VMAT-102 "Skyhawks"


VMAT-102 was activated on 1 January 1969 and flew A-4Cs. In 1970, the unit began receiving A-4Es and flew these along with A-4Fs and the TA-4J. 1975 brought the A-4M to the squadron and these were flown along with TA-4Js until the squadron was disestablished in 1987. The squadron was responsible for the training of ground attack pilots in all aspects of the A-4. The squadron also provided technical training for maintenance personnel.

VMA-322 "Fighting Gamecocks"

VMA-322 flew the A-4C from 1962 until the early 1970s when these were replaced by the A-4E. The A-4Ms were received in 1984 and the squadron flew this version until its deactivation in 1992.

VMA-311 "Tomcats"

Formerly stationed at Iwakuni, Japan, this squadron was disestablished in 1974 while flying the A-4E. After dispersing of personnel, the squadron was reestablished at MCAS Beaufort, SC with the A-4M in 1974. The squadron flew this aircraft until 1988 when it began to transition to the AV-8B Harrier. It was at this time that they moved to their current home at MCAS Yuma, AZ.
