MILICAST INSTRUCTION LEAFLET

All kits in the MILICAST range are made from the highest quality Polyurethane Resin and can be cut, drilled or sanded with ease. However when working with any type of resin (or plastic) it is essential that caution is exercised, as the fine dust produced can cause irritation. We recommend the use of a face mask. Always WORK IN A WELL VENTILATED AREA.

Should any part be warped or distorted, then gentle heat, applied either by emmersion in hot water, or by using a hair dryer, will allow the part to be corrected to its original shape. NEVER USE A NAKED FLAME.

"SUPERGLUE" types or two part epoxy adhesives, ie. ARALDITE or DEVCON are recommended. Again it is stressed that CAUTION MUST BE EXERCISED when using this type of product.


