






Suggested Kit: 1/48 DML/Dragon Fokker D VII.







Fokker D. VII(OAW). S/N 4499/18. Flown by Franz Mayer. The wings of this A/C of the Marine Fighter Unit III (MFJ III), was covered with a four color lozenge fabric and featured a White fuselage striped in Black, with Yellow forward nose section and horizontal stabilizers. Notice the 3 Black sections on the elevators (upper & lower). Gray/ Green machine gun upper deck panel. Engine side covers shown Gray on our drawings are removed, showing the cilynders and exhaust headers (not illustrated).

Fokker D. VII F, flown by VzFw Wilhelm Hippert, of Jasta 73, 1918. Four color lozenge fabric covered the wings of this fabulously decorated aircraft. Black & White chequered fuselage and empenage, with Dk. Blue nose, wheel covers and wing struts complete the decoration!

Notice the four little Black stars on the wheel covers, orientation is unknown. Upper deck machine gun panel seems to be also Dk. Blue.

Paint fuselage Gloss White with the Dk. Blue areas of the forward section. Begin decaling the left fuselage side. Allow to dry. Repeat the operation with the right side, making sure the checkers align properly, otherwise you will have problems later. Do the top and bottom fuselage and stabilizers. Now, continue as you would with any other model.
