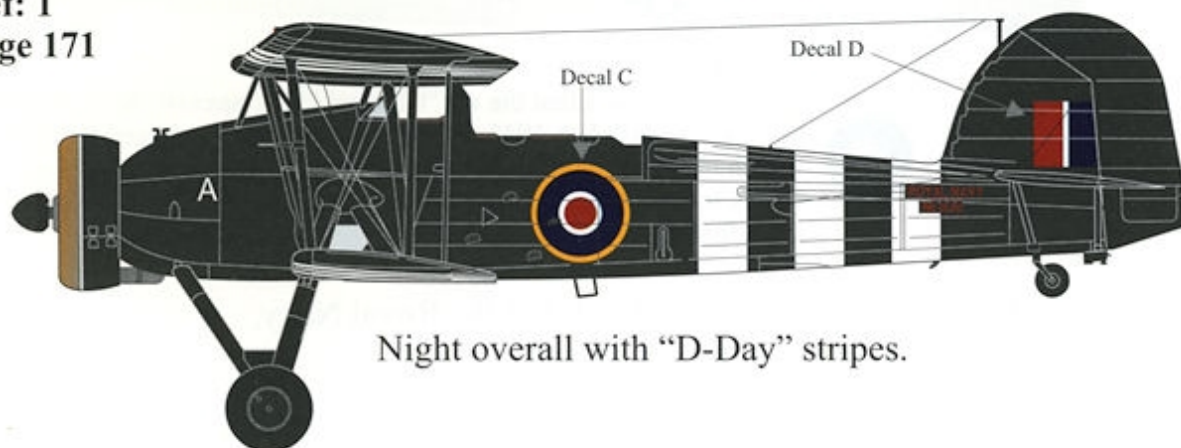


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**Scheme 1:** Swordfish Mk.II, NE932/A of 819 Sqn., Fleet Air Arm, circa June 1944.

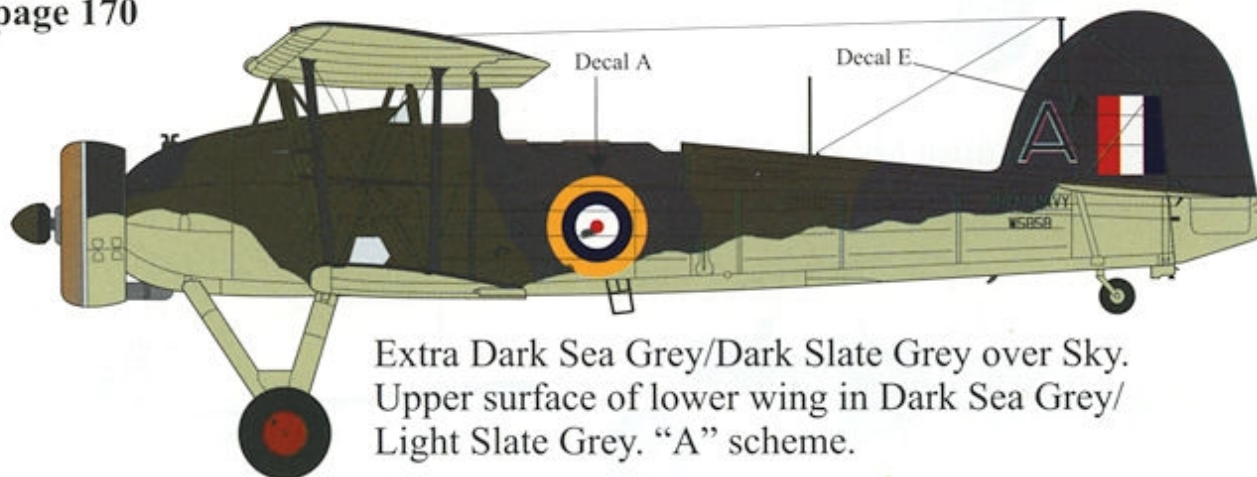

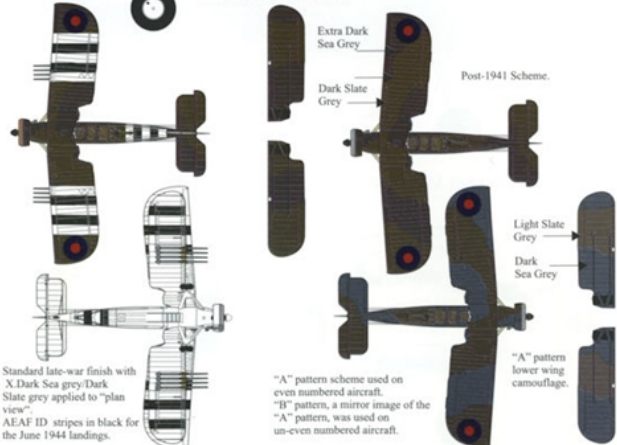


**NOTES:**
