 March 1945, Overall Glossy Sea
 Blue, crudely painted Yellow
 nose. Black propellers with
 Yellow tips. Note position of
 individual aircraft number on
 each gear door.



F4U-1D, VF-84, USS Bunker
 Hill (CV-17), Okinawa, April
 1945, Glossy Sea Blue, Black
 propellers with Yellow tips.
 Aircraft number shown on gear
 door. Prop Hub, Glossy Sea Blue
 or Black. Another option for this
 A/C would be a Yellow cowd
 Ring with #171 on Blue square.



F4U-1D, VF8F-88, USS Yorktown
 (CV-10), July 1945, Glossy Sea
 Blue, Black propellers with
 Yellow tips. Aircraft number
 shown on gear doors.



F4U-4, USS Lake Champlain
 (CV-39), June 1945. Overall
 Glossy Sea Blue, and black
 propellers with yellow tips. Note
 position of individual aircraft
 number on gear doors. Natural
 Metal propellers Hub and spinner.



F4U-1C of VF8F-99, USS
 Shangri-La (CV-38), July 1945.
 Overall Glossy Sea Blue, Black
 propellers with Yellow tips and
 White individual aircraft number
 on each gear door. Pilot was Lt.
 Joe Robbins.



F4U-4 of VF-10, USS Intrepid
 (CV-11), Aug. 1945 (top). F4U-
 1D, USS Yorktown (CV-10),
 summer 1945 (below). Glossy
 Sea Blue. Propellers were Black
 with Yellow tips. Note the gear
 door numbers and the "dash 4" or
 all-white insignia.
