



## Instructions for Applying Decals

- Cut out each subject carefully. DO NOT trim the excess clear film from around the image, as this allows the decal film to disappear when dry.
- 2. Dip the decal into clean water for 10 seconds.
- Allow water to soften decal adhesive for approximately one minute or until decal slides easily on backing paper. Do not force decal to slide before adhesive is completely dissolved, or decal film may tear.
- Apply decal to model surface by holding decal in place and gently sliding backing paper away.
- Gently blot excess water and adhesive with a soft cloth and allow to dry completely, usually overnight.
