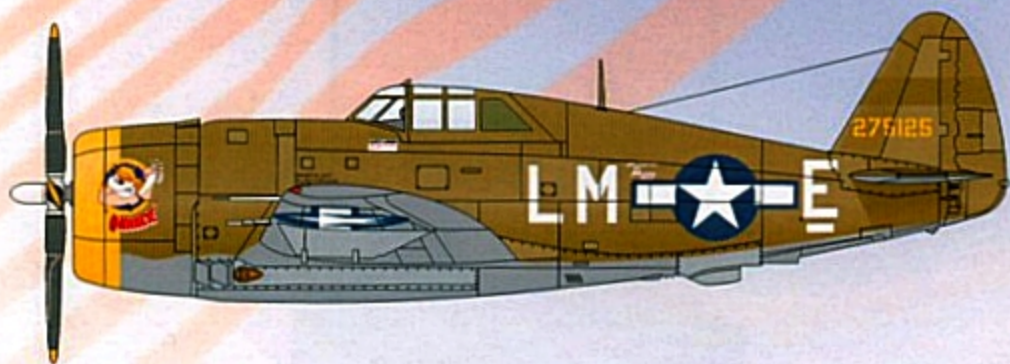
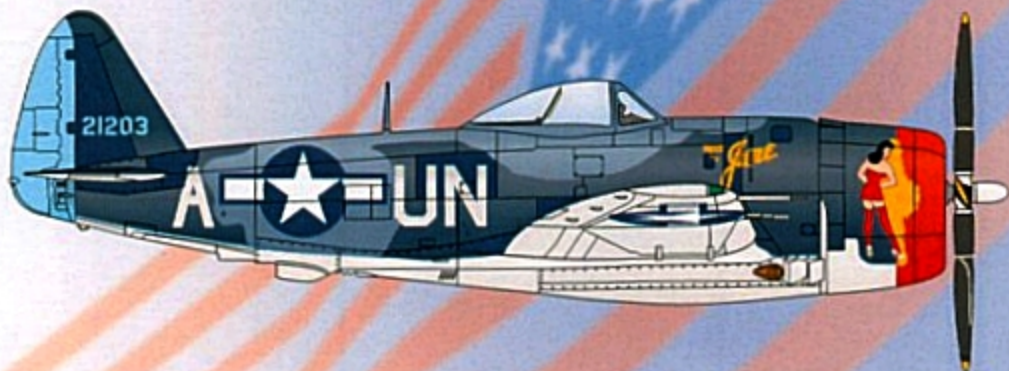
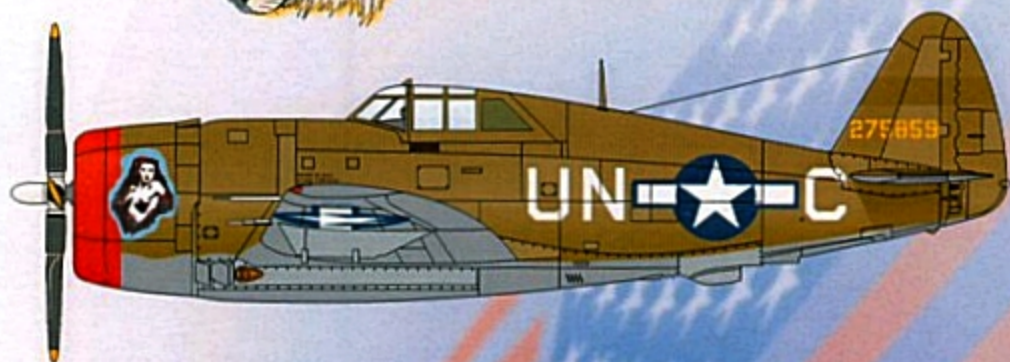

Aircraft 1 - P-47D-15-RE flown by Lt. Charles C. Clamp, 63rd FS, 56th FG. Standard Olive Drab uppersurfaces, Neutral Gray undersides. Red cowl front. NMF propeller boss. A/C Seems to be equipped with a 13' symmetrical propeller.



Aircraft 2 - P-47M-1-RE. Flown by Lt. Eugene Andermatt, this airplane was an early P-47M without dorsal fillet. As if in need of a more colorful livery, this a/c carried nose art on both sides of the nose, something very rare on this type of bird. Dark Blue, Medium Blue with N. Metal lower surfaces, Red front cowling and Light Blue rudder with serial numbers on the fin decorated this super colorful a/c. Not many details are known about this airplane or it's pilot, Curtis Electric 13' 1" symmetrical prop. "They don't make them more colorful"

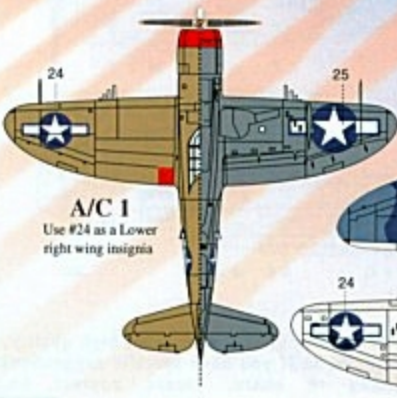

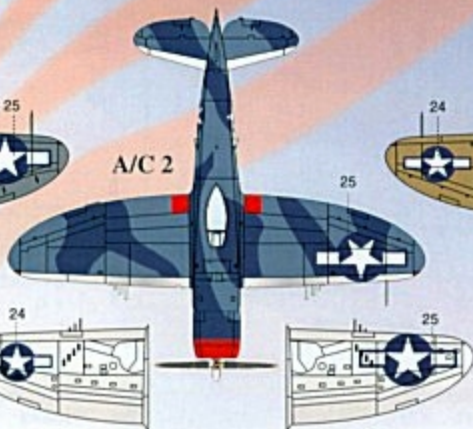

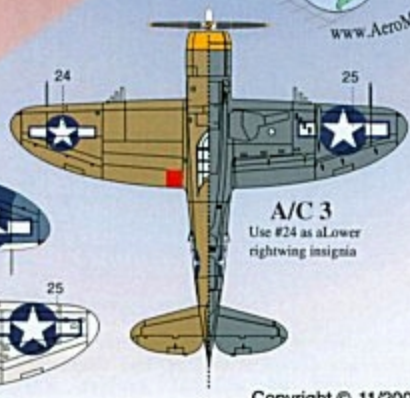
