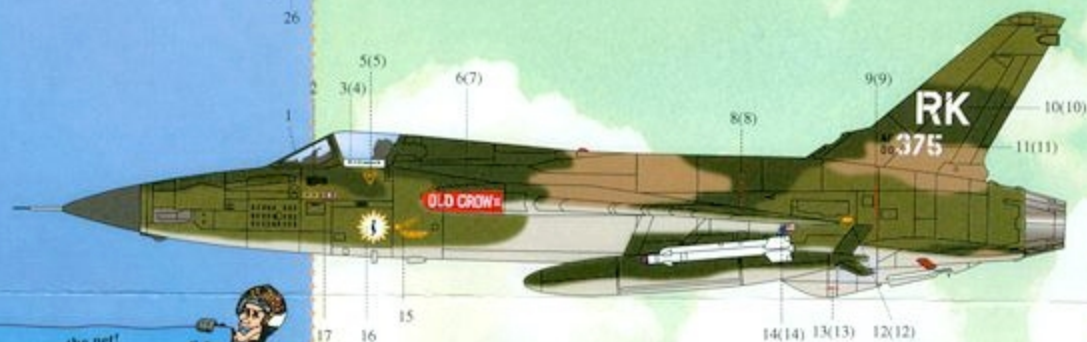
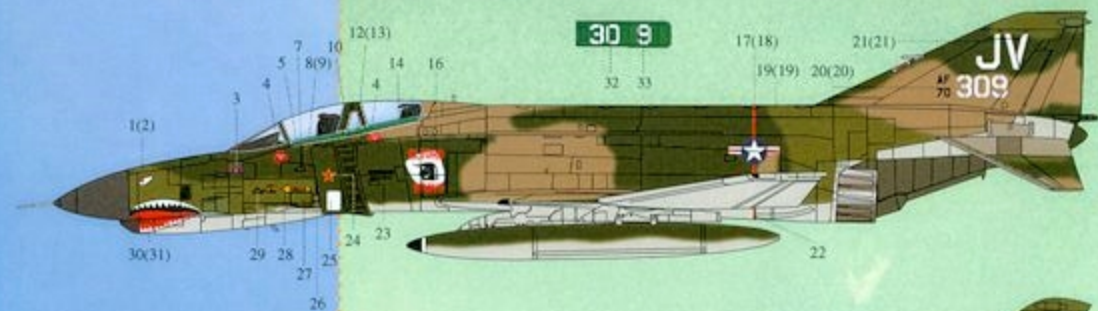

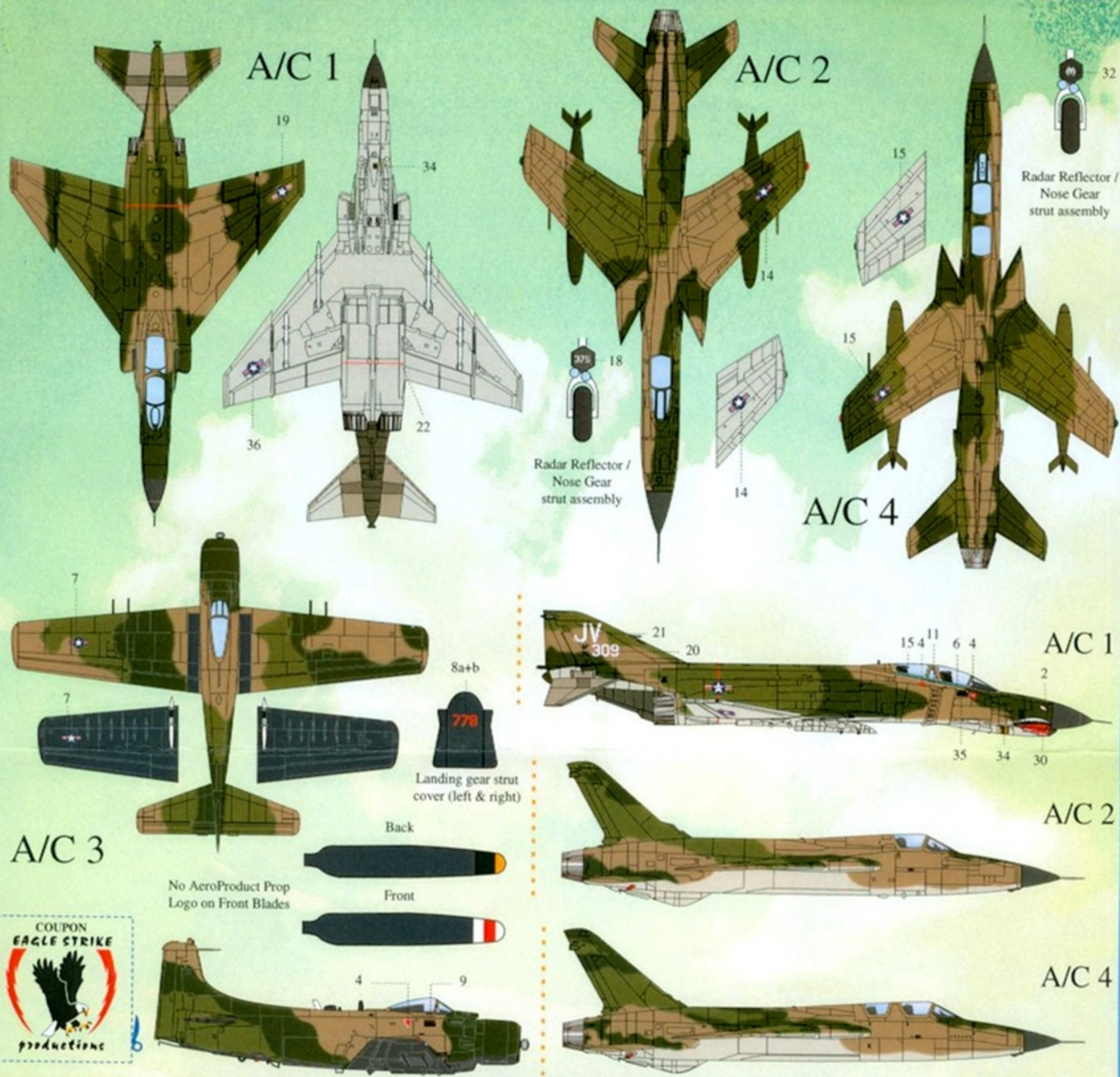
Notice the numerous antennas and beacons to be added to the A-1H kit.

**AIRCRAFT 1** F-4E-35-MC Phantom 67-309 El Toro Bravo, flown by Lt/Col Erickson (Pilot) and Lt Williams (WSO). Assigned to the 469th TFS, 388th TFW at Korat in April of 1970. Standard SEA camouflage with PUC and AFOUA ribbons on the left nose. A MiG kill with a White detail placard was applied to the left inlet ramp. Aircrew names were applied on the left side canopy frames, ground crew names on the right side. The "last three" of the serial were painted in White on the Green interior nose bay door. Borderless national insignia on all uppersurfaces and full Red turbine warning stripe.

#### AIRCRAFT 1

*Kit Modifications for Early F-4E:*

1. Short Gun Gas Diffuser
2. No Wing Slats
3. No Formation Light Panels
4. No Triangular Braces on Upper Horizontal Tails

*Kits:* Hasegawa F-4E converted to early F-4-E.

F-4 Stencils (AMD Decal # 148-018; temporarily out of stock).

**NOTE:** Borderless National Insignia were applied to all upper surfaces at the factory. These were replaced with bordered insignia when the aircraft was repainted at the depot.

**AIRCRAFT 2** "Old Crow II", F-105D # 60-0375, flown by Colonel Clarence Anderson, CO of 355th Tactical Fighter Wing, Takhli, 1970.

**AIRCRAFT 3** "Bubbles 'n Bust", A-1H, Serial #39778. 602nd Special Operations Squadron, Nakhon Phanom, March 1970. SEA camouflage, underside overpainted black. Aircraft carried no national insignia. Note white cowl ring and mismatched cowl flaps. Aircraft was also fitted at one time with Green 34102 cowl ring and flaps. This aircraft carried no national insignias.

**AIRCRAFT 4** "Tough Cookie/Jefferson Aireplane/Half a yard", F-105G #63-8302. 44th Tactical Fighter Squadron, 355th Tactical Fighter Wing. Based at Takhli, after unit transfer from Korat in 1968.

#### AIRCRAFT 2 & 4

*Kits:* Monogram F-105D/F/G.

**NOTE:** The fin tips on F 105's were mostly painted light gray. However, some camouflaged A/C had them painted the same surrounding color, which was Dk. Green. We do not have a clear picture of the fin tip of these aircraft.

#### AIRCRAFT 3

*Kits:* Tamiya/Monogram/ESCI A-1H.
