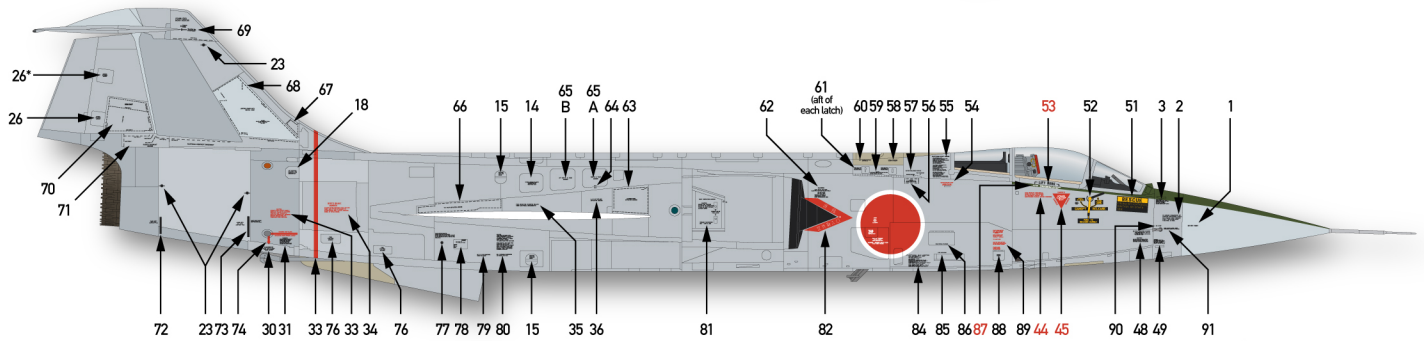
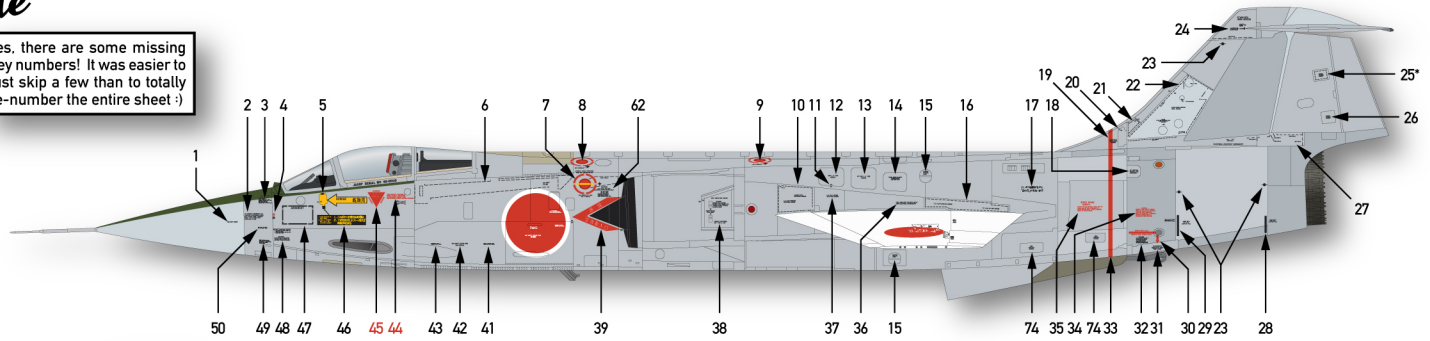


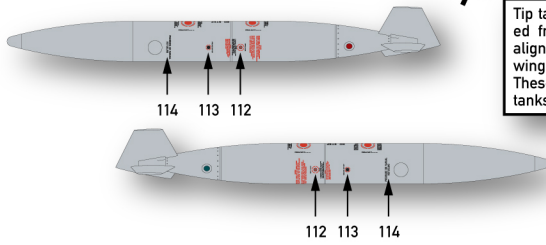

Yes, there are some missing key numbers! It was easier to just skip a few than to totally re-number the entire sheet :)



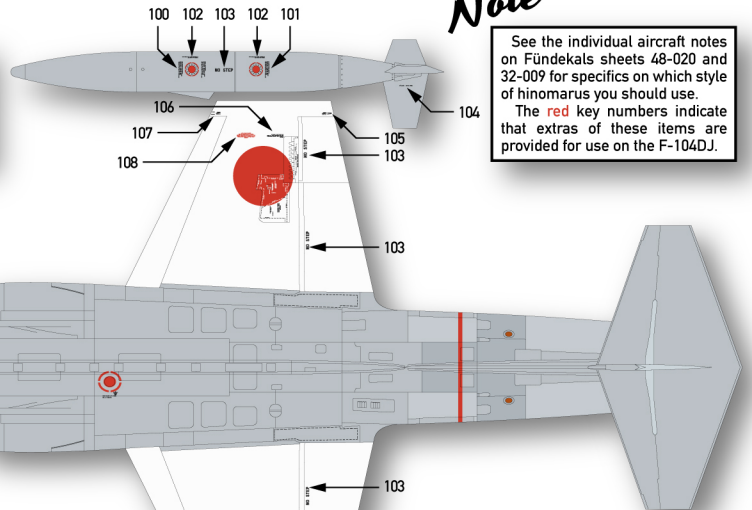
Note

Tip tanks are shown dismounted from wing to show where alignment markings on upper wing surfaces are located. These are covered when the tip tanks are fitted.

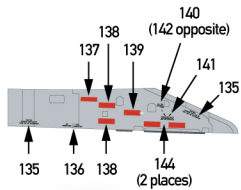

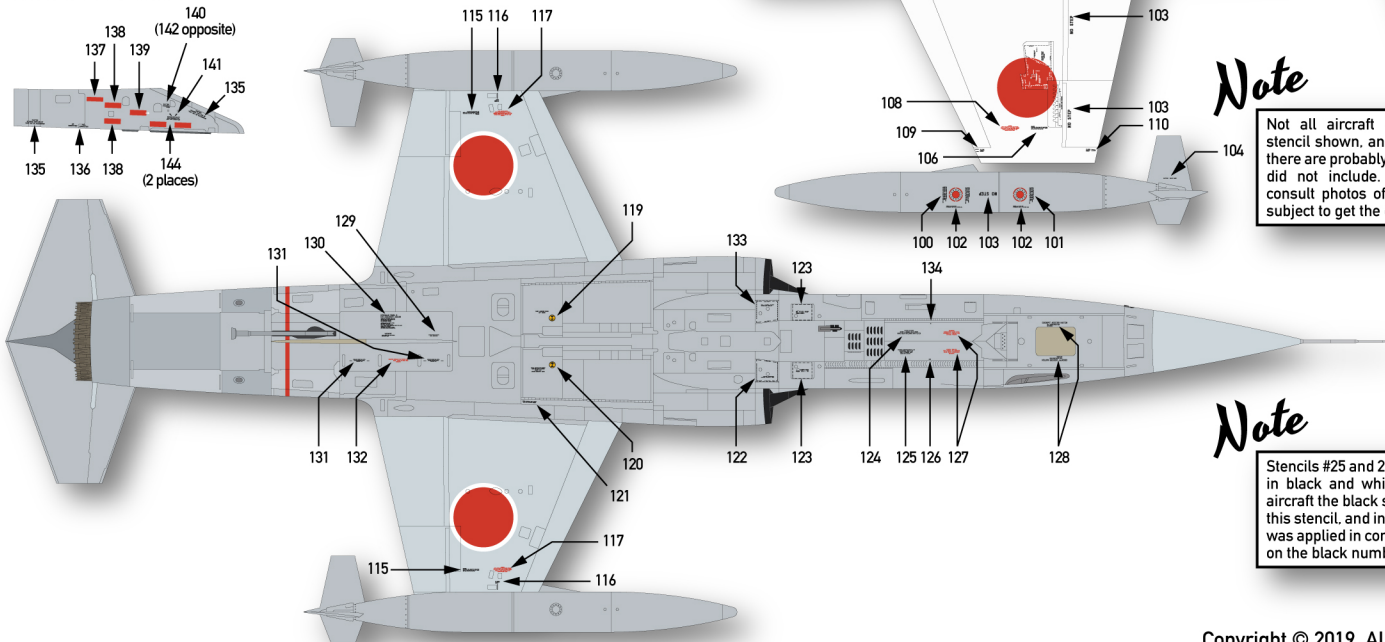


Left hand pylon
