

#### A/C #1

EKA-3B of VAQ 131, CVW-11 aboard USS Kittyhawk, 1968, Gull Gray over Gloss White camouflage. Black nose cap, A/G panel, front of fuselage blisters and I.D. band on fuselage. Also fin tip. Notice White sloping color demarcation, fin leading edge and rear fuselage cap.

### A/C#2


KA-3B of VAQ-308, Naval Reserves, about 1978. Some A/C of this Sqdn. had large Roman numbers on the rear of the fuselage for I.D. purpose. Unknown if it was before or after the Red rear fuselage caps. Camouflage as per number one A/C.


#### A/C#3


KA-3B of VAH-10 aboard the USS Hancock, as part of CVW-11, during 1969. Color scheme as A/C 1. Note that the upper section of the left side sword wraps around the refueling probe. That is the reason for it being larger. Apply 20A first. Then apply and adjust 20B to the right height.

#### MODELERS NOTE:

For A/C 2 & 3 you must do a little conversion, thoughtfully provided by our friends at Hasegawa. You will need to use the kit# K134, EKA-3B. During construction discard part K3 and replace it with J3 (which shows in gray on their instructions part layout, as not used). Now you have a KA-3B. That simple! We believe Hasegawa will be re-boxing the same kit in the KA-3B version soon. Until then, Sayonara!
