## **TURKISH CURRENT A310**

SHEET: FP20-184

**RECOMMENDED KIT:** Revell in 1/144. Braz or the various display models in 1/200. These aircraft are powered by GE CF6 engines. Note that two complete models can be made from this one sheet.

<u>PAINTING:</u> Refer to the photographs for complete marking information. Paint the entire fuselage white. When using the white fin logos, paint the fin bright red (two white logos are provided for each side for increased opacity). The wings and tailplanes appear in the standard light gray and natural metal patterns (please note that wing and tailplane center section decals for the A310 are available from Flightpath as FP44-132). The engines are white, with a natural metal lip and burnt metal exhausts. The pylons are light gray.

**DECAL APPLICATION:** Note that the old version featured "THY TURKISH AIRLINES" titling, while the current version features larger "TURKISH" titling only. Pay close attention to window location and spacing when applying the fuselage titles. The double-letter fleet number is positioned on the rear portion of the nose gear doors. The large wing registration should be positioned on the lower left wing. With regard to the flag, the half-moon faces towards the rear and is positioned forward of the titles on the old scheme, and to the rear of the titles on the current scheme. The aircraft names are centered on the nose, just below the windshield. Note the "Airbus A310" titling on the forward fuselage. This decal sheet possesses a constant clear. Therefore, cut each piece out individually before soaking in water.

REGISTRATION NUMBERS: The following registration numbers are all A310s: TC-JCL / SEYHAN, TC-JCM / CEYHAN, TC-JCN / DICLE, TC-JCO / FIRAT, TC-JCR / KIZILIRMAK, TC-JCS / YESILIRMAK, TC-JCU / SAKARYA, TC-JCV / ARAS, TC-JCY / CORUH, TC-JCZ / ERGENE, TC-JDA / AKSU, TC-JDB / GOKSU, TC-JDC / MERIC, and TC-JDD / DALAMAN.
