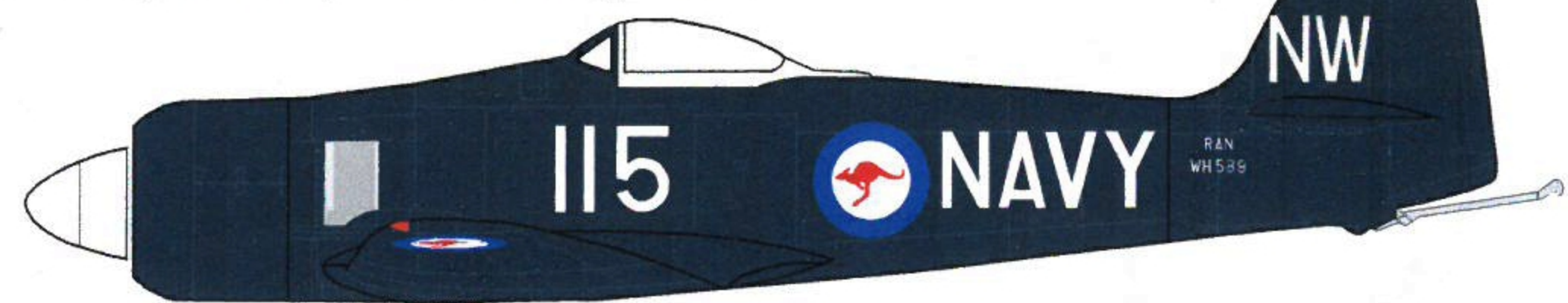
**Sea Fury VW-632 / 108K 805 Sqn R.A.N. 1950**



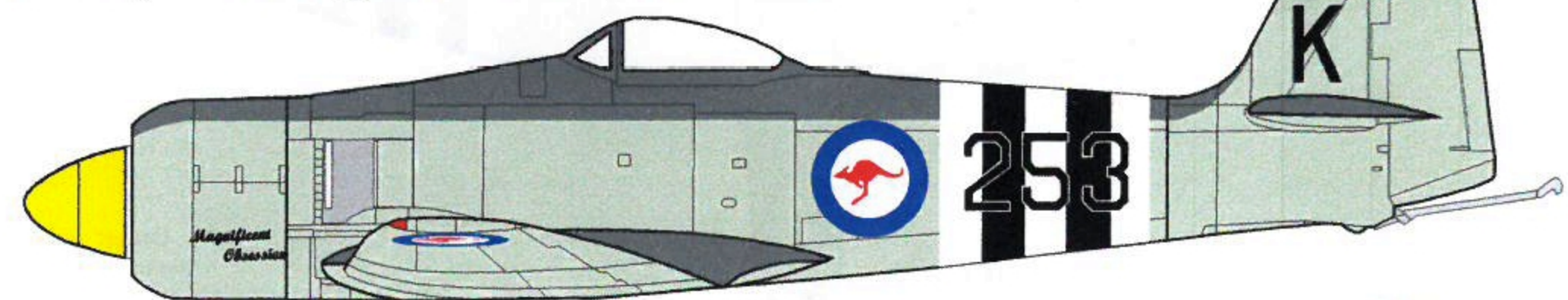
**Sea Fury VX-730 / 109K 805 Sqn R.A.N. HMAS Sydney Korea 1951**



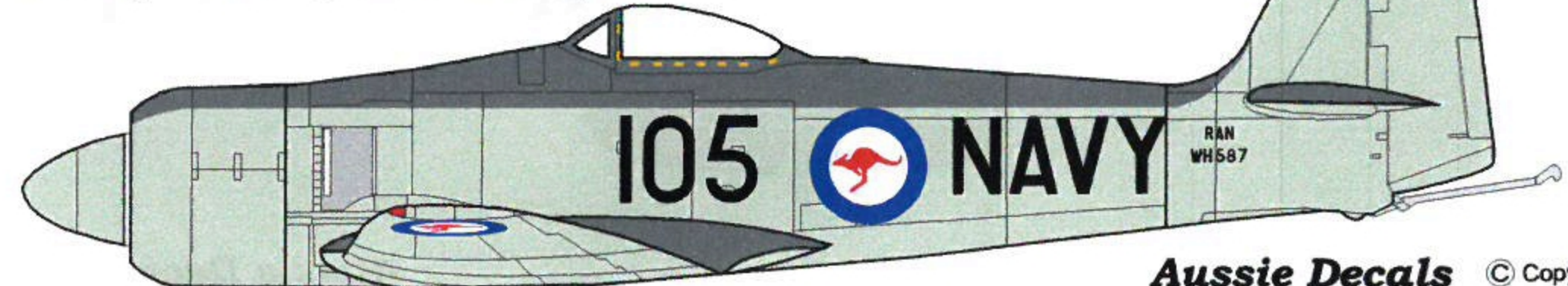

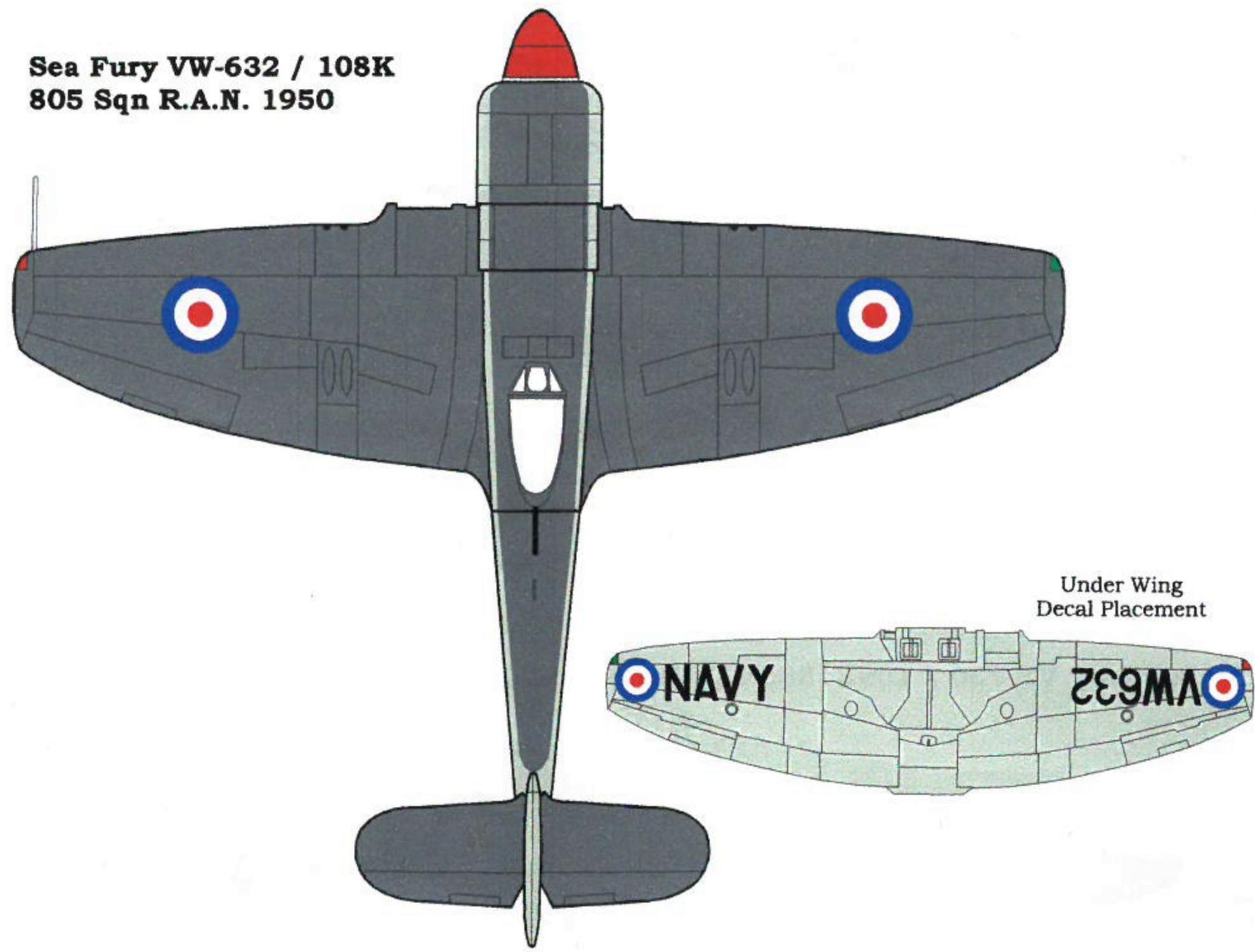

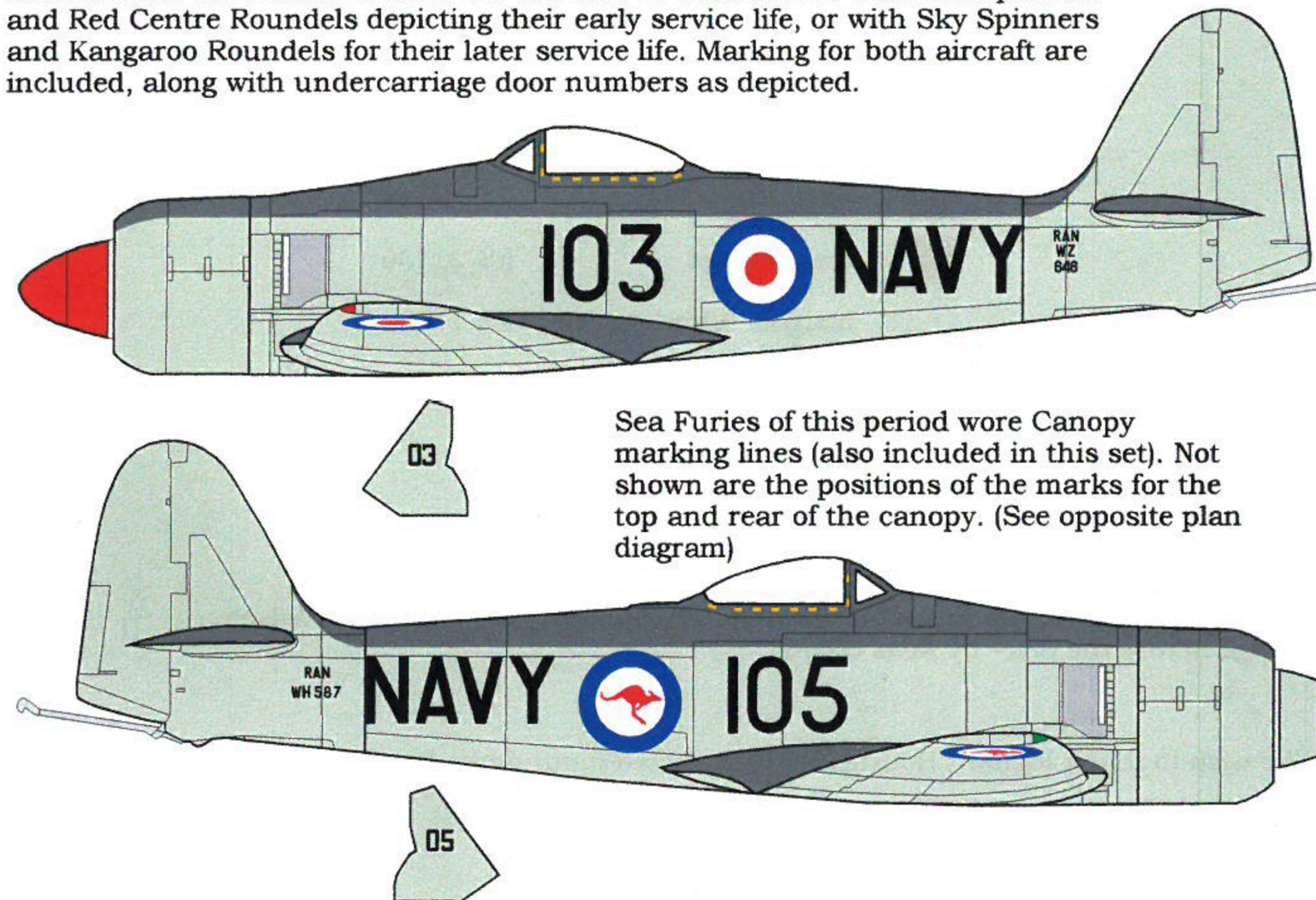


**Sea Fury VX-730 / 109K**

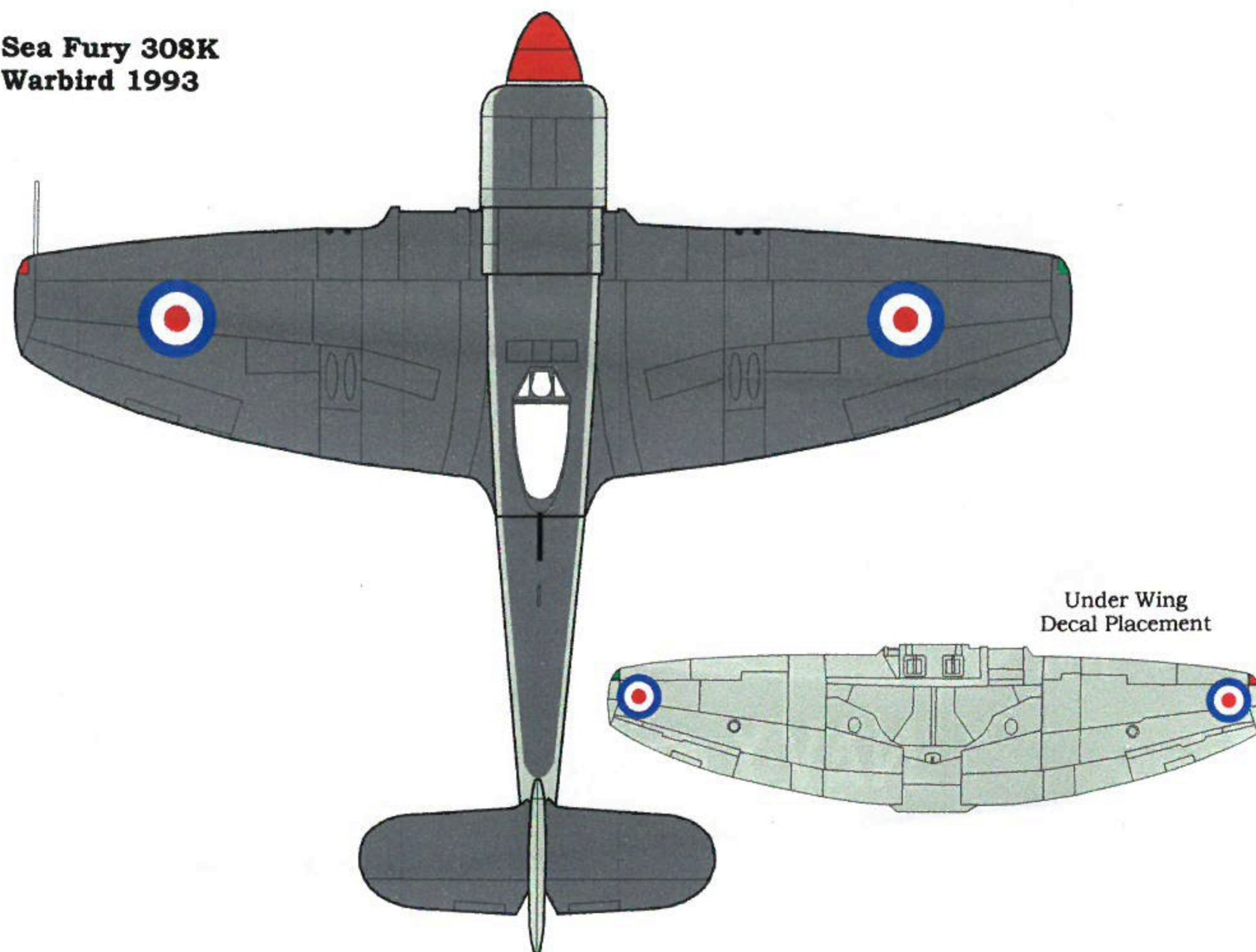

**Sea Fury WZ-646 / 103K and WH-587 / 105K 805 Sqn R.A.N.**  
Both aircraft wore identical schemes and can be constructed with Red Spinners and Red Centre Roundels depicting their early service life, or with Sky Spinners and Kangaroo Roundels for their later service life. Marking for both aircraft are included, along with undercarriage door numbers as depicted.

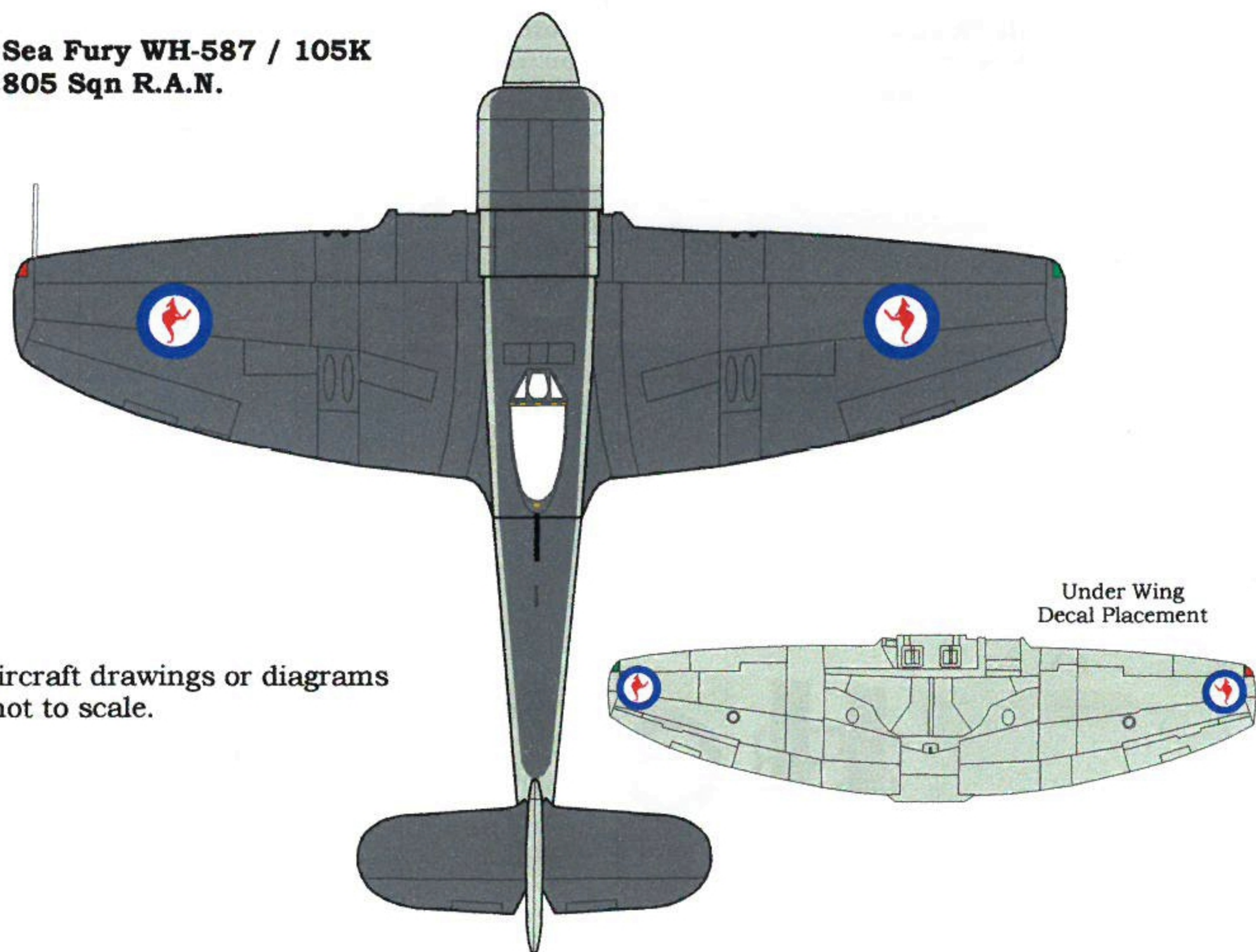

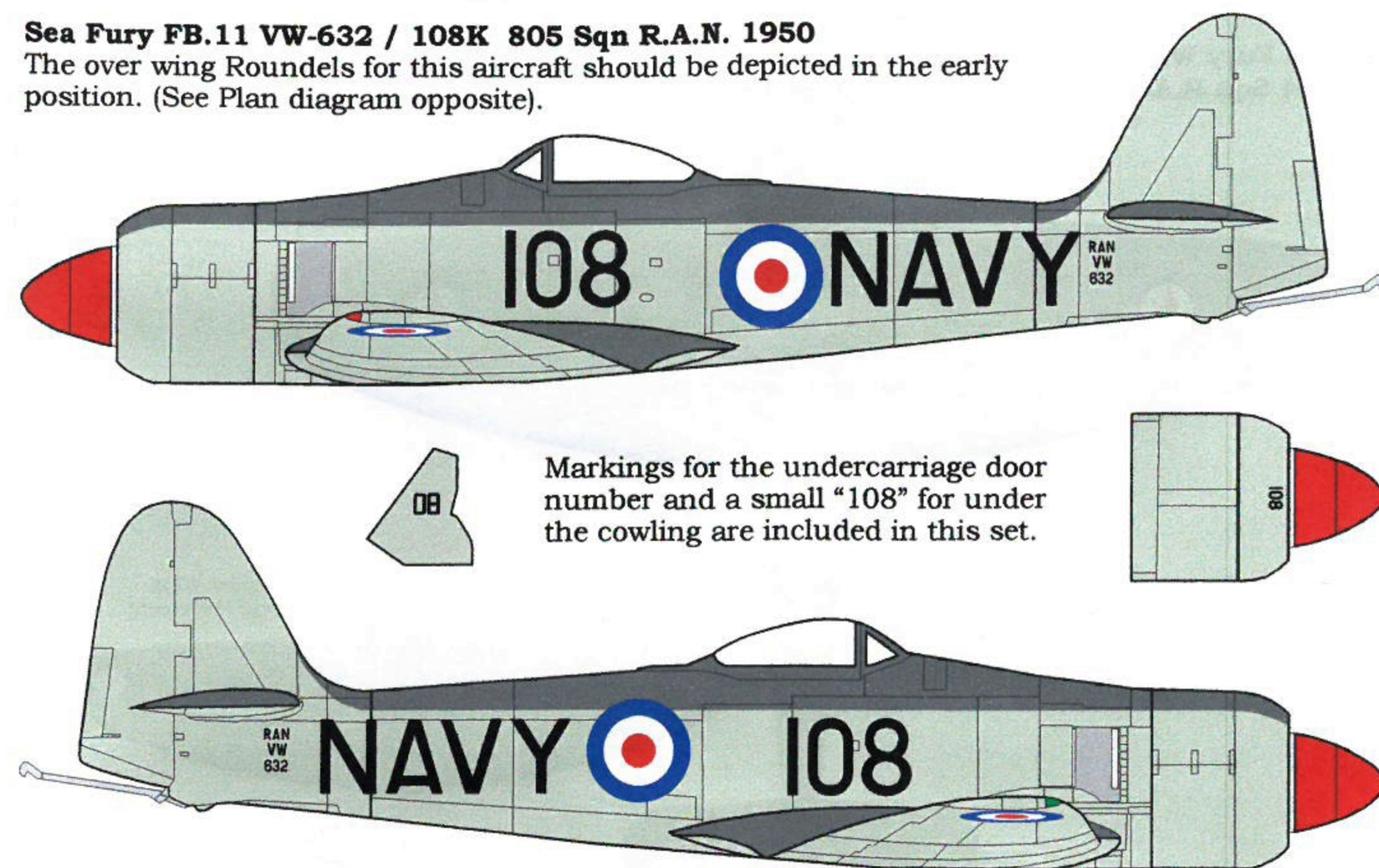

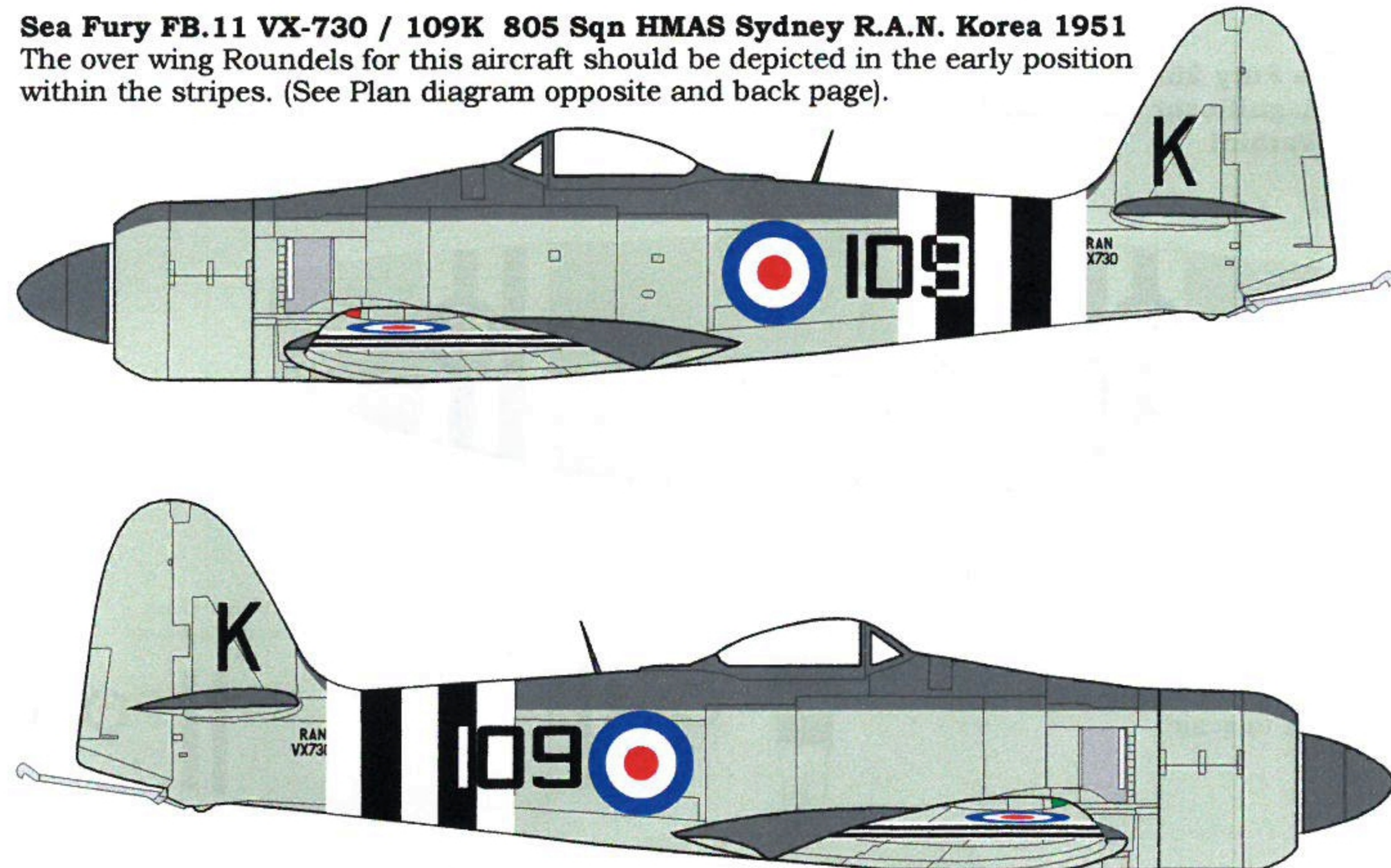

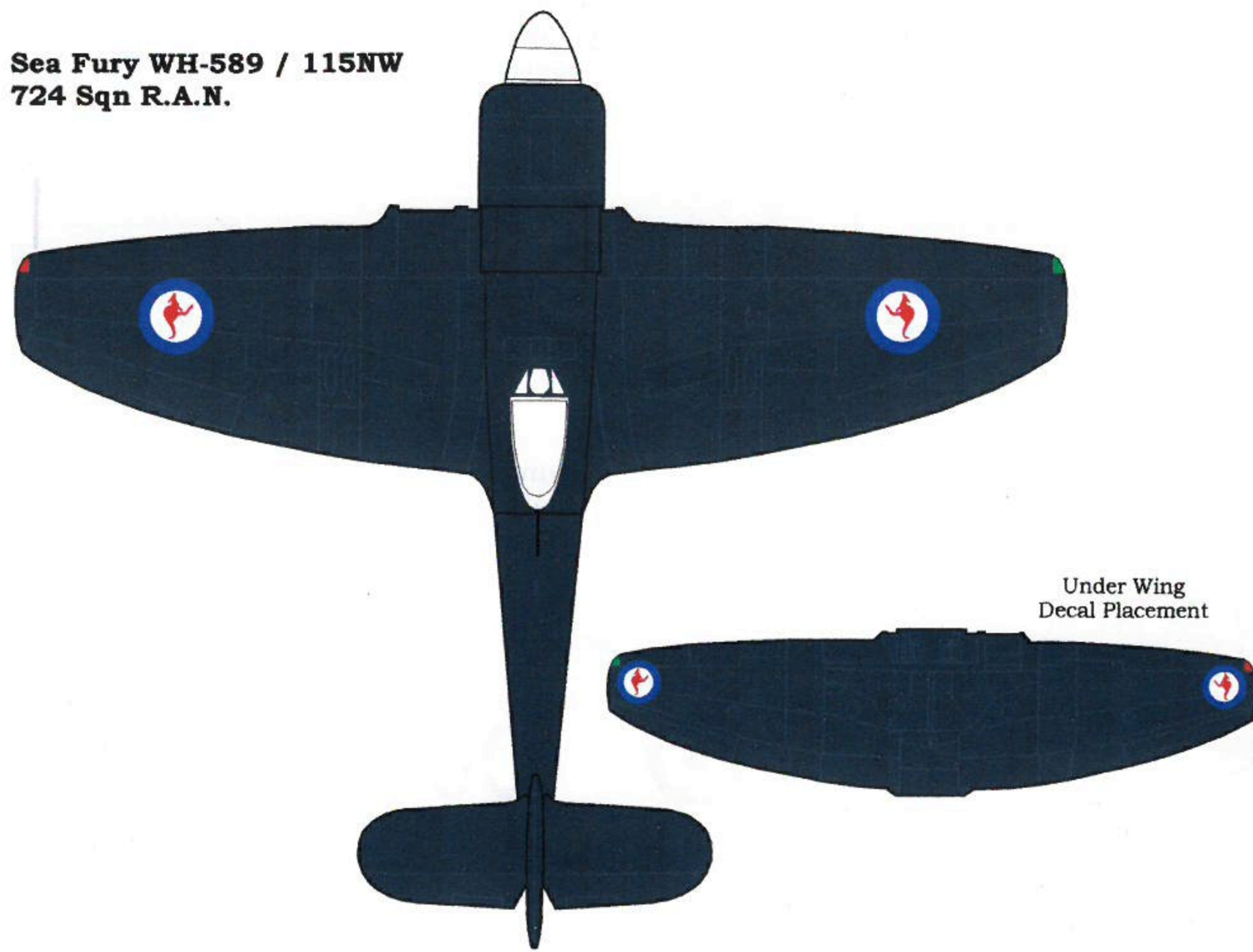
**Sea Fury FB.11 VW-632 / 108K 805 Sqn R.A.N. 1950**

The over wing Roundels for this aircraft should be depicted in the early position within the stripes. (See Plan diagram opposite and back page).



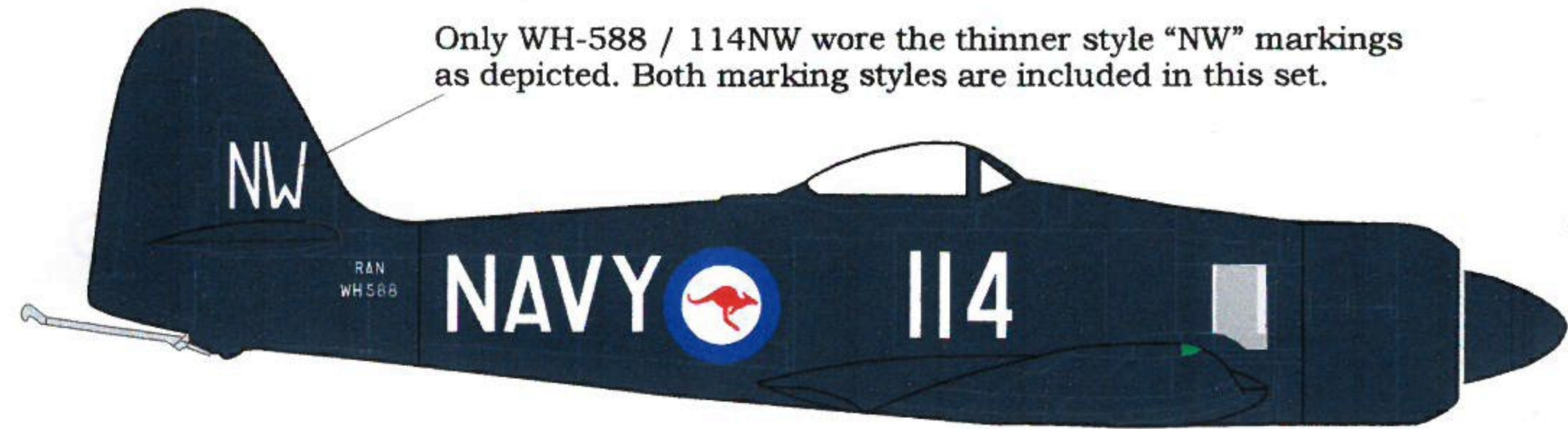

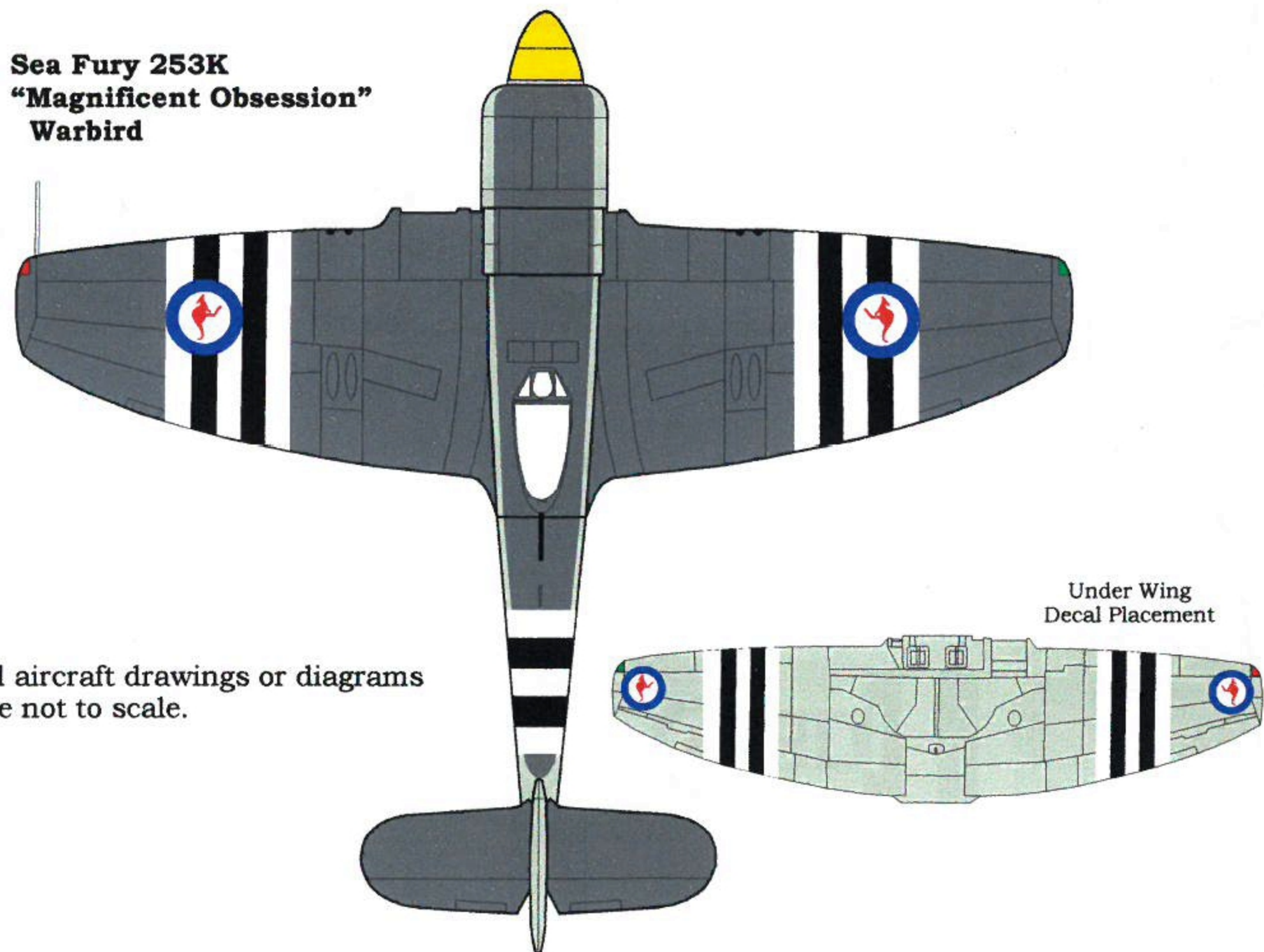
**Sea Fury FB.11 WH-589 / 115NW & WH-588 / 114NW 724 Sqn R.A.N.**

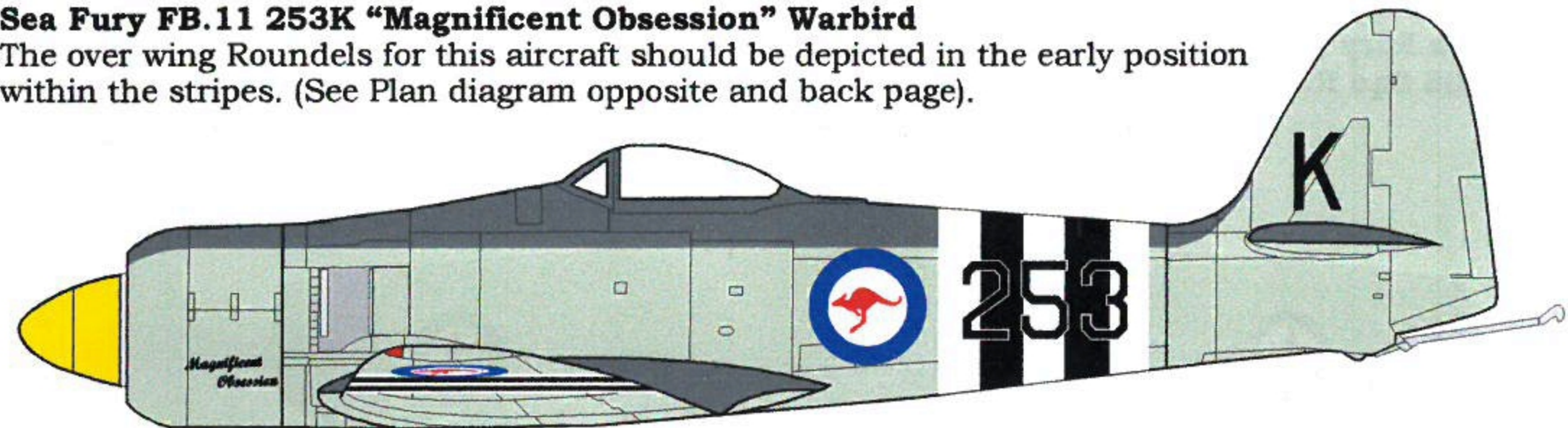
Only WH-588 / 114NW wore the thinner style "NW" markings as depicted. Both marking styles are included in this set.
