




TBM-1C, VT-7, USS HANCOCK (CV-19). Tri color scheme consisting of Non-Specular Sea Blue upper surfaces, Intermediate Blue on the vertical surfaces and Insignia White on the lower surfaces. Note fresh patch of Intermediate Blue. Also note White prop boss.







TBM-1C, VT-18, USS INTREPID, October 1944. This Avenger was painted Non-Specular Sea Blue on the upper surfaces, intermediate Blue on the vertical surfaces and Insignia White on the lower surfaces. The 'NAVY' and Serial Number on the vertical stabilizer may have been re-applied on top of the White 'plus' symbol.

TBM-1C, VC-76, USS PETROF BAY(CVE-80), January 30th, 1945. The standard tri color scheme was applied to this Avenger.







TBM-3 of VC-88, USS SAGINAW BAY (CVE-82), March 1945. Tri color scheme with the vertical stabilizer above the horizontal stabilizer painted Glossy Sea Blue. Note light patch of paint on fuselage, possibly covering a previous tactical number. A dark patch appears between the port wing root and cowl flaps, possibly fresh paint covering exhaust staining. Prop boss seams to be White.


TBM-1C, VT-20, USS ENTERPRISE (CV-6), October 25, 1944. The standard tri color paint scheme was applied to this aircraft.

TBM-3E of VT-34, USS MONTEREY (CVL-26), August 29, 1945. Overall Glossy Sea Blue with a Non-Specular Sea Blue replacement panel on foward fuselage. No photo of the port side of the aircraft was available, so placement of pin-up and kill markings is not known. Several extras, both handed and un-handed, of each are supplied. Prop boss is gloss Sea blue.
