




Weathered olive drab over neutral grey finish with red prop. spinner; red nose band and white theater stripes on the main wings. A/C data block (decal 4) has been included although it appears to have been overpainted.






A/C # 2: P-51D-5-NA 44-13606 flown by First Lieutenant Claude Crenshaw, 369th FS, 359th FG November 1944. Overall duraluminum finish with medium green prop. spinner and forward nose band; weathered black antiglare panel and red rudder. Single rear view mirror painted black.

A/C # 3: P-51D-15-NA 44-15076, flown by Second Lt. William T. Kemp, 375th FS, 361st FG, September 1944. Overall duraluminum finish with yellow prop spinner and forward nose; pale greyish blue rudder and canopy frame and black anti-glare panel. Black band on vertical fin. D-Day stripes on main wings and lower rear fuselage. 'White' fuselage D-Day stripes are pale gray (dirty white).







A/C # 4: P-51D-5-NT 44-11243, flown by Maj. Samuel Wicker, 383rd FS, 364th FG, December 1944. Overall duraluminum finish with white prop. spinner; white/ insignia blue nose stripes; black antiglare panel. Black theater stripes on main wings and rear horizontals. D-Day stripes on lower rear fuselage. Rear view mirror painted black.









A/C # 3: Position of underwing D-Day stripes (both wings). Pattern-white/black/white/black/white
