
Fiat CR 42, 85th Sqn., 18th Group, 56th Stormo, Maldegem, Belgium, 1940. This machine wears standard Dark Green and Red Brown mottling over a Sand Yellow base. Lower surfaces are Light Blue-Gray. Spinner, cowling and fuselage band are yellow.


Fiat CR 42, 97th Sqn., 9th Group, 4th Stormo, Benina, Libya, 1940. Mottled dark Green and Sand Yellow over Light Blue-Gray. Note the absence of the white "theater band," not yet applied at this point. Wheel pant flashes look very dark on photo, but most likely were red. Consult your references.


Wheel flash A & B on OUTER spats only. Trim at front edge of spat.

CR 42 of 1./4 Sqn., 1st Fighter Regiment, Royal Hungarian Air Force, Budapest, 1941. Colors are most often reported to be Dark Green and Blue-Gray over Sand Yellow, with Light Blue Gray beneath. Note the mottled Dark Green and Sand Yellow under- carriage. Align decals 8L and 8R with the fin leading edge, then trim at the rear.

CR 42 of 1/3 Sqn., Hungarian Fast Corps, Royal Hungarian Air Force, USSR, late 1941. Dark Green and Blue-Gray over Sand Yellow, with Light Blue Gray beneath and mottled Dark Green/Sand landing gear. Both the fin and rudder, as well as both horizontal stabilizer surfaces wear Green (inmost shade), white and red (outer color) Hungarian national colors. Note the yellow fuselage band, lower cowl and lower wing tips — all East Front identification devices.









## AeroMarter Decals.

CR 42 of 2./4 Sqn., 1st Fighter Regiment, Royal Hungarian Air Force, Budapest, 1941. Colors are most probably mottled Dark Green and Sand Yellow over Light Blue-Gray - the Italian delivery scheme. Spinner is Sand Yellow.
