# FV 432 Mk.2/1

## Armoured Personnel Carrier

The FV432 is the armored personnel carrier variant of British Army's VF430 series of AFV. Since its introduction in the 1960, it has been the most common variant being used for transporting infantry on the battlefield. In the 1980, almost 2500 vehicles were in use, with around 1500 now remaining in operation—mostly in supporting arms rather than front-line infantry service.

Although the FV432 series was to have been phased out of service in favour of newer vehicles, such as the Warrior & the CVR(T) series. 500 have been upgraded to extend their service into the next decade.
