Much has been written in the last few years about the actual shade of the Japanese Navy Lt. Gray Color. The best article on this elusive color is by Ian Baker in his series on Japanese Colors and Markings. Some authors suggest that when the protective coating known as Ame-Hiro was used, the color turned into a lighter shade of RLM 02. We are only calling for the original color. If you want to accurately finish your kit, we recommend you do more research into this color and particular A/C. Food for thought...

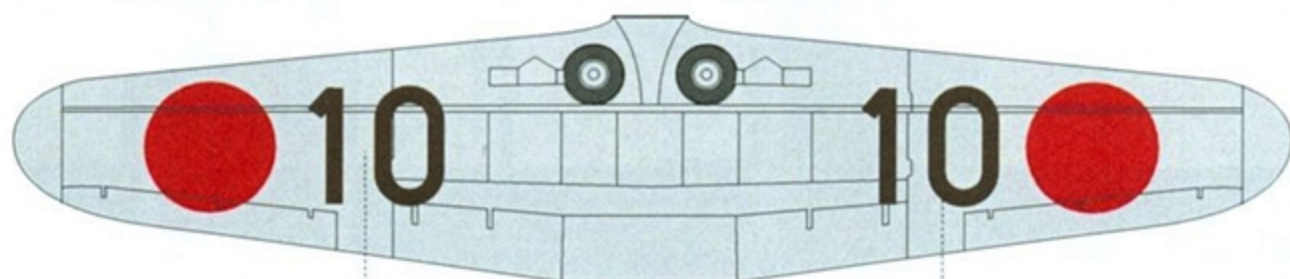


Note: It is not known if every Zero carried a cowl number, but photographic evidence suggests that most did.

Note: It is not confirmed that all Vals carried spat and/or cowl numbers - these are provided for your use if you choose to do so.

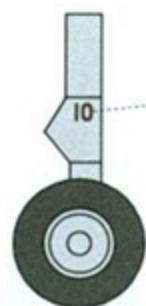


## A6M2 Zero
