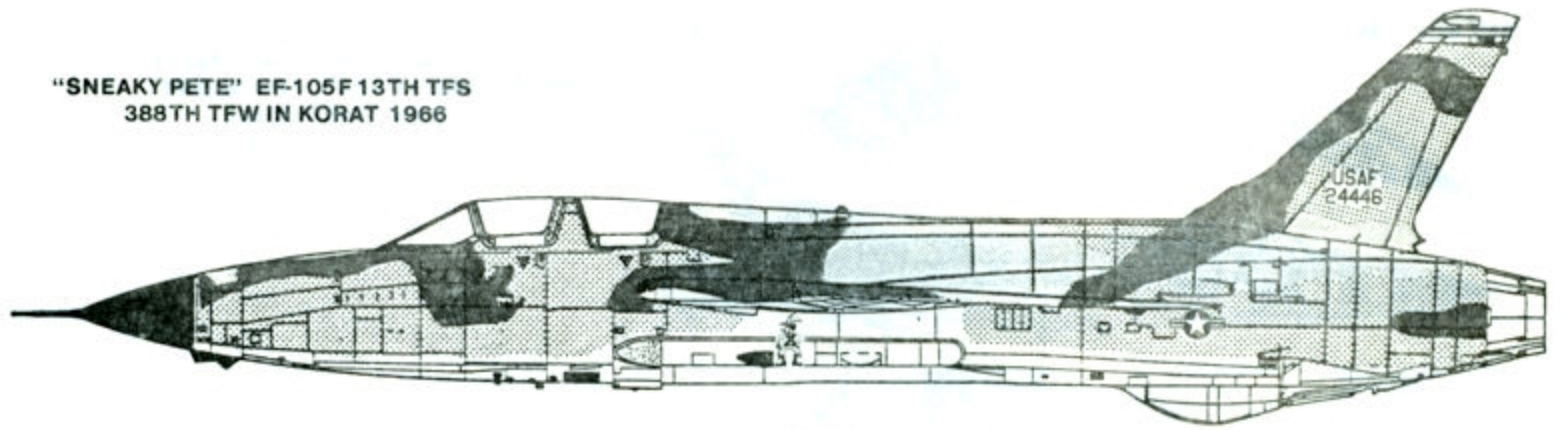
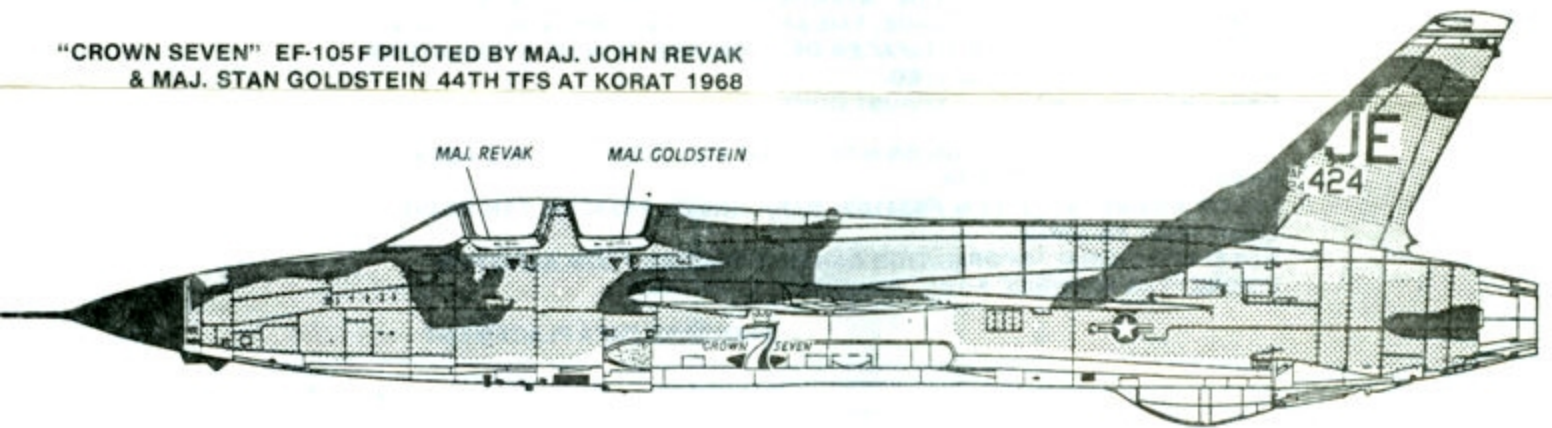

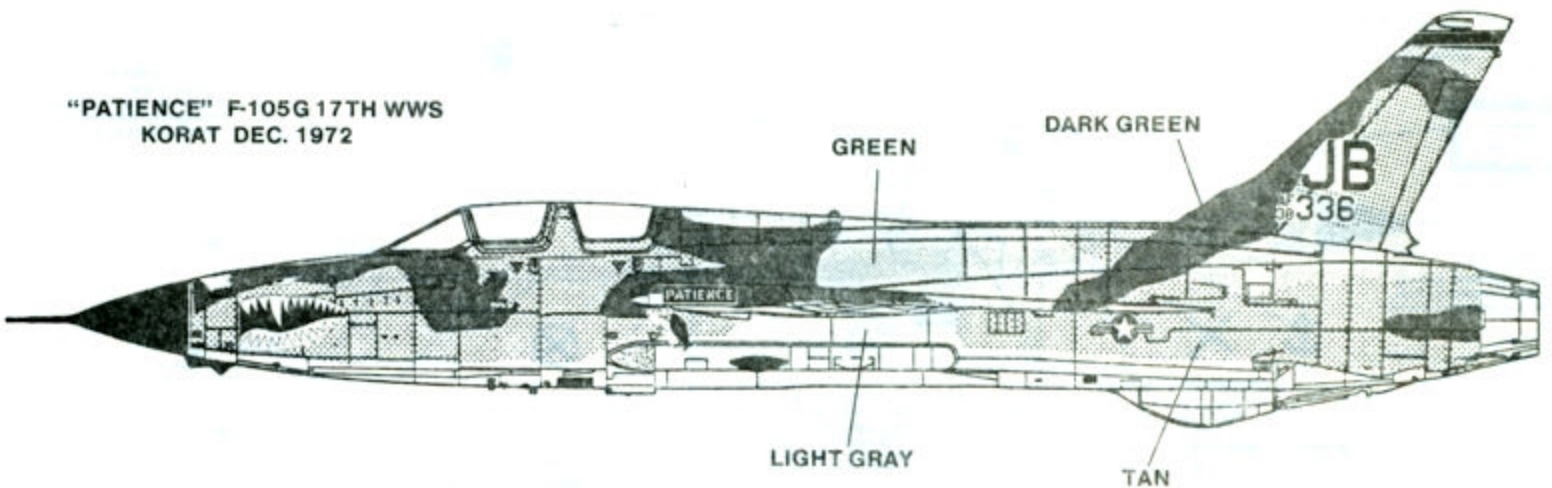

SPLIT VIEW SHOWING DETAILS COMMON TO ALL VERSIONS

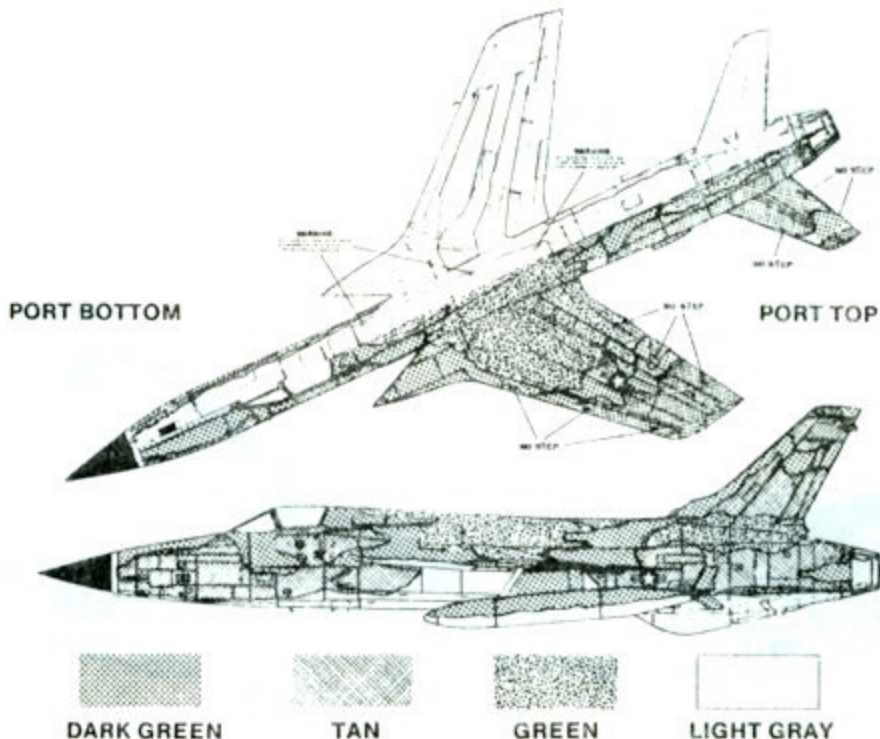
