A/C #1. KI-45 Kai Type Tei of the 5th Sentai, 1st Chutai, flown by 1st Lt. TOTARO ITO, November 1944, Kiyosu A/B, Aichi Prefecture, Japan.
Overall color Kawasaki Dark Olive (aprox FS34096). Yellow ID panels on wings. Propellers and Spinners red brown. ITO's final score, was more than 13.

A/C #3. Kai Type Tei of the 27 Sentai, 2nd Chutai, end of 1944, Philippines. Overall Dark brown color (aprox FS30111). Propellers and Spinners in Red Brown, Yellow ID bands on wings.

A/C #2. KI-45 Kai Type Tei of the 53 Sentai, 3rd Hikotai, 1945 Matsudo A/B, Chiba prefecture, Japan. Red diagonal band and spinner circles are presumed to indicate Commanders A/C. Camouflage pattern of dark Green spots over light gray overall. White home defense bands on wings and fuselage (must be painted by modeler) Rear fuselage band is white, spinner is red brown with bands (Front to back) in white(decal), red and blue. Last blue band is outlined in white. Yellow ID panels on wings.
