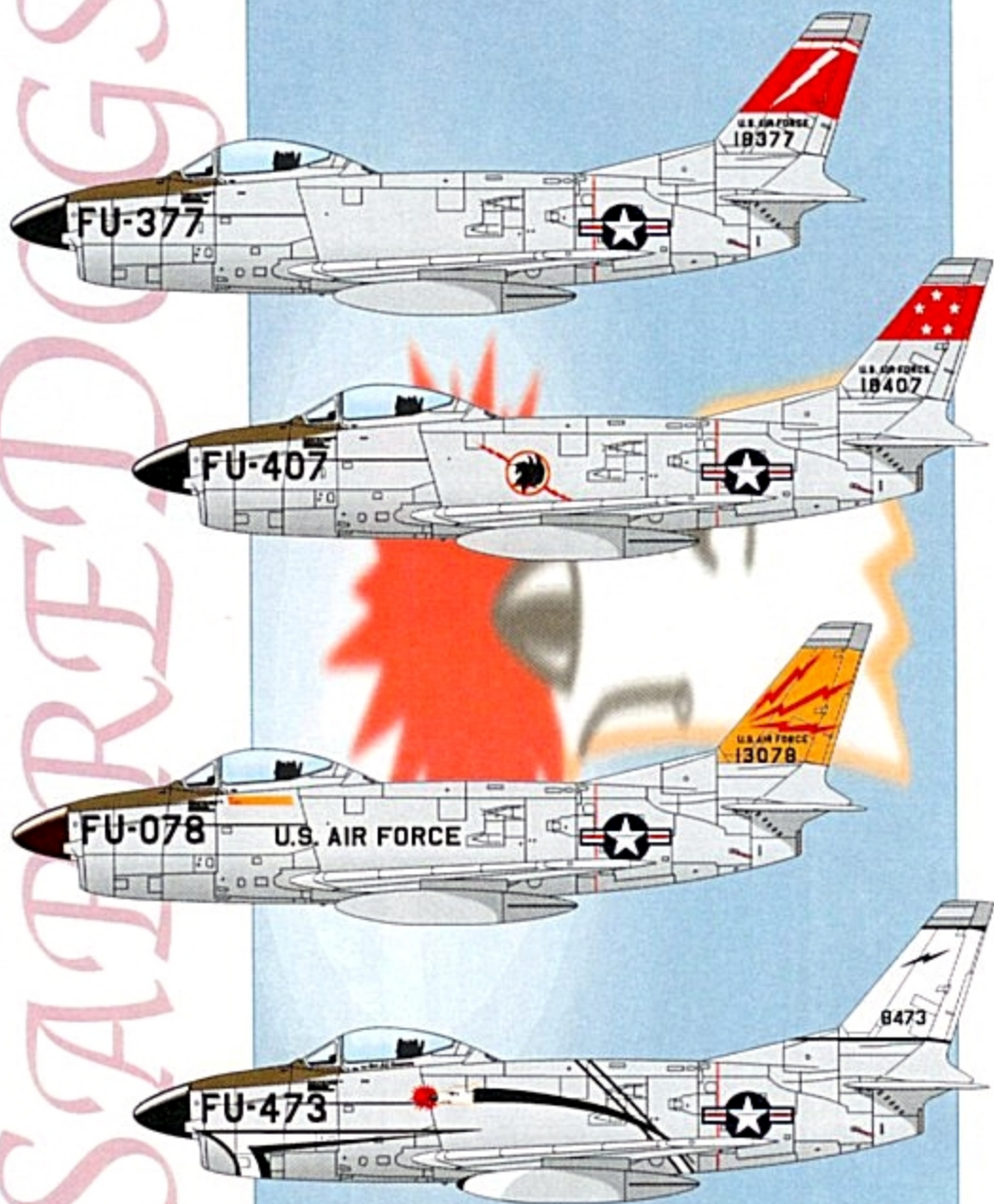

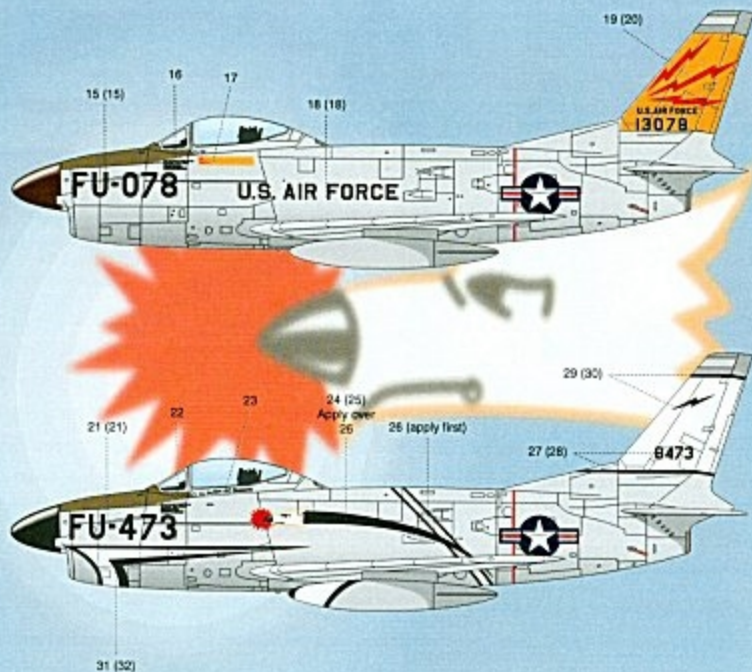
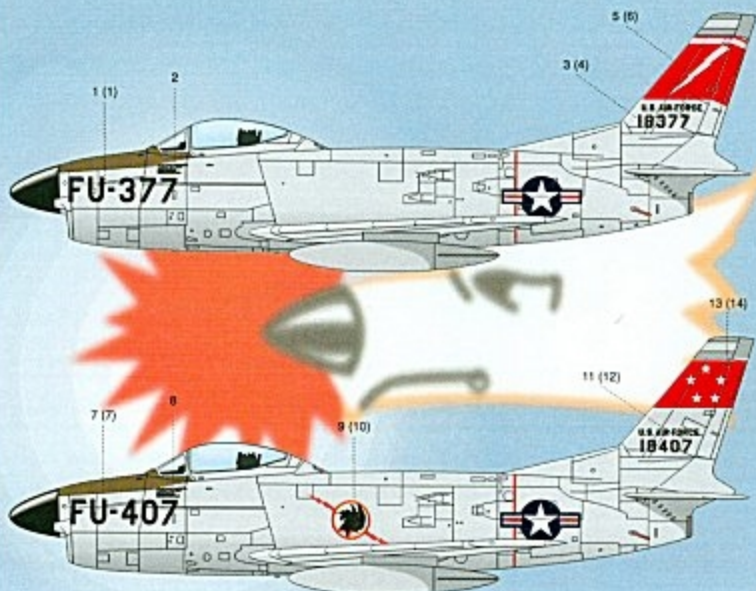
F-86D SABRE DOGS

A/C Type	F-86D-35-NA
Pilot & Unit	86th FIS, 14706th ADW
Locale & Date	Youngstown, Ohio
Camouflage & Markings	Natural metal finish overall with various gray panels. Olive Drab anti-glare panel. Semi-gloss Black radome.

After painting fuselage, nose gear door and airbrakes, place the opening section of the airbrake and doors over the cavities. They will stay in place. Then apply the fuselage insignia and nose flash over them. With a NEW # 11 knife, trim around the airbrake and doors. Separate them. Apply SOL solution to both edges to smooth out any left overs. This is the best way we have found to go around these features.

Camouflage & Markings	Natural metal finish overall with various gray panels. Olive Drab anti-glare panel. Semi-gloss Black radome.



A/C Type	F-86D-20-NA
Pilot & Unit	465th FIS, 567th ADG
Locale & Date	1953
Camouflage & Markings	Natural metal finish overall with various gray panels. Olive Drab anti-glare panel. Very weathered-gloss Black or matt Brown radome. Modeler must paint fin and rudder Yellow prior to applying decals 19 and 20.

Notice fin tips on all these A/C are Lt. Gray, in a specific pattern, not just the fin cap.
