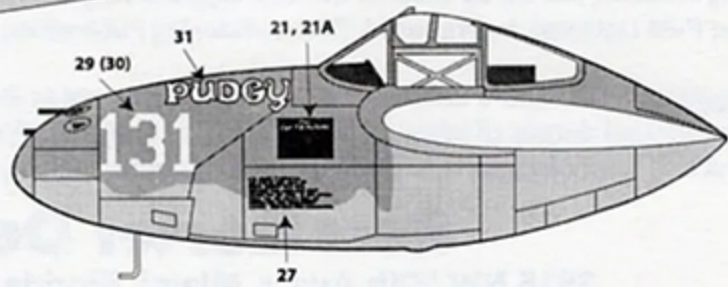
Slit decals 37 (34) & trim to fit. Excess film may need to be trimmed away.

Paint black (may have been blue at times)

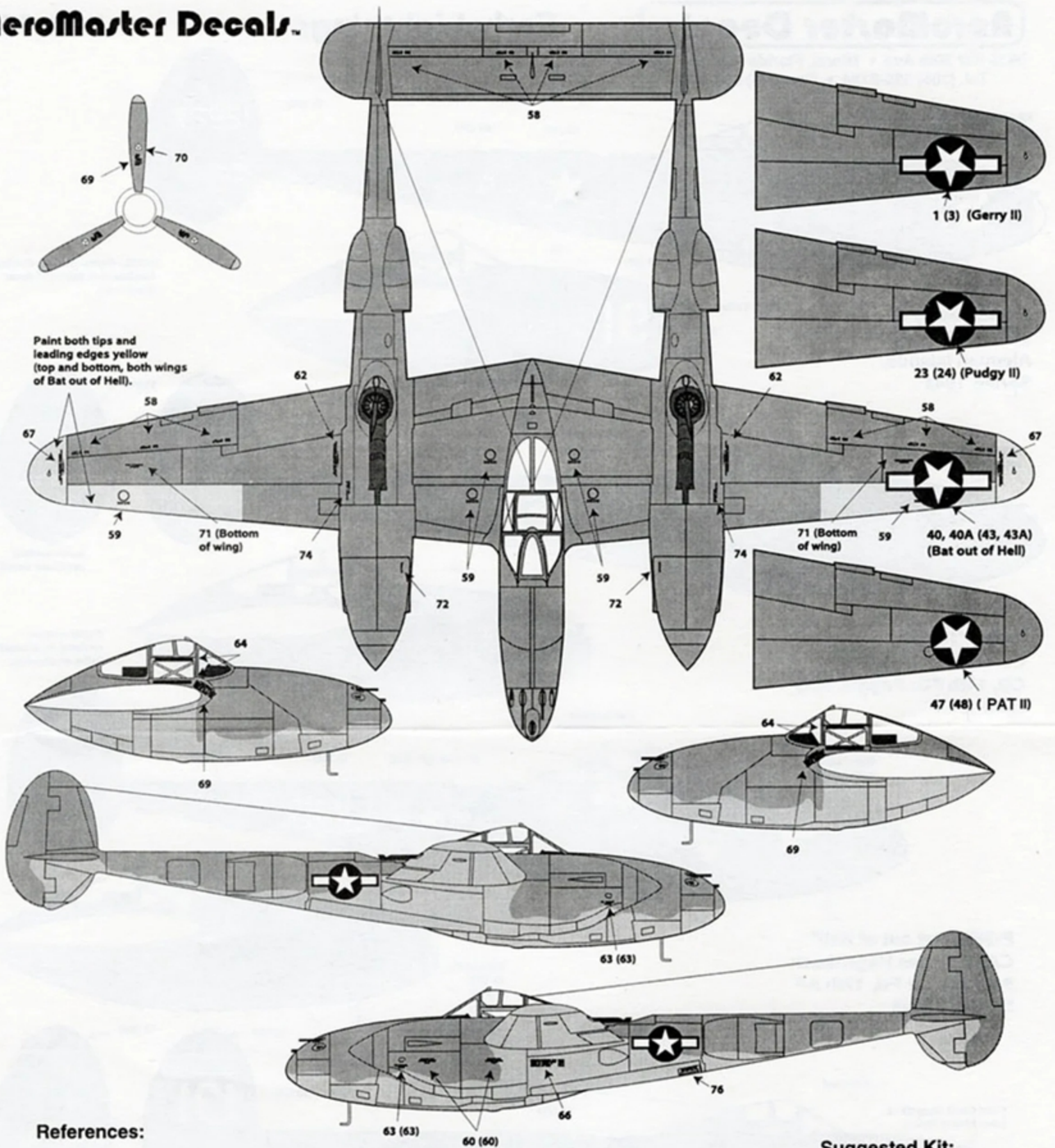


Inner vertical stabilizer decal(s)
