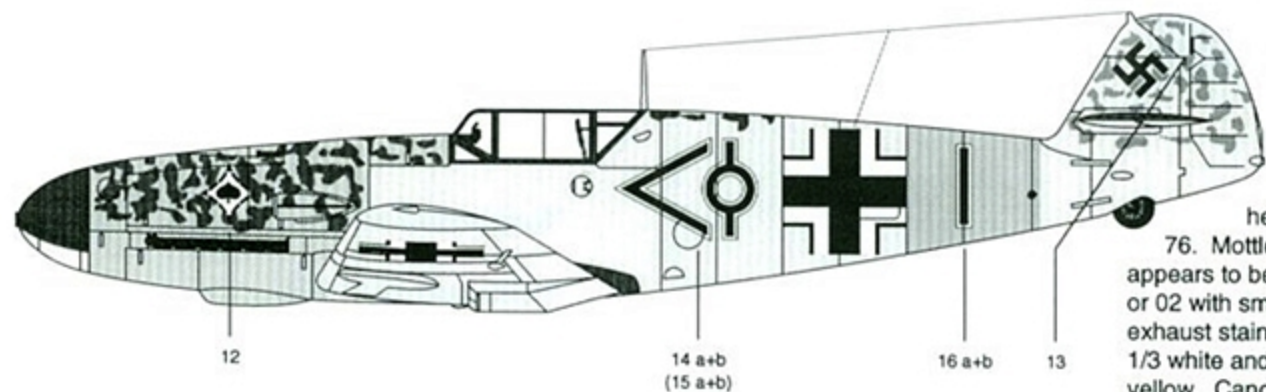
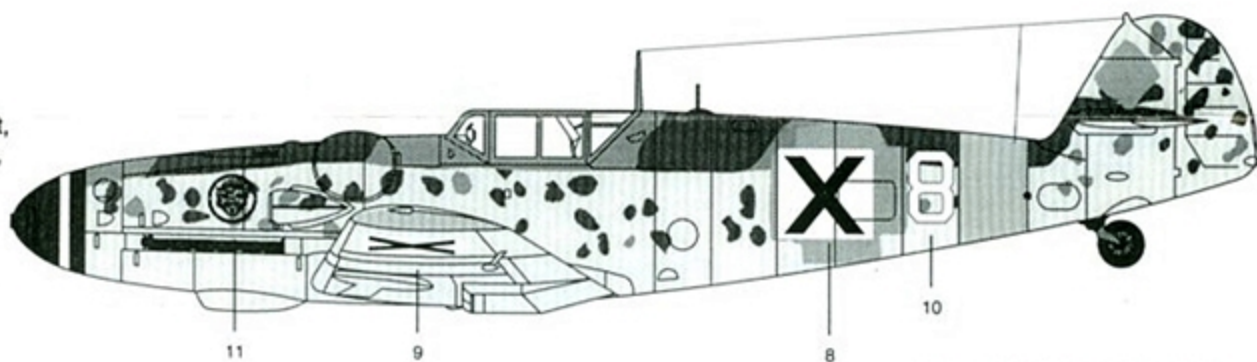
In order to provide as many aircraft choices as possible, German national insignias are not provided for all aircraft. These are available on AeroMaster Sheets 48-020 and 48-021.

Bf-109G-10, Jagdstaffel 5, Oberst Kazakov, Russian Army of Liberation, flown by Maj. S.T. Bychkov, Russian front, 1945. RLM 75/82/76 camouflage with black and white striped spinner. Yellow theatre markings on rear fuselage and lower wing tips. Previous German markings probably painted out.



Bf-109F-4, 1./1 Vadasz Század, Hungarian Air Force, Stalingrad, 1942. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage with yellow spinner tip, cowling, lower wing tips and fuselage band. Rear of spinner RLM 70, possibly with 1/3 white.

Bf-109G-6, 6th Fighter Regiment, Bulgarian Air Force, Wrasdebn, April 1944. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage with yellow lower wing tips and fuselage band. Spinner black with white stripe. Previous German markings probably painted out.



Bf-109F-2, W.Nr. 8085, Stab. III./JG 53, Sobolevo, Russia, June 1941. Flown by Lt. Jürgen Harder. Camouflage appears to be mainly RLM 76 on fuselage with a light mottle on tail surfaces. Cowling previously yellow, but overpainted with a heavy mottle, possibly of 74 over 76. Mottle on fuselage spine aft of canopy appears to be 74. Upper wings are mainly 75 or 02 with small areas of 74. Moderately heavy exhaust staining on fuselage sides. Spinner 1/3 white and 2/3 RLM 70. Fuselage band yellow. Canopy framing RLM 66.

Bf-109G-6/R6, I./JG 302, Malmi airport, Helsinki, Finland, March 1944. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage heavily oversprayed with a "squiggle" pattern of white. Rudder yellow. Starboard lower wing black. Spinner 1/3 white and 2/3 RLM 70.
