



P-38J-10. 42-67597, "BUFFALO BLITZ". 431st FS, flown by Lt. Fred Champlin. This Lightning carried the standard color scheme of Olive Drab upper surfaces and Neutral Gray lower surfaces, with Red and White stripes applied to the spinners, fin caps and rear booms.






P-38L, standard 35th markings at le Shima. This aircraft was overall bare metal with an O.D. anti-glare panel and Yellow/Black trim on the wings, spinners and fin tops. Inboard sections of engines are Olive Drab.








P-38H-5, 42-66827, 'MAIDEN HEAD HUNTER', 431st FS, flown by Lt. M. Kirby. This Lightning carried the standard color scheme consisting of Olive Drab upper surfaces and Neutral Gray lower surfaces. Red/White stripes were applied to the aft booms and fin caps. The spinners were Blue & Red and the nose was Red.
