Eagle wing emblem on both sides of fuselage. Outboard guns intact

Colors: RLM 65 undersurfaces; uppersurfaces RLM 02 Gray/RLM 71 dark Green, possibly RLM 76/75/74, Yellow rudder Yellow undercowling. Ten white victory bars with RAF roundels on both sides of rudder

National Markings: Fuselage; B2 800 mm Black and White crosses with Black outline

H2 Black and White with Black outline Hakenkreuz

Wings: Upper, B2 910 mm Black and White crosses with Black outline Lower, B2 900 mm Black/White crosses with Black outline

"Blue 6" Fw 190 A-1 W. Nr. 080 10/JG 2

No outboard wing guns, Fw 190 A-1s had MG 17 machine guns in the inboard position that do not protrude through the leading edge of the wing, Some A-1 aircraft were updated with inboard MG 151 20 mm cannons. Later open louvers behind engine cowl, same as A-2, A-3; A-1 style canopy bracing. Since 10./JG 2 was a Jabo unit which required ETC 501 racks, it is optional on this aircraft. At the time photos were taken of "Blue 6" no ETC rack was installed. Colors: Undersurfaces, RLM 65; uppersurfaces RLM 02 Gray/RLM 71 Dark Green

Spinner and prop; RLM 70 Black-Green. Yellow rudder and undercowling. W. Nr. 080 on both sides of upper fin

Wings: Upper, B2 910 mm Black and White crosses with Black outline Lower, B2 900 mm Black and White crosses with Black outline

No outboard wing guns.

Colors: Undersurfaces, RLM 76; Uppersurfaces RLM 71 Dark Green/RLM 70 Black-Green

Spinner and props RLM 70, White tip on spinner, Yellow under cowling, Yellow fuselage band and Yellow lower portion of rudder

National Markings: Fuselage B2 800 mm Black and White crosses with Black outline

H2a Black and White Hakenkreuz

Wings: Upper, B2 910 mm Black and White crosses with Black outline

Lower, B2 900 mm black/white with black outline

The number '539' is on both sides of the fin in White; JG 51 Hawk's head on port side only. I./JG 51 mountain goat emblem on port side under windscreen.

"White 6" Fw 190 A-2 Pilot: Fw. Otto Kleinert 7./JG 2

Outboard guns intact; A-1 style canopy bracing; FuG 25a antenna. Black and White eagle wing with thin Black outline on both sides of fuselage.

Colors: Undersurfaces RLM 65, Uppersurfaces RLM 02 Gray/RLM 71 Dark Green; Yellow rudder and undercowling Spinner and prop RLM 70 Black-Green

National Markings: Fuselage B2 800 mm Black and White crosses with Black outline

H2a Black and White Hakenkreuz

Wings: Upper, B2 910 mm Black and White crosses with Black outline

Lower, B2 900 mm Black and White with Black outline

II./JG 2 Rooster head emblem on both sides of cowling.
