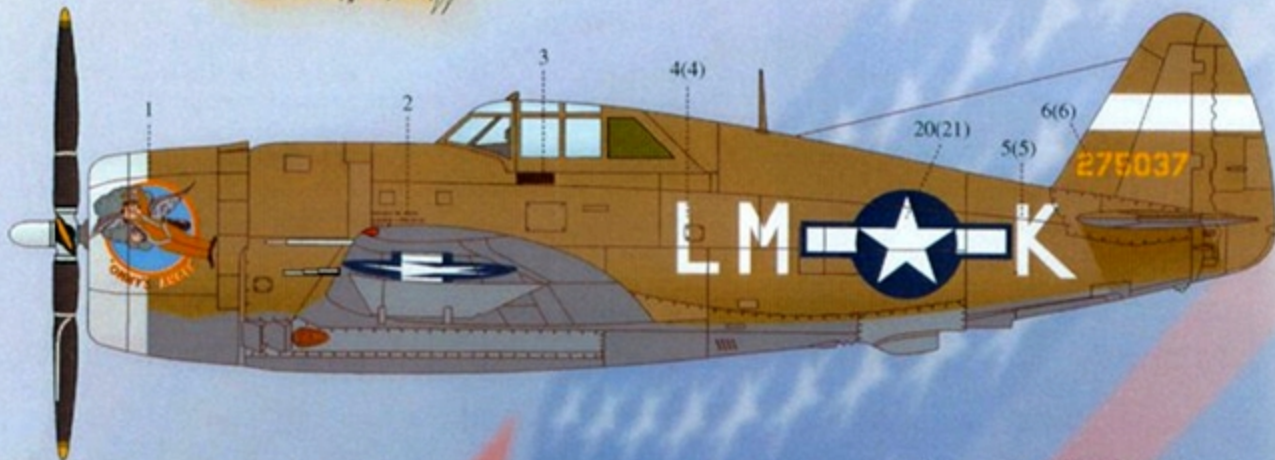


Suggested Kit: Hasegawa/Tamiya P-47 Family.

The 56 F.G. in W.W.II Pt. V

Aircraft 1 - P-47D-10-RE 'Onny's Angel' flown by Lt. Wilbur N. Kelly, 62nd FS, 56th FG. Standard Olive Drab uppersurfaces, Neutral Gray undersides. White Cowl and theatre bands. NMF propeller boss. C. E. 13' 1" asymmetrical propellers.



Note: A/C 2 & 3 use the C.E. symmetrical 13'prop.



Aircraft 2 - P-47M-1-RE 'Lookin' fer Trouble' flown by Lt. Edger Huff, 63rd FS, 56th FG. Azure Blue? and Insignia Blue uppersurfaces, NMF lower surfaces with NMF leading edges. Medium Blue rudder. Red cowl. NMF canopy frame.

Decal 11 (data block) is applied to left fuselage - refer to position shown on A/C 1.

AIRCRAFT 3 - "Anamosa 2", P-47D-25RE #42-28466. Flown by Lt. Russ Westfall, 63rd Fighter Squadron, 56th Fighter Group, Late Summer 1944. Aircraft is Medium Green 42 or British Dk Green on upper surfaces, natural metal underneath. Note Olive Drab anti-glare panel and over painting of upper invasion stripes. Also note chipped Red paint on nose.



Note:
Underwing invasion stripes may have been removed at this time and corresponding upper wing areas could also have been over painted OD.

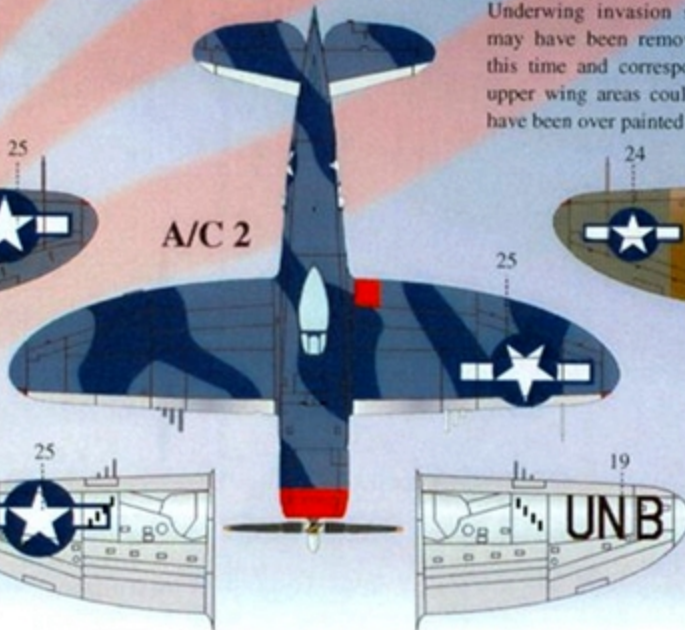
