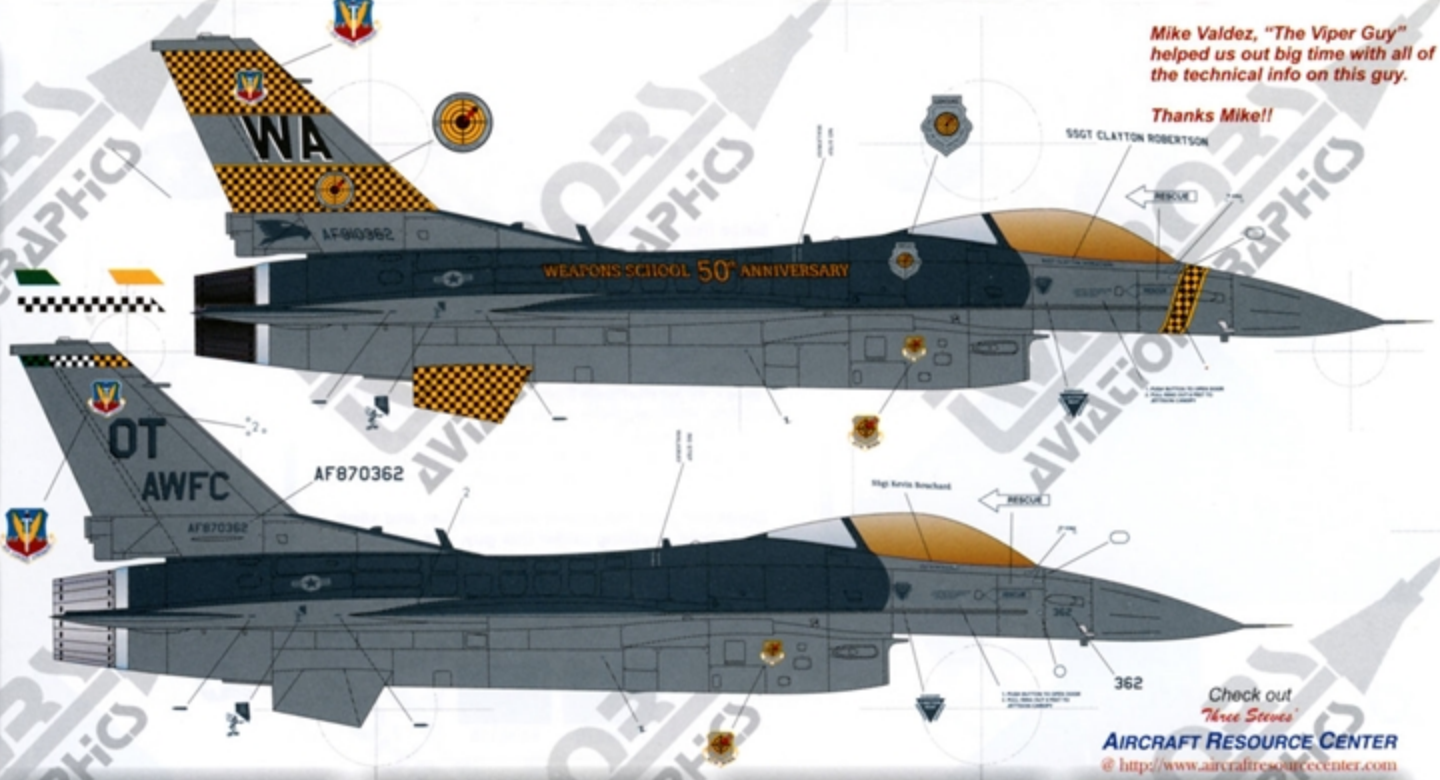
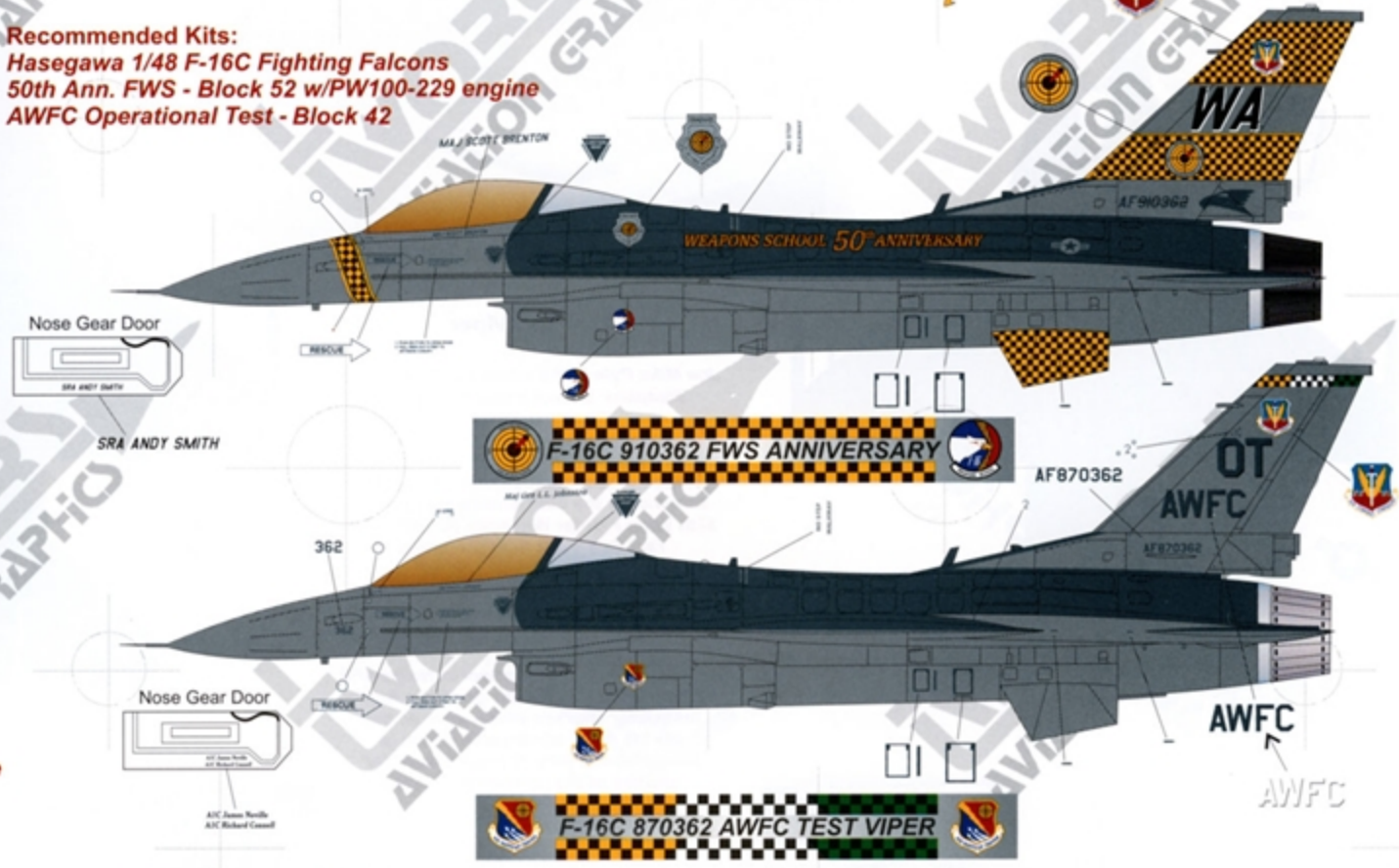

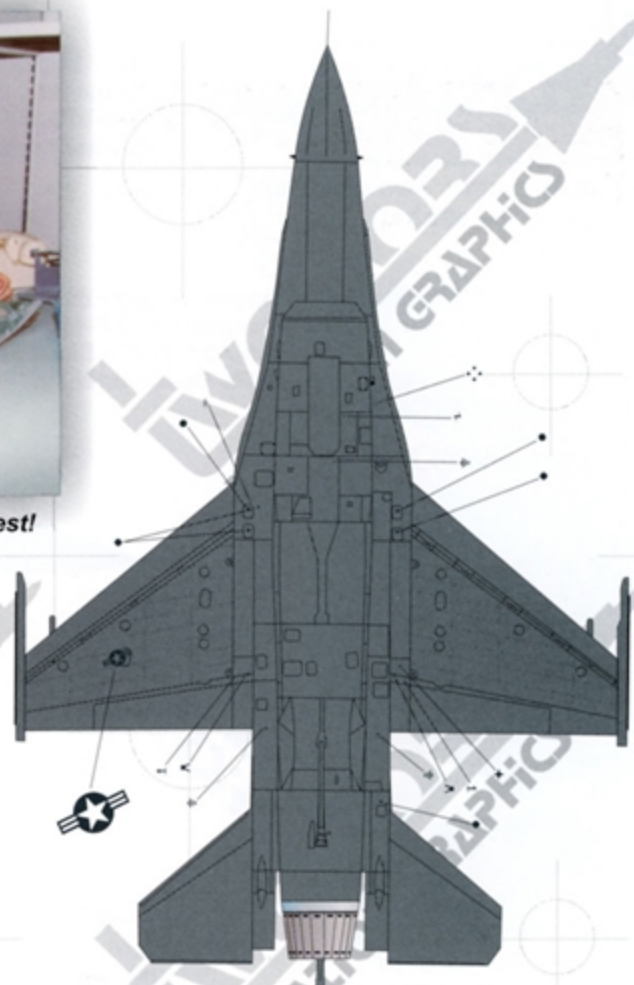

Cool thing about doing both these jets is that they both give you lots of ordinance options.

91-0362:

Since this is a Block 52 jet it's usually carrying an HTS pod. It's been seen with HARMs on the wing stations and AMRAAM missiles on the wing tips. Centerline station usually has an ALQ-131 ECM pod.

87-0362:

Block 42 jet that's an Eglin AFB bird assigned to the 57th Wing at Nellis. Has been used for a bunch of test missions in the past. Right now it's dedicated to testing NVIS (Night Vision Instrument System) technology. Basically NVG stuff.

Break out your Hasegawa Weapons Set and sling just about anything under this guy. It's probably carried it at one time or another! This jet is the workhorse of the 57th Wing as far as weapons separation testing, etc, etc, etc.... The list goes on and on....
