






Note: to ensure proper placement of 4(5) & 2(3), apply hats separately.

Bf 109C-2 of 10.(N)/JG 26, based at Jever, Autumn 1939. Upper surface camouflage RLM 70 & 71, under surfaces RLM 65. Fuselage band and under wing tips yellow. Spinner RLM 70 (black green).





