ВНИМАНИЕ!

Работать с клеем и красками в проветриваемом помещении и не допускать открытого огня.

Для сборки модели рекомендуется применять полистирольный клей ПС или его зарубежные аналоги.

Отделяя детали от литников, используйте модельный нож для зачистки.

Метод нанесения аппликаций

Чистым ножом или ножницами аккуратно вырежьте необходимую аппликацию.

Вырезанную аппликацию погрузите в теплую воду на 20 секунд. Приложив аппликацию к необходимому месту, аккуратно удалите

подложку.

Марлевым тампоном удалите пузырьки воздуха и слегка прижмите аппликацию.

После высыхания аппликаций влажным тампоном удалите остатки клея вокруг них.

CAUTION!

When you use glue or paint, do not use near open flame, and use in well ventilated room.

Glue and paint are not included.

When you take parts off from the runner frame, use a modeling scissors and trim excess plastic with a cutter or a file.

Correct Method for Applying Decals

Clean model surface with wet cloth.

Cut each design out of decal sheet and dip them in warm water for 20 seconds.

Check with finger tip if design is loose on base paper. If so, place it on proper position on model and slide off base paper leaving design on model.

Move design to exact position with wet finger tip, and push out excess water and air bubbles under decal with soft cotton cloth.

When decals get dry, wipe off with wet cloth excess glue left around decals.

For some reason a great respect in 92th regiment they have to **Maestro Леонід Биков**. Leonid Bikov (1928-1979) it was a screenwriter, director and actor in '1973 war drama B бой идут одни "старики" (Only "old man" go to the fight), about a squadron fighting for liberation of the Ukraine during Second World War.

Years ago the Su-15 #41 has its name, and since 1998 MiG-29 #70. After overhauls, an inscription "Maestro Leonid Bykov" and few musical notes are always carefully painted on fuselage. In fact, in nineties it was 9-12, later it was another 9-13 renumbered to #70 and christened "Maestro Leonid Bikov".

In December 1998, the 40th Hunting Wing of Ukrainian Air Force (now 40th Brigade of Tactical Aviation) in Vasilkov under the name Mig-29 (9-12) B / N 70 with note record, inscriptions "Maestro" from the front of the cabin and "Leonid Bikov" behind the cab on the hull. The specified aircraft was not in flight condition at the time.

In 2002, "Maestro" MIG-29 (9-13) has appeared as B / N 70. In the beginning, the aircraft was in a standard gray-green camouflage and with the inscriptions "Leonid Bikov" with white letters.

After a while, the board is transformed into gray, and the name of "Leonid Bikov" was updated in blue..

On drawing is MiG-29 #70 9-13, about 2007.





In 2007, the aircraft went to Lviv for repair, where he later received a standard gray-blue camouflage for the factory in Lviv, a new flight number 19 and released the honorary name. After the overhaul, the aircraft was operated by 204 BRTs and is currently (2022) at the occupied Belbek airport.



As he found out, recently in LDARZ was another remounted MIG-29 (b/n 09) received the honorary name Leonid Bikov, and the loads and inscriptions "Maestro" and "Leonid Bikov" were painted on the hull. However, according to unconfirmed information, there was an instruction that the inscriptions and paintings on the aircraft, are overpainted before moving into the unit.
