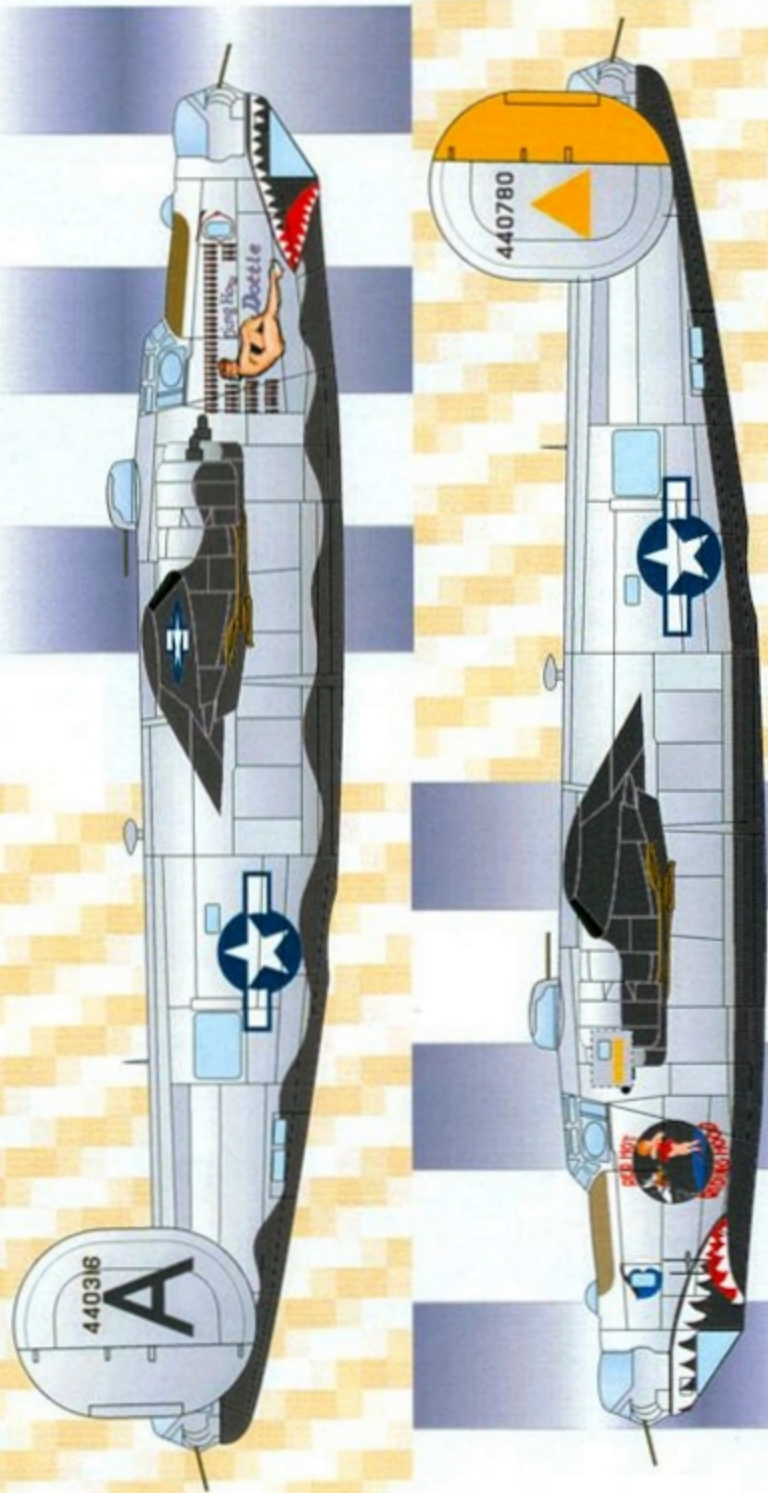

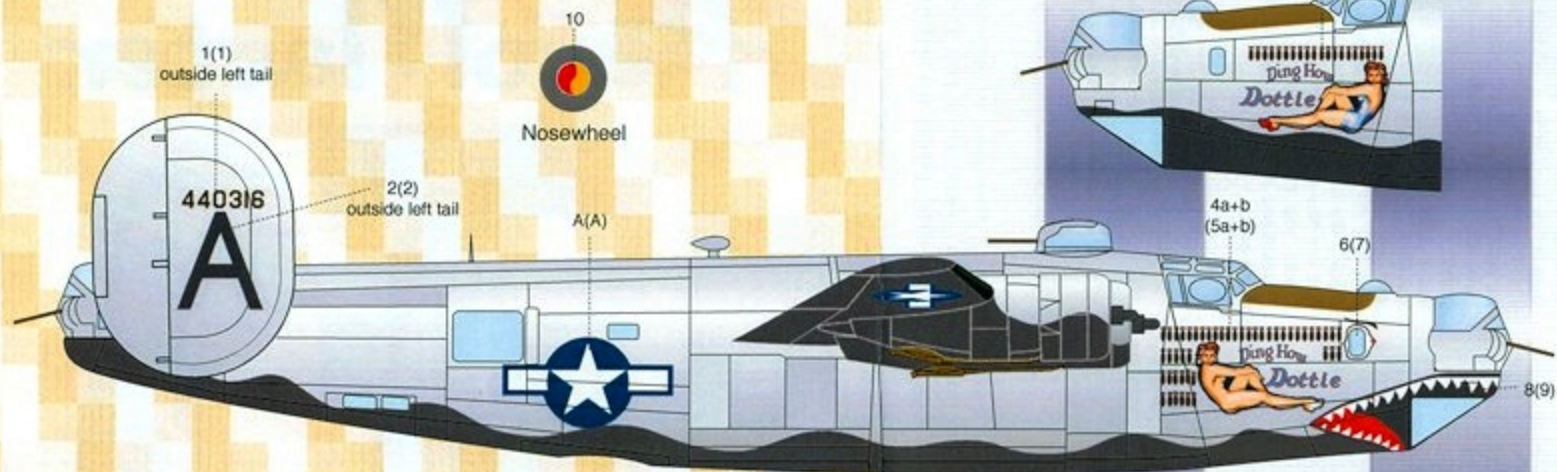

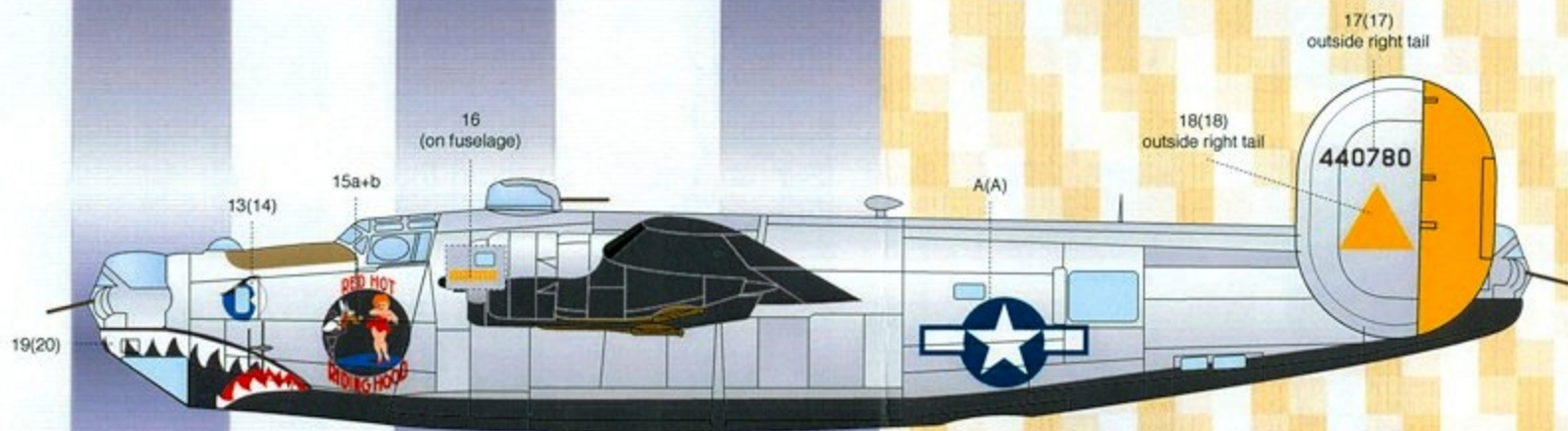


Suggested Kit: Monogram B 24J Liberator.





Aircraft 1 - B-24J-155-CO 44-40316 'Ding How Dottie', 373rd BS, 308th BG. Luliang, China, September 1944. Natural metal uppersurfaces, Black undersides with soft demarcation line. Olive Drab antiglare panel. No deicer boots. Late version shown, A/C may have had Red rudders at a late date. Early version did not carry the sharkmouth or eyes.



Aircraft 2 - B-24J-180-CO 44-40780 'Red Hot Riding Hood', 374th BS, 308th BG. Lost due to a mid-air explosion October 9, 1944 during a single-ship mine laying operation to Hankow, China. Natural metal uppersurfaces, Black undersides with hard demarcation line. Outside of both rudders Yellow. Very faded Olive Drab antiglare panel. No deicer boots. SCR-729 radar antennas on nose.

Paint antiglare panels as per kit instructions.
