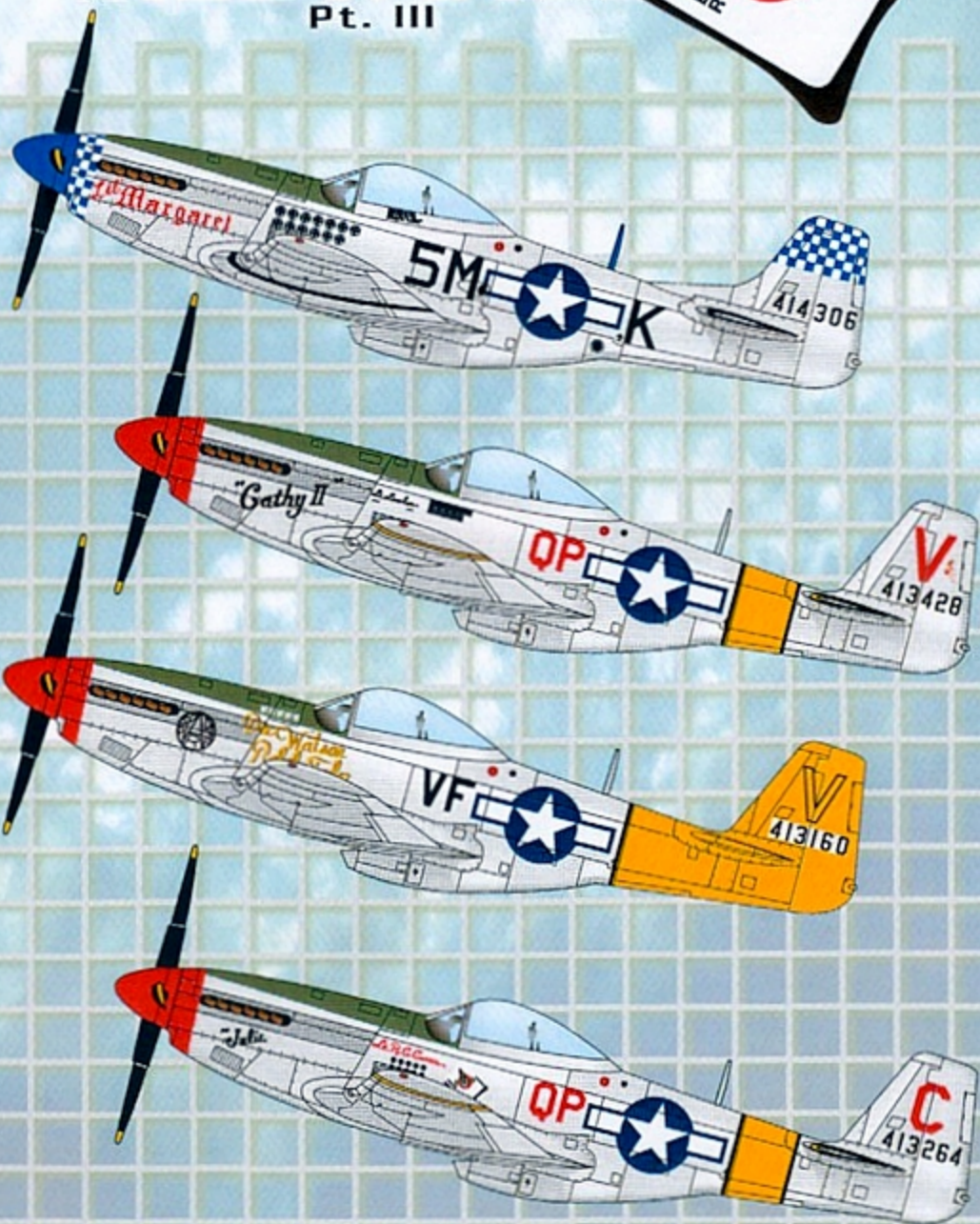

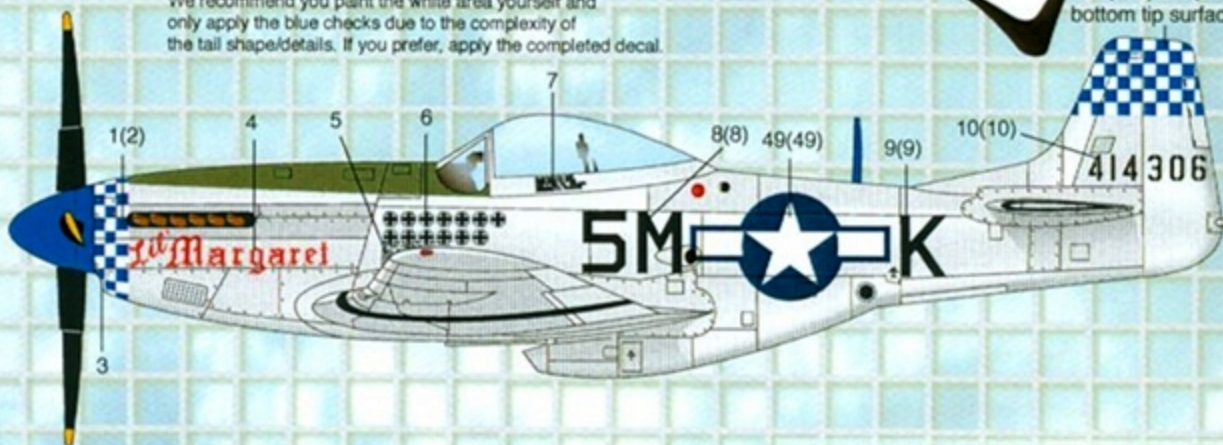


Suggested Kit: Tamiya P-51 Family.

"Lil Margaret" was assigned to Capt. Clyde B. East, and was named after his wife. The a/c, as presented here, is in the final stage of its ever changing artwork. Capt East, with 13 confirmed aerial victories, was the USAAF's highest scoring recce Ace in the ETO.



We recommend you paint the white area yourself and only apply the blue checks due to the complexity of the tail shape/details. If you prefer, apply the completed decal.



"Cathy II" was assigned to Captain Barry Lawler. With 11-2-3 aerial victories, Capt. Lawler was in third place for the Group's scoring honors.

"Spareparts" was assigned to Lt. Col. Ralph "Doc" Watson. The origin of the a/c name is unknown. Watson was another of the group's Aces and finished the war with 5-1-3 aerial victories. Three of his victories were scored in P-38's.



No data block was on this aircraft at this time.



"Julie" was assigned to Major Robert C. Curtiss, CO of the 2 FS, 52 FG. and was named after his younger sister. Major Curtiss ended his tour of duty with 14-1-5 aerial victories. After his departure, "Julie" was converted into a two seater and retained all of his personal markings, except the code was changed to QP\*?
