

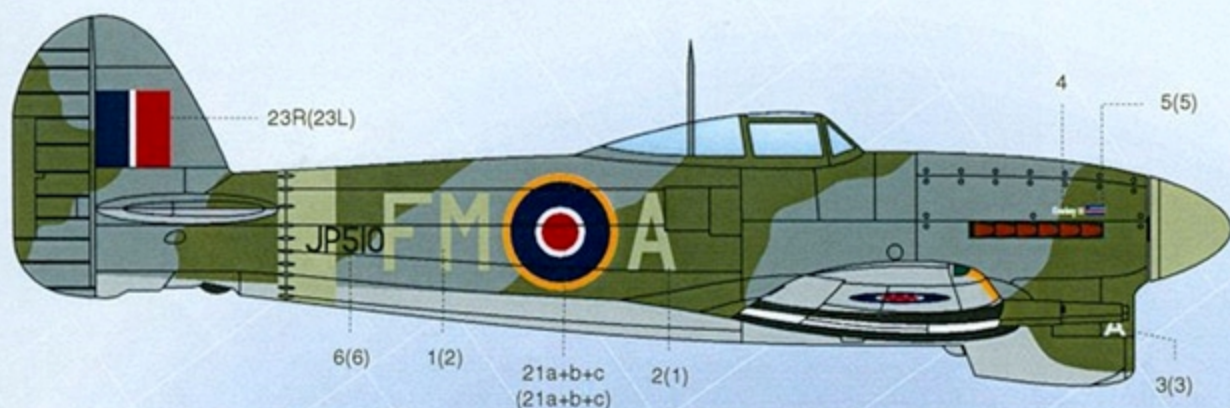

FM•A, Serial No. JP510, Typhoon Mk IB of No. 257 Sqn. Flown by Sqn Ldr R. H. Fokes. Warmwell, August 1943. Camouflaged in Ocean Gray and Dark Green over Medium Sea Gray. Sky fuselage band and spinner. I.D. stripes under wings. Left side codes read FM•A.

DJ•S, Serial No. R8843, Typhoon Mk IB of Tangmere Wing. Flown by Wg. Cdr. D. J. Scott. September 1943. Camouflaged in Ocean Gray and Dark Green over Medium Sea Gray. Sky fuselage band and spinner. I.D. stripes under wings. Right side codes read DJ•S. Notice "DJ" touches roundel. Three bladed prop.



JJ•F, Serial No. EJ762, Tempest Mk V of No. 274 Sqn. Flown by Flt. Lt. D. C. Fairbanks. B.80 Volkel, November 1944. Camouflaged in Ocean Gray and Dark Green over Medium Sea Gray. Sky spinner with Black spinner back plate. Invasion stripes under fuselage. Right side codes read JJ•F. Notice separation of codes from roundel.

SA•M, Serial No. SN129, Tempest Mk V of No. 486 Sqn. Flown by Sqn. Ldr. C. J. Sheddan. B.152 Fassberg, May 1945. Camouflaged in Ocean Gray and Dark Green over Medium Sea Gray. Black spinner. Left side codes read SA•M. Notice overpainted fuselage band.
