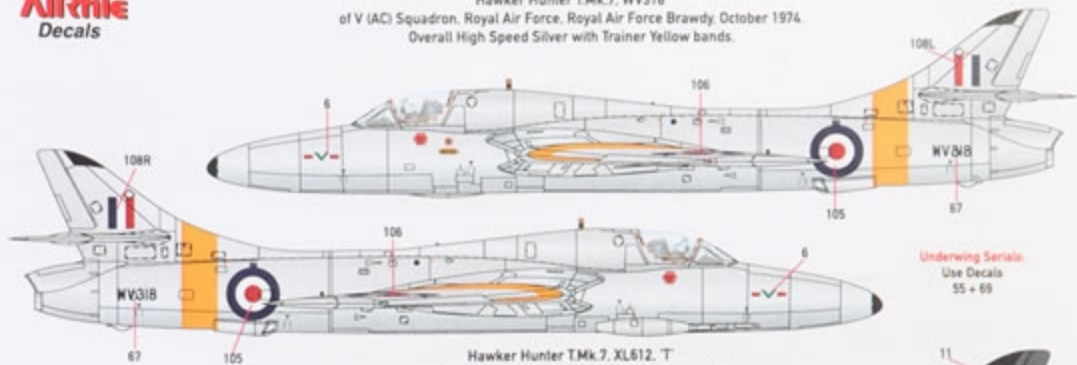

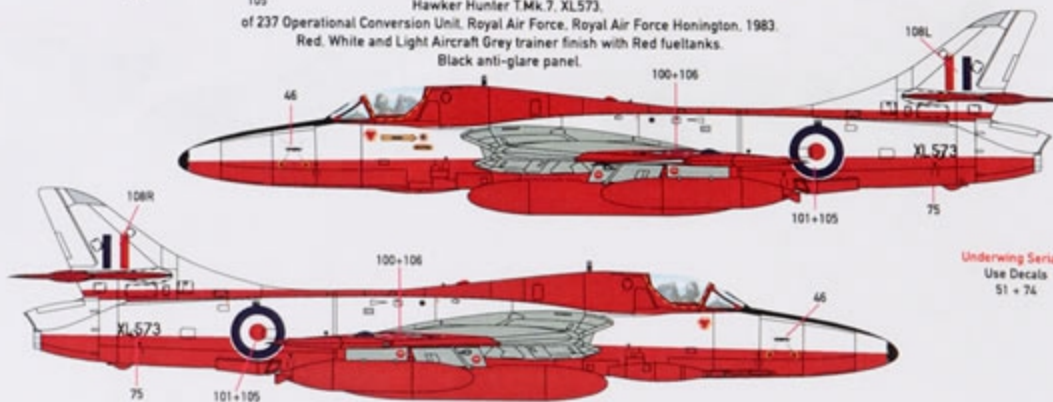

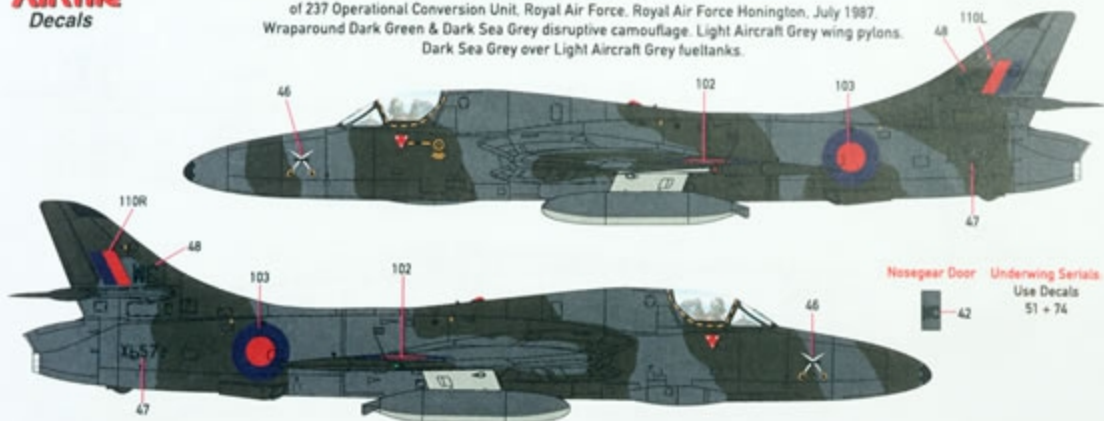

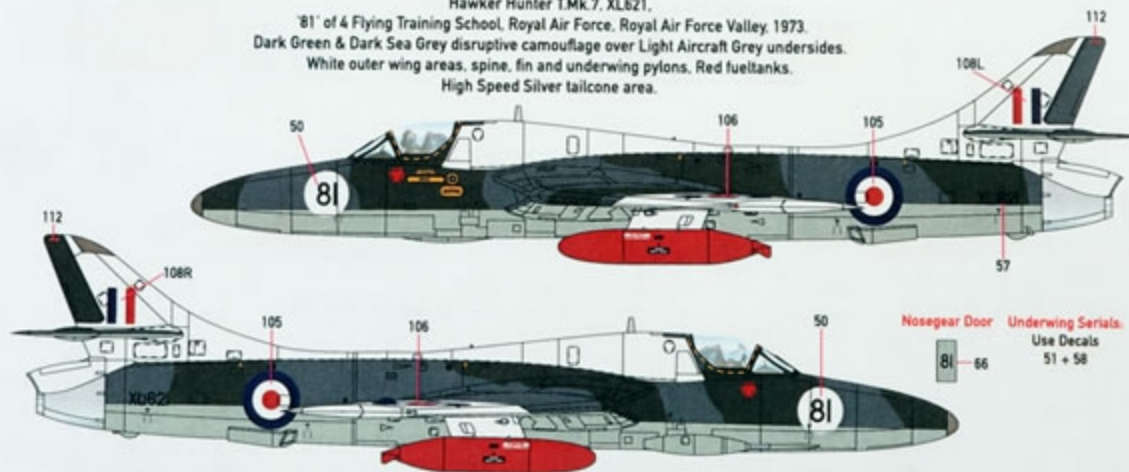

 High Speed Silver tailcone area.

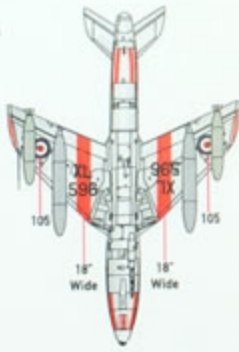




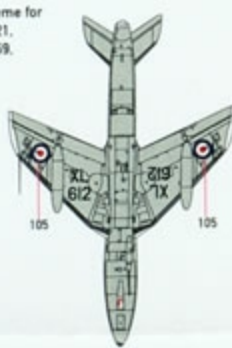

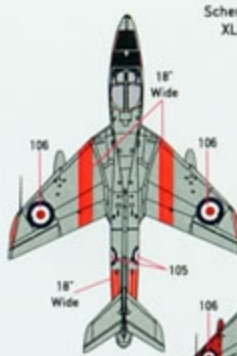
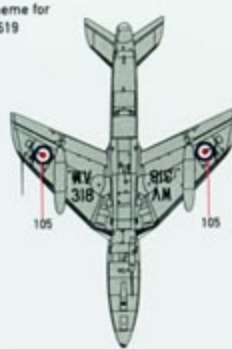
Camouflage Scheme for

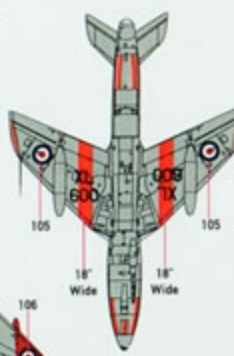

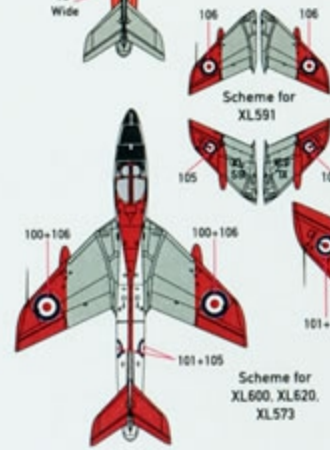
