Colors: Undersurfaces; RLM 76. Uppersurfaces a non-standard medium Green and Dark Green. Spinner - 3/4 White/ 1/4 RLM 70 Black-Green with front portion Black. Backing plate Black. Upper wings unknown, standard camouflage pattern provisional. Motor cowling Yellow with light mottling of Green on the top. Yellow band behind fuselage cross. Yellow underwing tips to edge of cross and wing leading edge not quite to wing root. 26 White victory bars on both sides of rudder. *Hakenkreuz* masked off with light Blue showing through

Overhead armor in canopy.
Colors: Undersurfaces, RLM 76. Uppersurfaces RLM 74/RLM 75. Yellow engine cowling, Yellow rudder, mottled over with camouflage color. Yellow fuselage band, Yellow underwing tips to edge of cross, Yellow leading edge wing. Spinner - Rear portion Black, front portion half Black/half White. A portion of the back plate is Yellow. 36 Black victory bars on both sides of rudder. III./JG 54 Shield on both sides of fuselage. 7./JG 54 flying wooden shoe is on both sides of the engine cowling.
