

Camouflage & Markings Natural Metal overall with Olive Drab anti-glare panel, D-Day stripes on lower fuselage and under wings, Black ETO ID bands on vertical and horizontal tail surfaces. Red fin cap, nose band, and prop hub. Early 12' Curtis Electric prop. Note rear view mirror.



Locale & Date Reims, France (A-27) August 1944.

Camouflage & Markings Natural Metal overall with Olive Drab anti-glare panel, D-Day stripes on lower fuselage and under wings, Black ETO ID bands on vertical and horizontal tail surfaces. Black ETO ID bands on vertical and horizontal tail surfaces. Red nose band and tip of vertical tail. 13' Curtis Electric Asymmetric prop.



A/C Type P-47D-28-RE Thunderbolt 44-28413.

Pilot & Unit 2Lt Eugene Martin, 379th FS, 362nd FG.

Locale & Date Reims, France (A-32) in early 1945.

Camouflage & Markings Natural Metal overall with Olive Drab anti-glare panel. Black ETO ID bands on vertical and horizontal tail surfaces. Yellow cowls, prop hub, and diamonds on cow flaps. Wheel hubs may have also been yellow. Tip of vertical tail painted red. Note reversed swastikas. Nose dorsal fin. 13' Curtis Electric Asymmetric prop.
