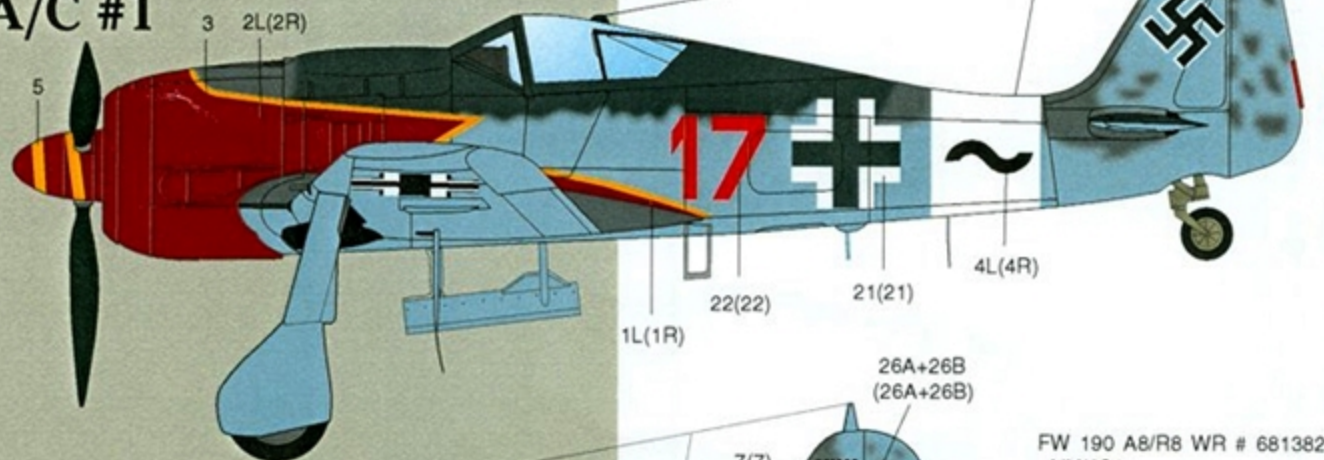
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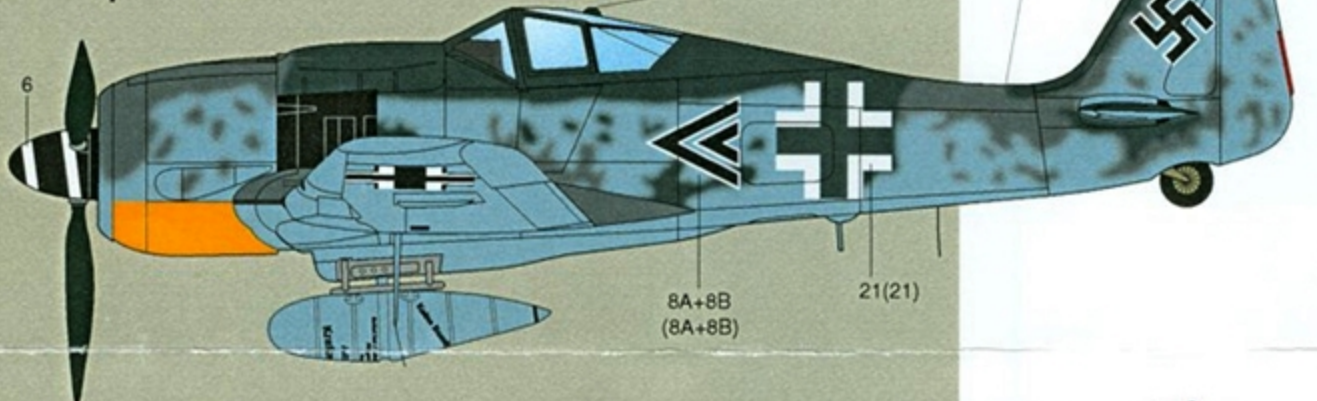
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FW 190 A8/R8 of IV/JG3 Probably flown by Feldwebel Willi Unger out of Ansbach, Germany. Unger later became the Staffel Kapitän of 12/JG3. Shot down at least once, he was credited with 22 victories, 19 being four-engine bombers. No upper deck guns.

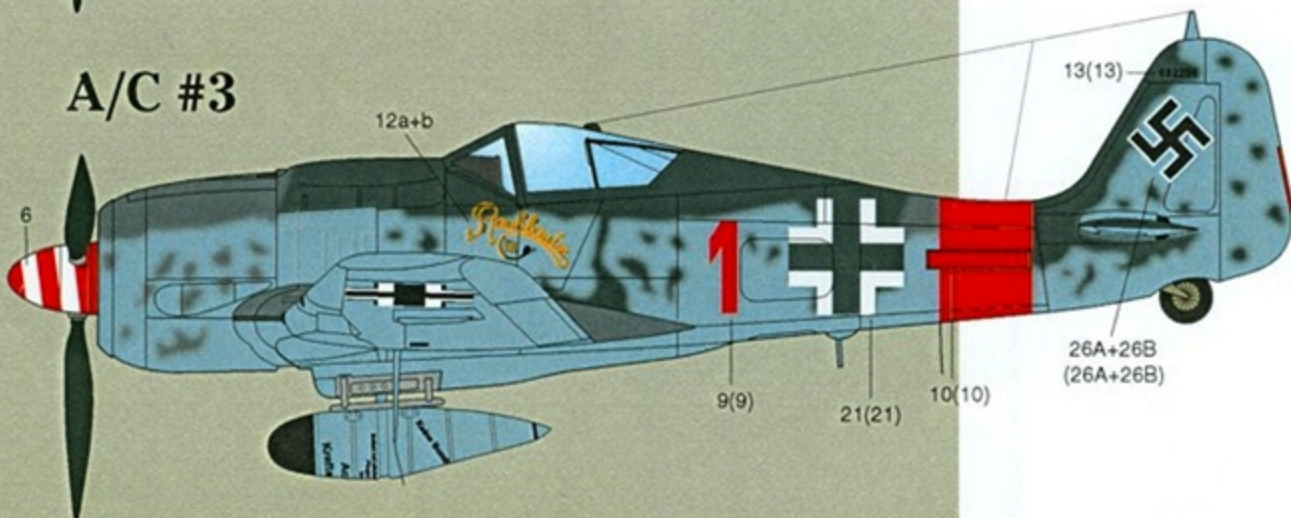

FW 190 A8/R8 WR # 681382 of IV/JG3

Flown by Hauptmann Wilhelm Moritz during August 1944. He scored 44 kills, 10 of them being four-engine bombers. Veteran of over 500 missions IV/JG3 became a sturmgruppe in April 1944. Their A/C had a 30mm armored glass attached to the front and sides of their canopies. No MG 131 were carried by the A/C in the cowlings. The gun troughs (holes) were faired over.

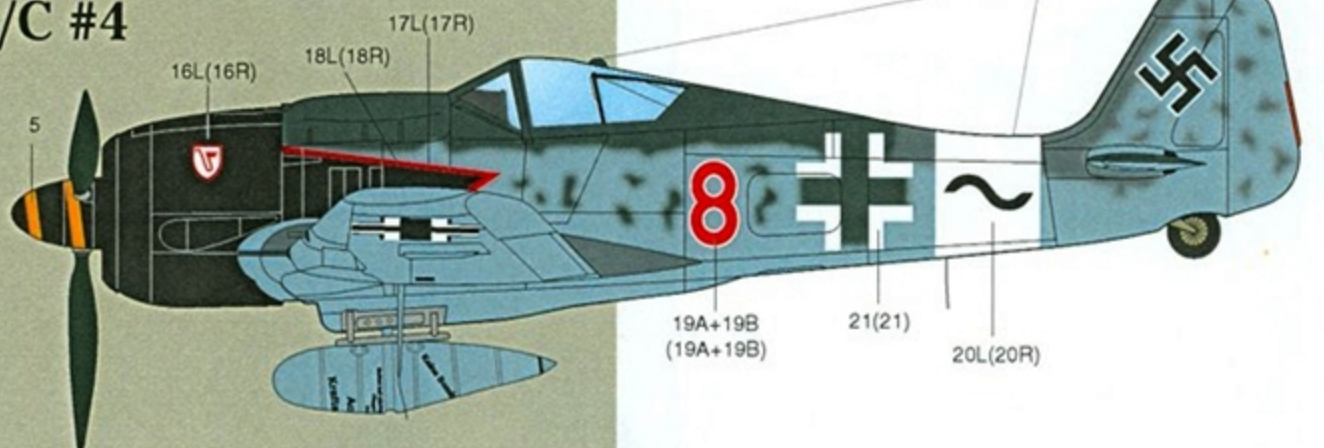

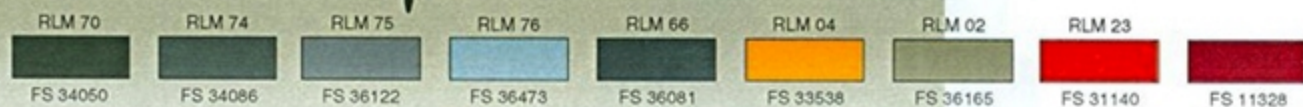
FW 190 A8/R2 WR # 682204 of 5/III/JG300. Flown by

Staffel Kapitän Klaus Brestschneider, October 1944. KPT Brestschneider was an ace with 31 kills, 19 of them being four-engine bombers. At one time this A/C had the lower cowling painted Red. KIA 12/24/44. No upper deck guns on this machine. Fuselage armor and cockpit front windshield armored glass windows were featured on this A/C.

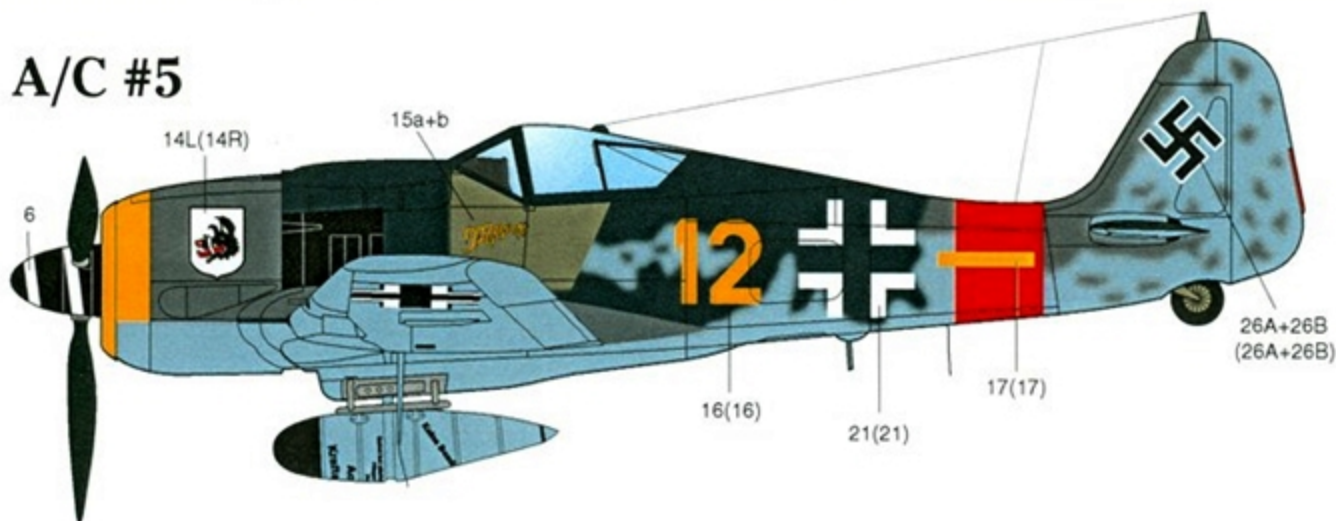
FW 190 A8/R8 of 11/IV/JG3. Flown by Unteroffizier Will Maximowitz, June 1944. A/C had the upper deck guns, as well as fuselage side armor. No D/F Loop on the bottom.



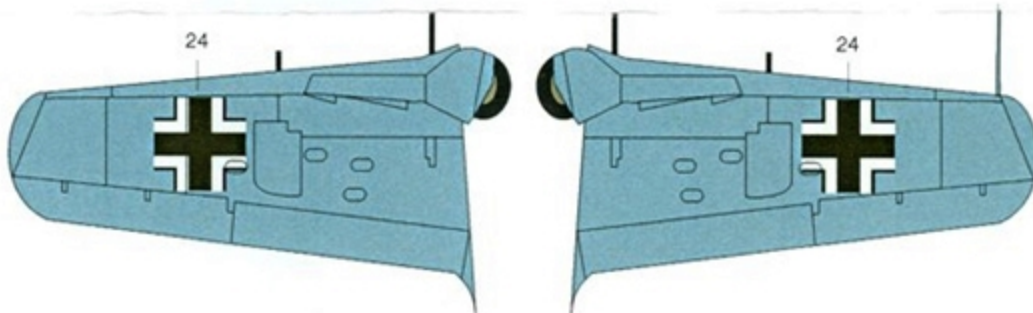
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FW 190 A8/R8 of 6/II/JG300. Flown by Unteroffizer Paul Lixfeld Nov. 1944. Due to the seriousness of the situation in the skies over Germany in July 1944, JG300 was reorganized as a Stürm Gruppe. This A/C was lost in combat on December 17, 1944, and wears an unusually strange camouflage color over the fuselage, consisting of a very Dark Gray, possibly RLM 66. Upper deck guns seem to have been removed and faired over.

Color Notes:

All the A/C featured on this sheet were camouflaged in the standard luftwaffe scheme of RLM 74/75 over 76. Cockpit interiors were RLM 66 with wheel wells, struts etc, RLM 02. Spinners were black or Red with spiral as depicted. Propeller blades were RLM 70.

On A/C 1, red 17, we used F.S. 11328 as the closest match to the wine red nose color featured on this aircraft. We suggest you match your paint as close as possible to the decal color (item 2L & 2R).
