



F-104G Historical Fighters Volkel RNLAF Starfighter

In December 1962, the first two F-104Gs for the Royal Netherlands Air Force (RNLAF) were delivered. By 1966, the RNLAF had five squadrons operational: 306 at Twenthe, 323and 322 at Leeuwarden and 311 and 312 at Volkel. In total, the RNLAF took delivery 138 F-104Gs. Between 1979 and 1984, these were replaced by the F-16A/B.

By 2000, the numbers of remaining Starfighters in the Netherlands were dwindling and many were in bad condition. Historical Fighters Volkel (HVV), consisting of a dedicated group of volunteers, started in 2004 with restoring historical jets at Volkel Air Base. Their main focus was to restore a Starfighter for static display. When in 2011 D-8114 became available, which had been in use at the Technical University in Delft, HVV jumped at the opportunity.

Today, the HVV is committed to bringing D-8114 back into full flyable condition. A lot has been achieved in recent yearsby performing a 200 hours inspection, with the aircraft's hydraulic and electric systems have been brought back to life. S&S Turbines Services from Canada will supply a running J79-GE11A engine to power D-8114. To raise much neededfunds and support the HVV, the Dutch Starfighter Foundation (DSF) was founded in 2018, chaired by Hans van der Werf, the famous RNLAF Starfighter demo-pilot from 1974 to 1979.

Please help the HVV to achieve their ultimate goal: Putting D-8114 back in the air!'
