

Flown by F.O. G.E. Kosh, this Tempest V, JN765/JF*K of No. 3 Squadron (at Newchurch, UK) was used in battle against V-1 flying bombs in June 1944. Note Sky spinner and fuselage band. The standard camouflage scheme was carried. A/C had long cannon barrels.

18 Paint Sky first, then the complete White

segment, and finally apply the Black stripe decals.

A colorful Tempest V, EJ865/W2*Y, No. 80 Squadron, as it appeared in 1947. Standard Dark Green and Ocean Gray uppersurfaces with Medium Sea Gray undersurfaces were carried. Medium/Dark Blue spinner.
