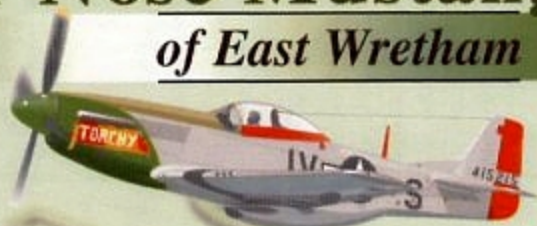

Natural metal finish.



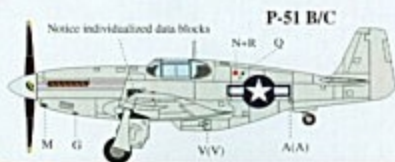

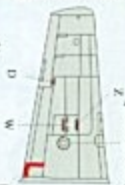
