This Bf109D-1 of Stab 1./JG233 wears standard Luftwaffe fighter colors: RLM 70 Schwarzgrün and RLM 71 Dunkelgrün over RLM 65 Hellblau. Note the RLM 70 prop and spinner with white tip. See page 93.

This He51B-1 of JG 135 (later 233) wears RLM 63 Hellgrau overall with medium blue flashing on fuselage . RLM 63 prop spinner with blue tip. RLM 63 prop blades. Note the aluminum drop tank assembly. We cannot determine if decal 12a/b appeared on the starboard side, but an extra is also provided, just in case. See page 59.

A He51A-1 of JG 132 Richthofen in overall RLM 63 Hellgrau with RLM 23 Rot flashing and 600mm trisected fuselage band. RLM 63 prop spinner with RLM 23 tip. RLM 63 prop blades. Note the aluminum drop tank assembly. JG 132 was the first unit equipped with the Heinkel biplane. See page 37.
