

The Bulldog, initially developed by Beagle Aircraft, as the B.125 Bulldog, first flew on May 19, 1969. The first order for the type came from the Swedish Air Force. However, before any planes were actually built, Beagle Aircraft ceased trading and the production rights, along with the swedish order, were transferred to Scottish Aviation.

The airplane was operated by the United Kingdom (130 α/c for the RAF, five of which were later transferred to the armed forces of Malta), Sweden (58 α/c for the air force, 20 for the army), Malaysia (15), Kenya (14), Ghana (13), Nigeria (37), Jordan (22), Lebanon (6), Hong Kong (2), Botswana (6) and one for a civilian customer in Venezuela.


Today, many Bulldogs have found a new life with civilian operators, as both the RAF and the Swedish air force have sold off their aircraft.


