



B-29A Serial Number 44-61562 "TOP OF THE MARK", 19th Bomb Group, 28th Bomb Squadron, Kadena AB, Okinawa, September 1950. Finish was overall natural metal with Black de-icer boots. The aircraft was trimmed in dark Green in the same locations as the Blue trim on the aircraft above. A large gloss Black stripe was carried on the fin and rudder. The propellers were Black with Yellow tips.
