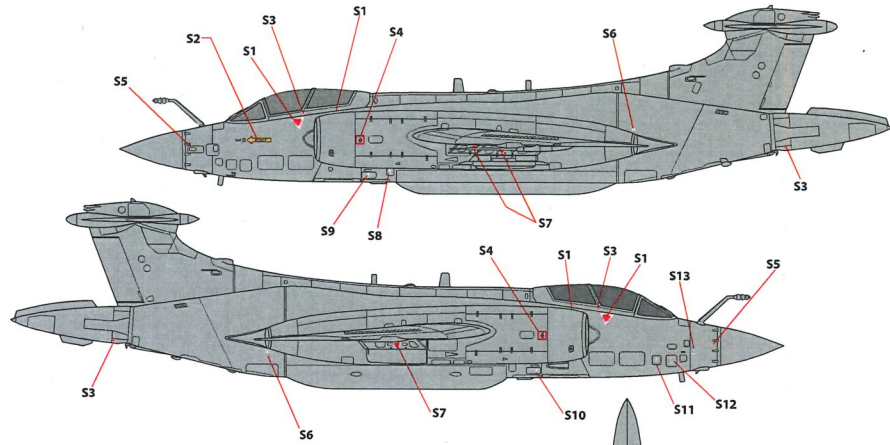
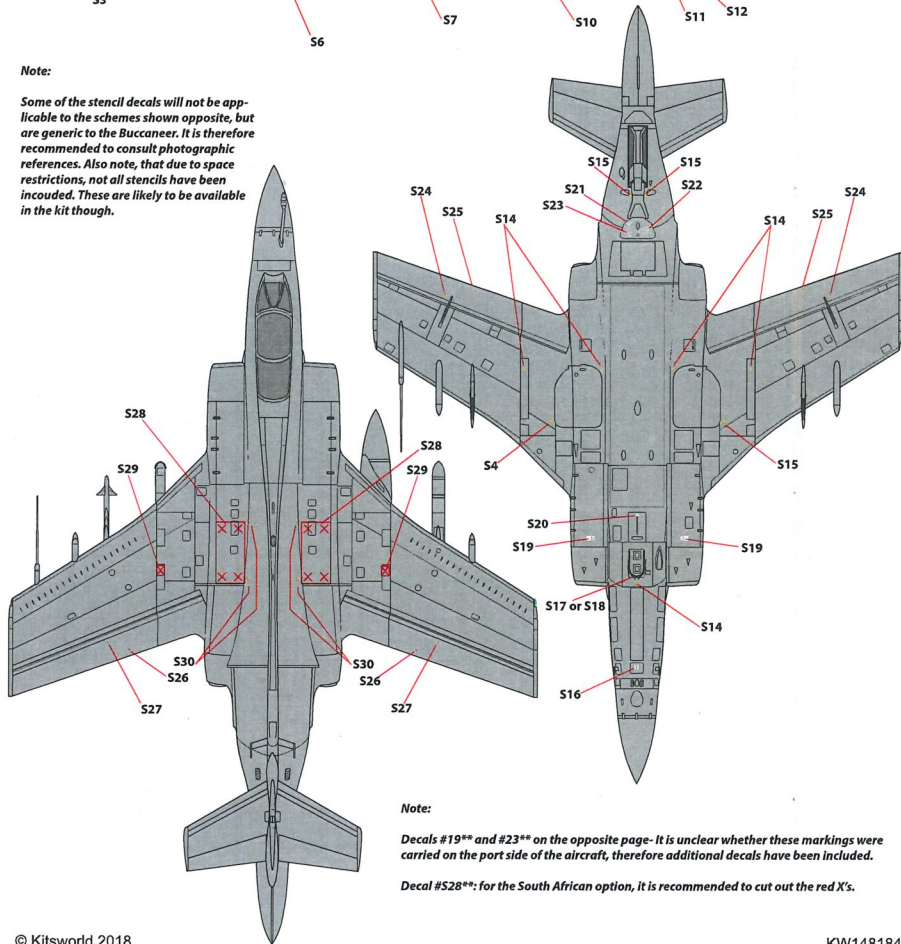


Generic four view showing stencils locations. NOTE: ** dependent on scheme and finish chosen.

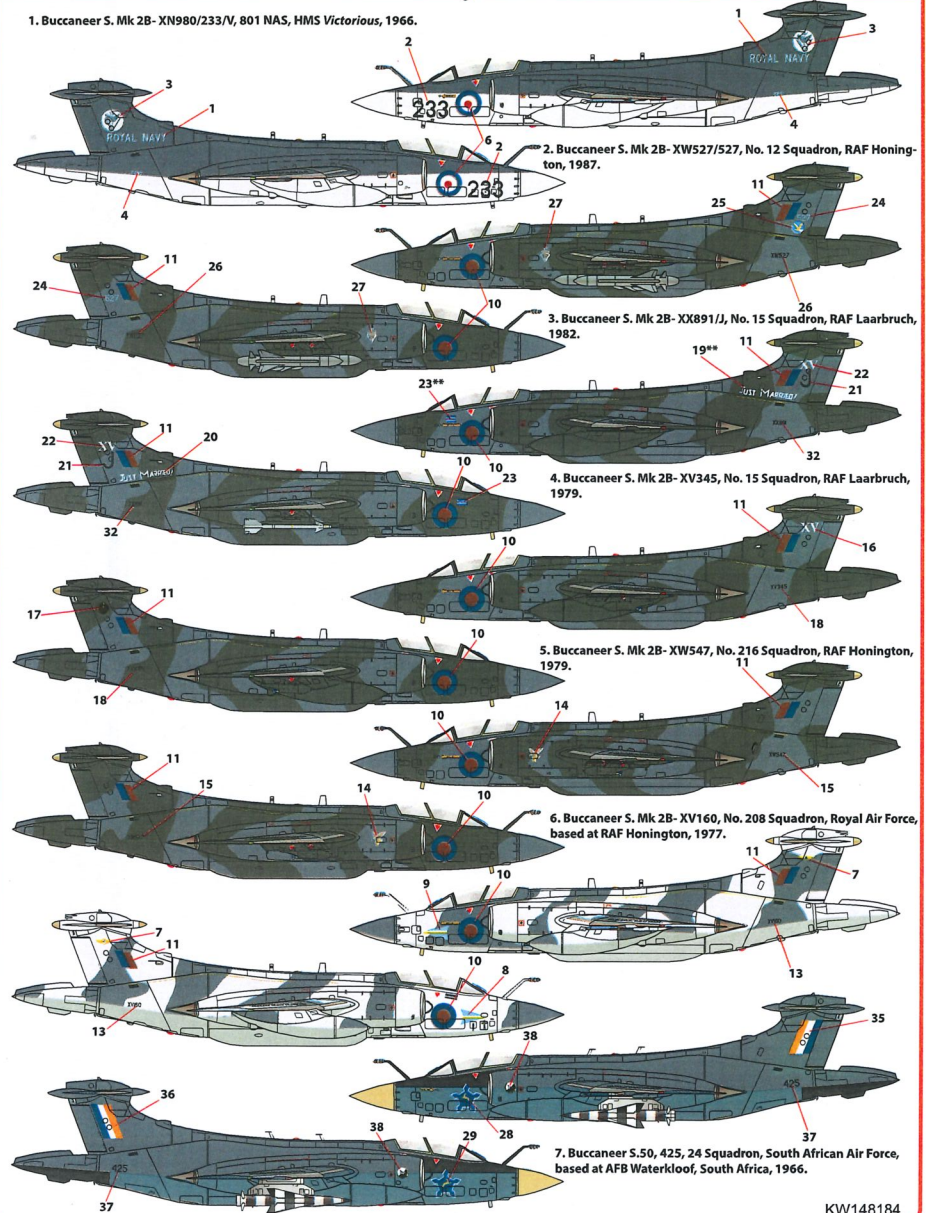


Note:

Decals #19** and #23** on the opposite page- It is unclear whether these markings were carried on the port side of the aircraft, therefore additional decals have been included.

Decal #528** for the South African option, it is recommended to cut out the red X's.

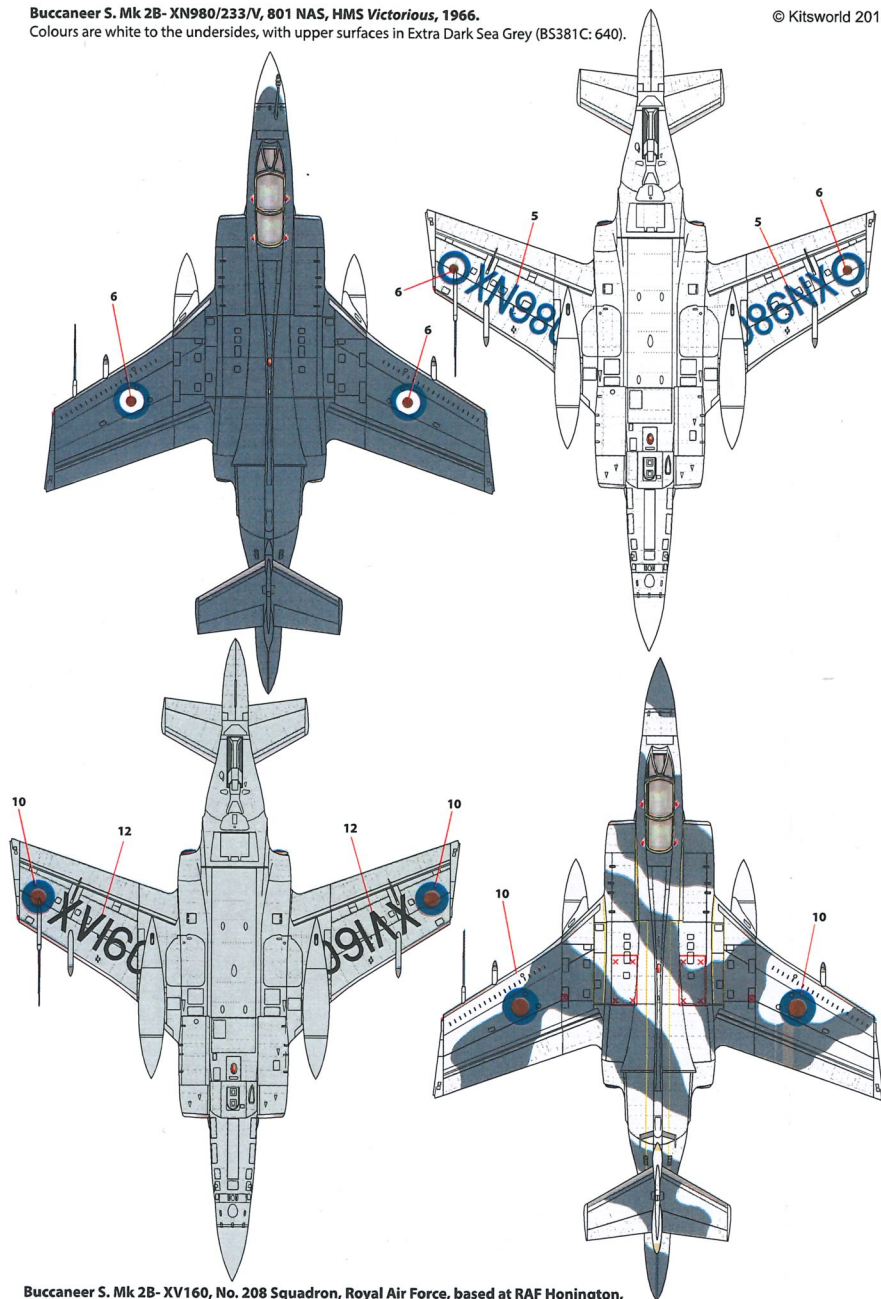

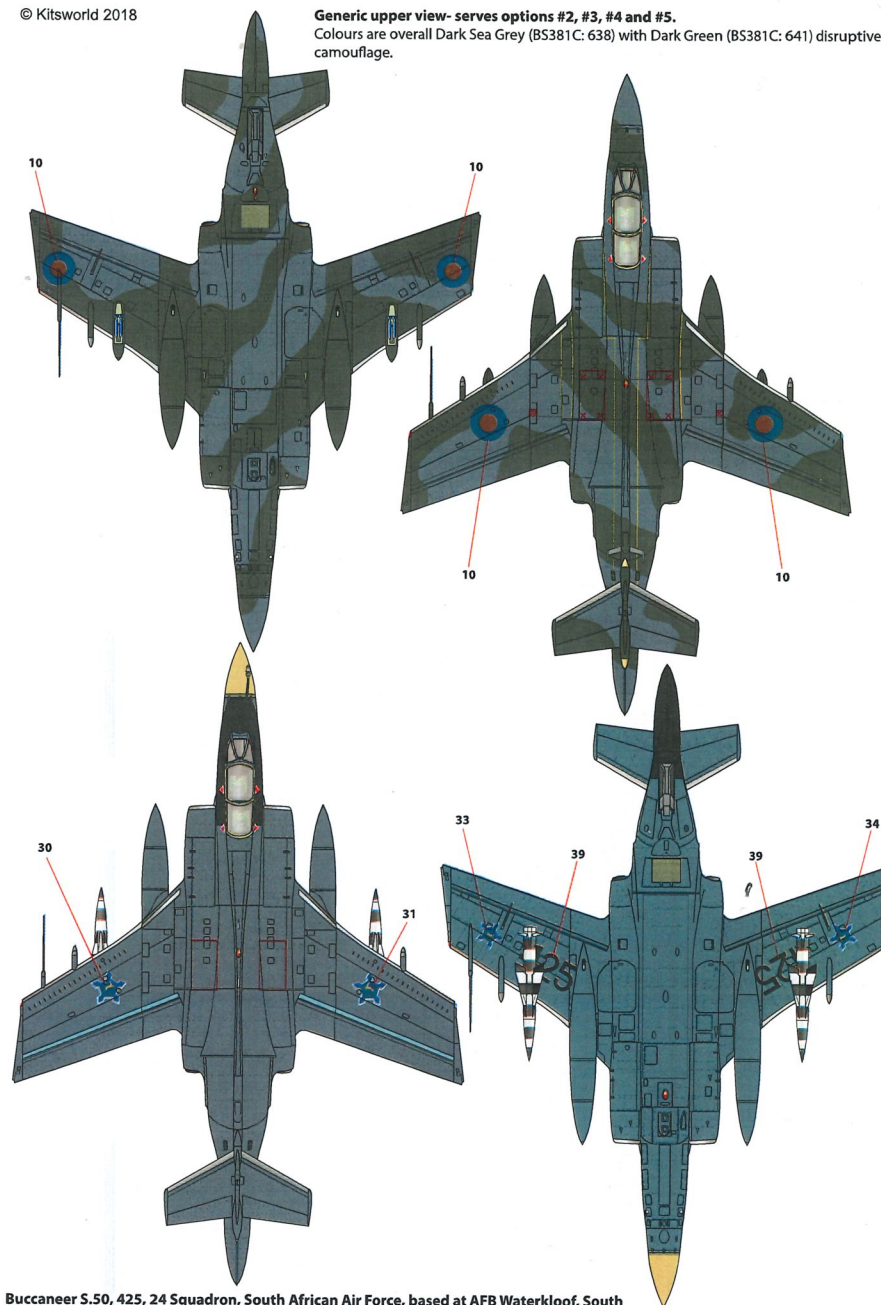
