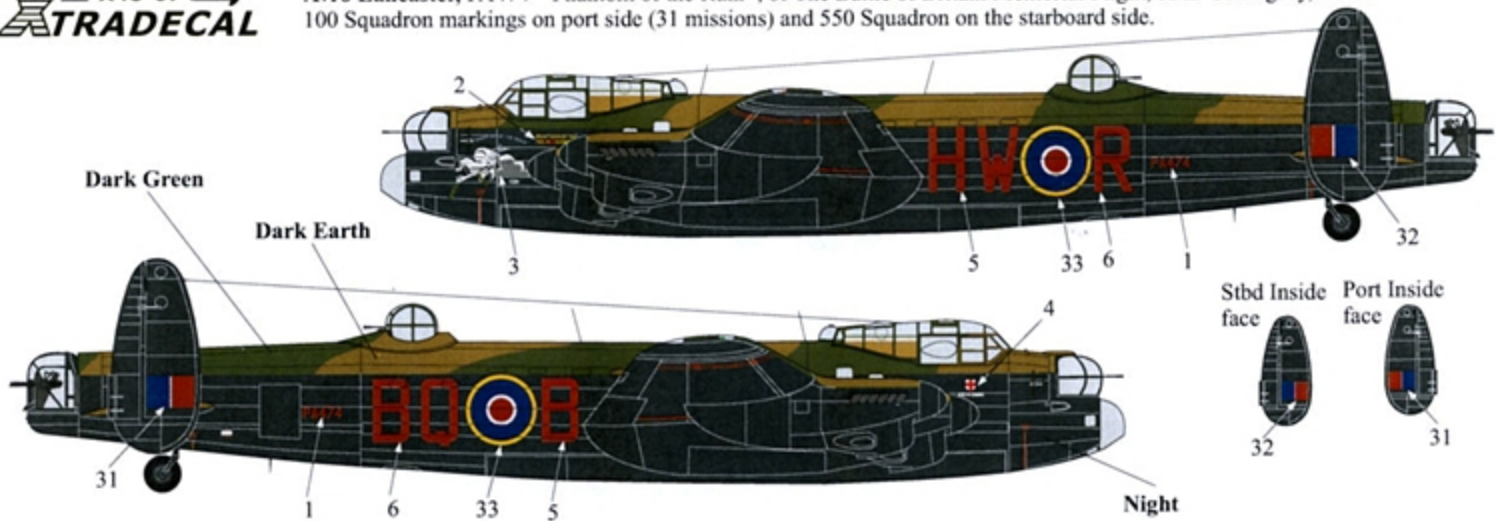

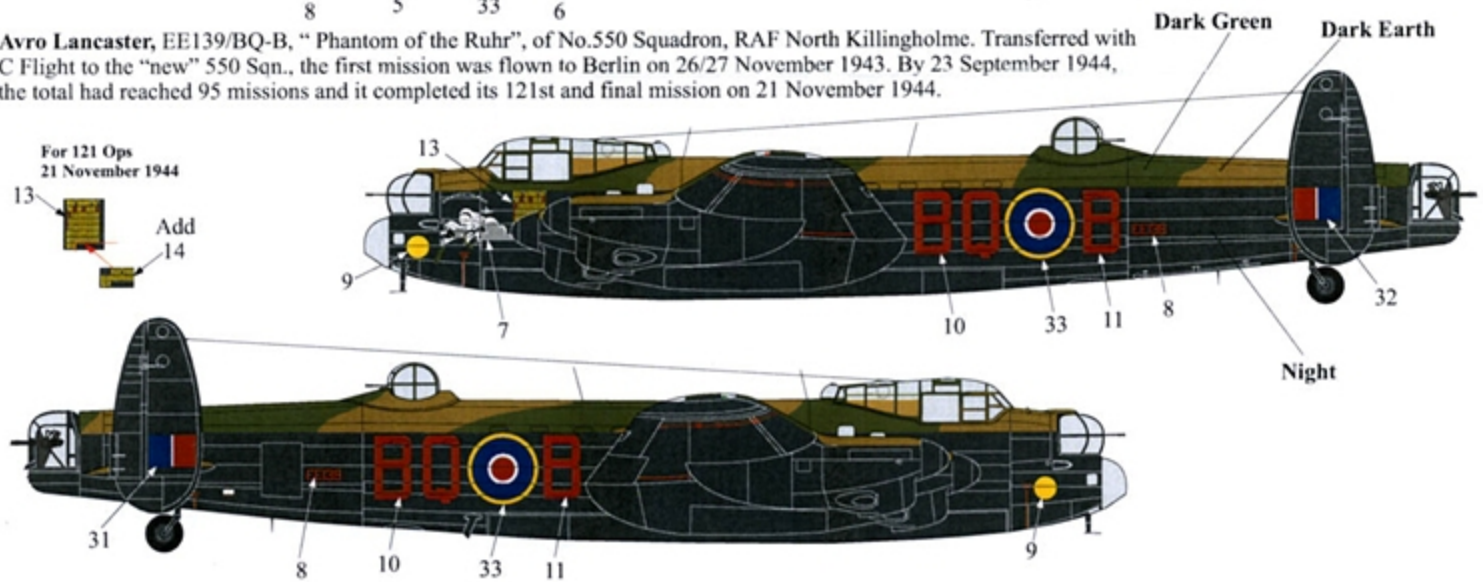

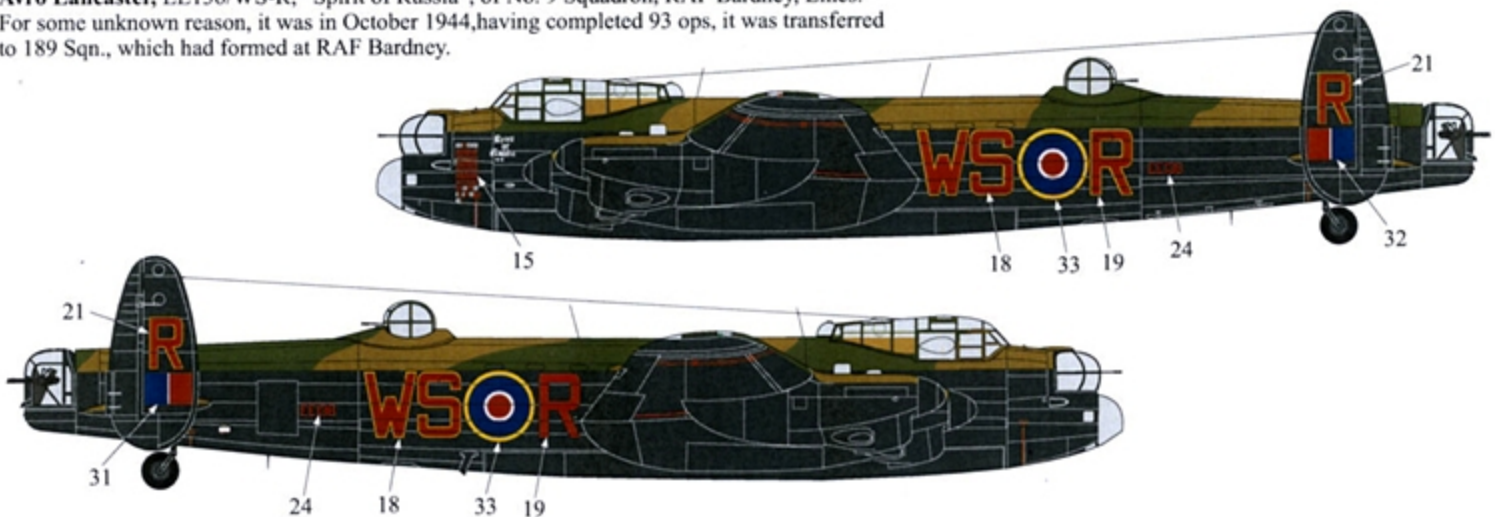
Avro Lancaster, EE139/HW-R, "Phantom of the Ruhr", of No.100 Squadron, RAF Waltham, Nr.Grimbsy. After its 31st mission to Berlin on 24 November 1943, it was transferred to 550 Sqn(formerly C Flight).



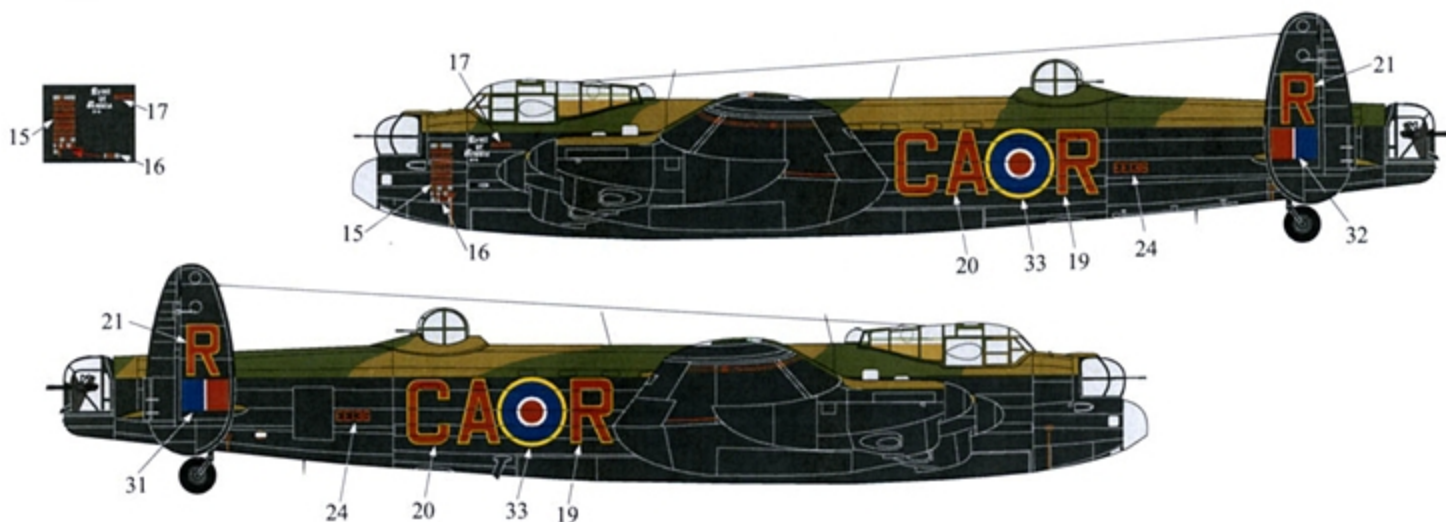
Avro Lancaster, EE139/BQ-B, "Phantom of the Ruhr", of No.550 Squadron, RAF North Killingholme. Transferred with C Flight to the "new" 550 Sqn., the first mission was flown to Berlin on 26/27 November 1943. By 23 September 1944, the total had reached 95 missions and it completed its 121st and final mission on 21 November 1944.



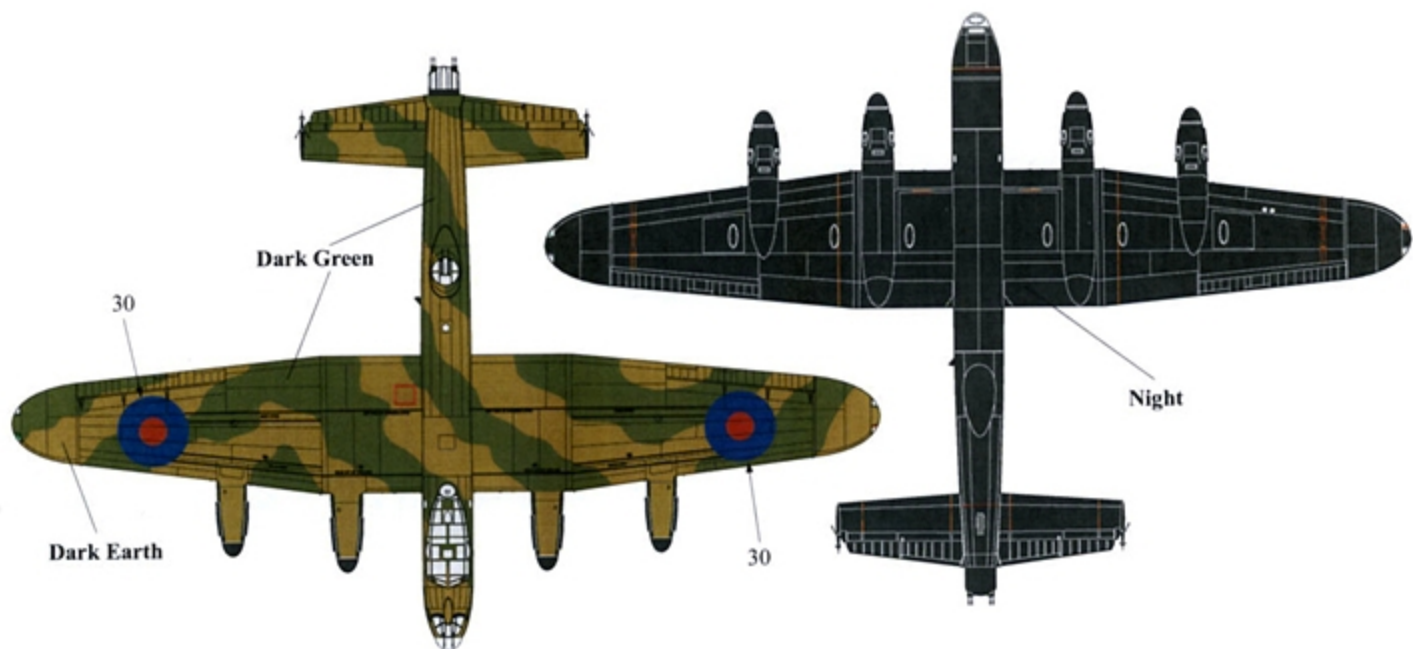
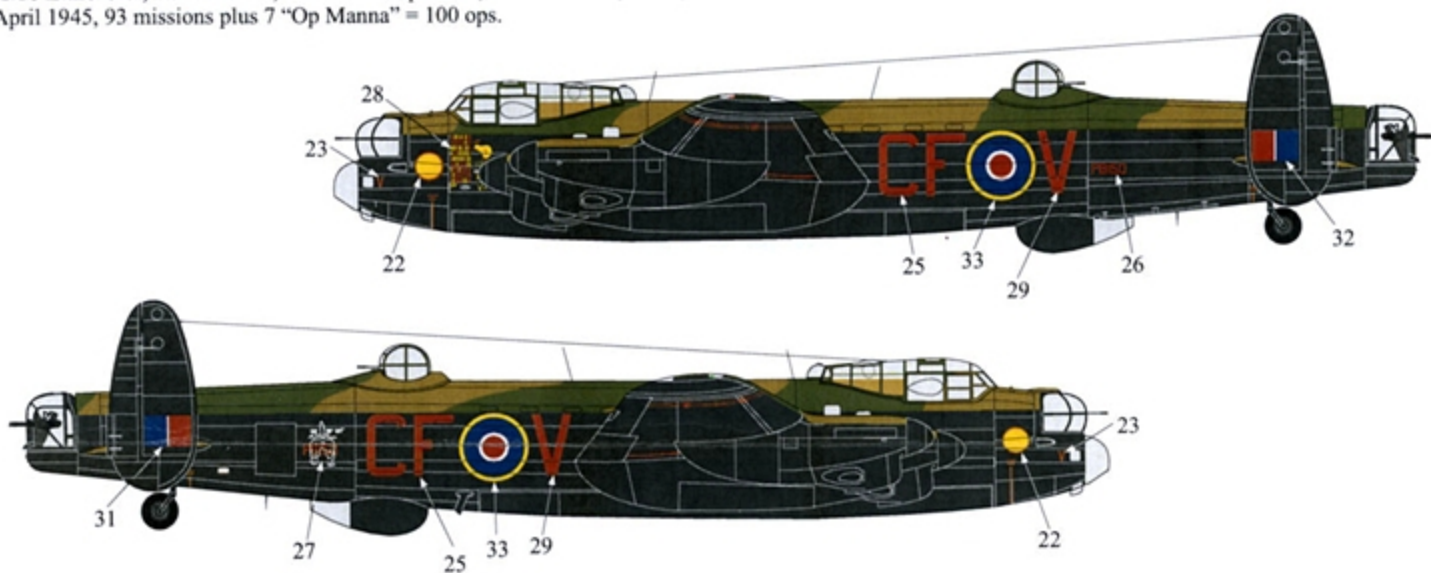
Avro Lancaster, EE136/WS-R, "Spirit of Russia", of No. 9 Squadron, RAF Bardney, Lincs. For some unknown reason, it was in October 1944, having completed 93 ops, it was transferred to 189 Sqn., which had formed at RAF Bardney.



Avro Lancaster, EE136/CA-R, "Spirit of Russia", of No. 189 Squadron, RAF Bardney, later RAF Fulbeck, Lincs.
 Transferred from No. 9 Sqn., in October 1944, it flew a further 16 ops by February 1945, bring the total to 109 ops.



Avro Lancaster, PB150/CF-V, of No. 625 Squadron, RAF Kelstern, Lincs,
 April 1945, 93 missions plus 7 "Op Manna" = 100 ops.
