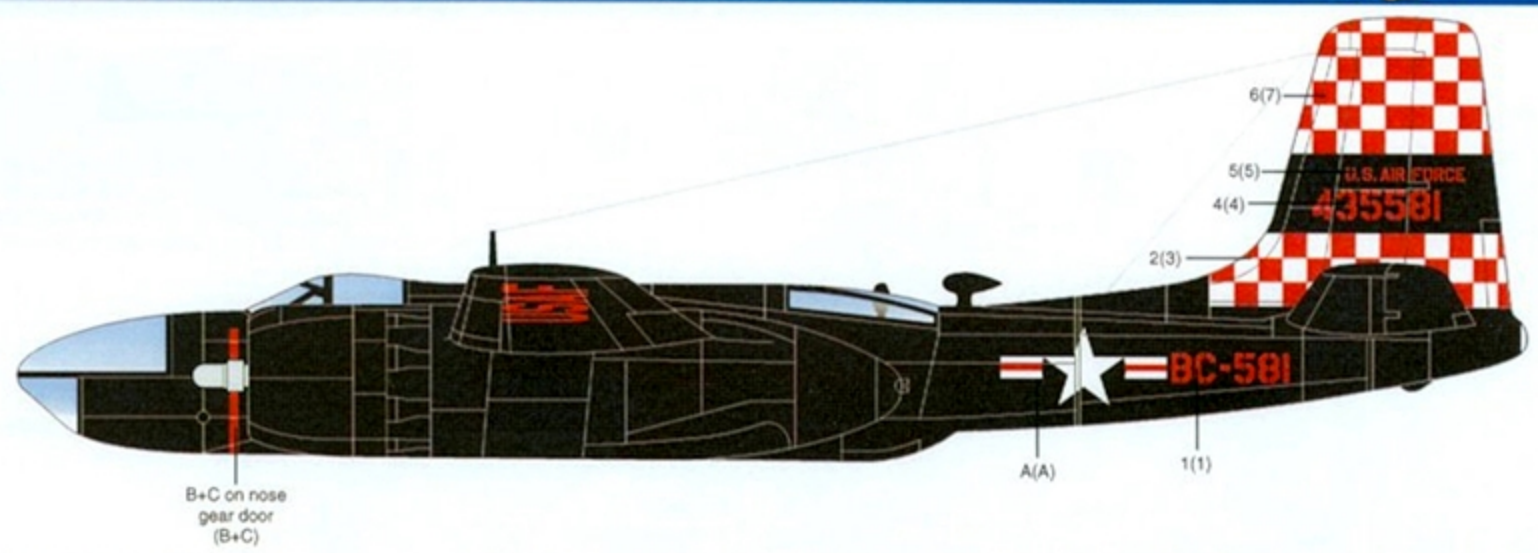

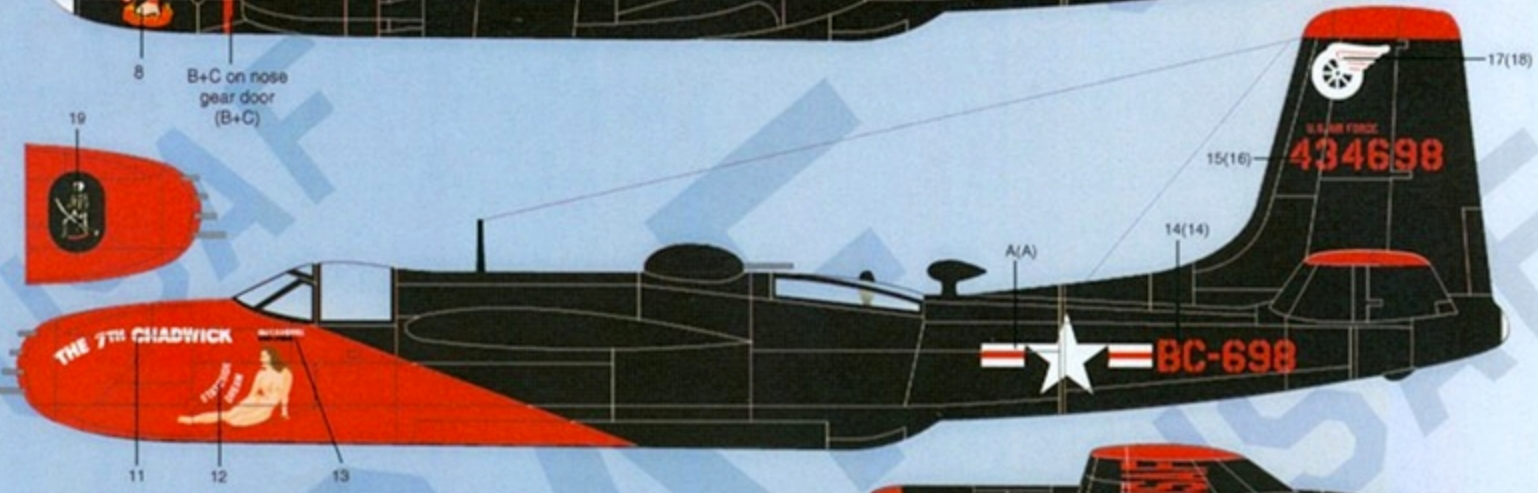
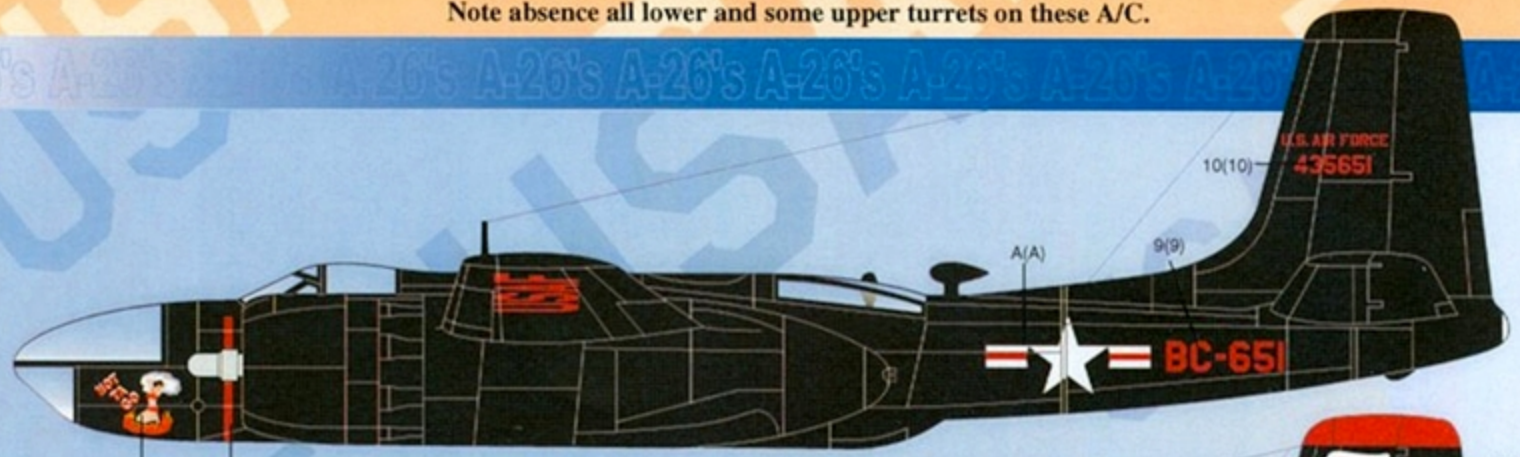


RB-26C, 44-35581, 363rd Tactical Reconnaissance Wing, Shaw AFB, SC, 1954. Overall Gloss Black with Flat Black anti-glare forward of windscreen. Red prop warning stripe. Very heavy exhaust staining on nacelles.

RB-26C, 44-35651, Hot Ta Go, 12th Tactical Reconnaissance Sqdn, Kimpo AB, Korea, 1953. Overall Gloss Black with Flat Black anti-glare forward of wind-screen. Prop hubs Natural Metal. Heavy exhaust staining on nacelles.

B-26B, 44-34698, "The 7th Chadwick", 13th Bomb Squadron, 3rd Bomb Group, Korea, April/May 1952. Flown by Lt. Col. Robert Fortney, commander of the 13th BS. Overall Gloss Black with Gloss Red wing, tail and stabilizer tips. Entire nose section is Red. Scallop on engine cowlings Gloss Red.

Note absence all lower and some upper turrets on these A/C.

 Both aircraft carried the FEAF modified 5" rocket rails under the wings. These consisted of standard stub mounts with attached rails. Both aircraft also carried internal wing .50 cal. machine guns.
