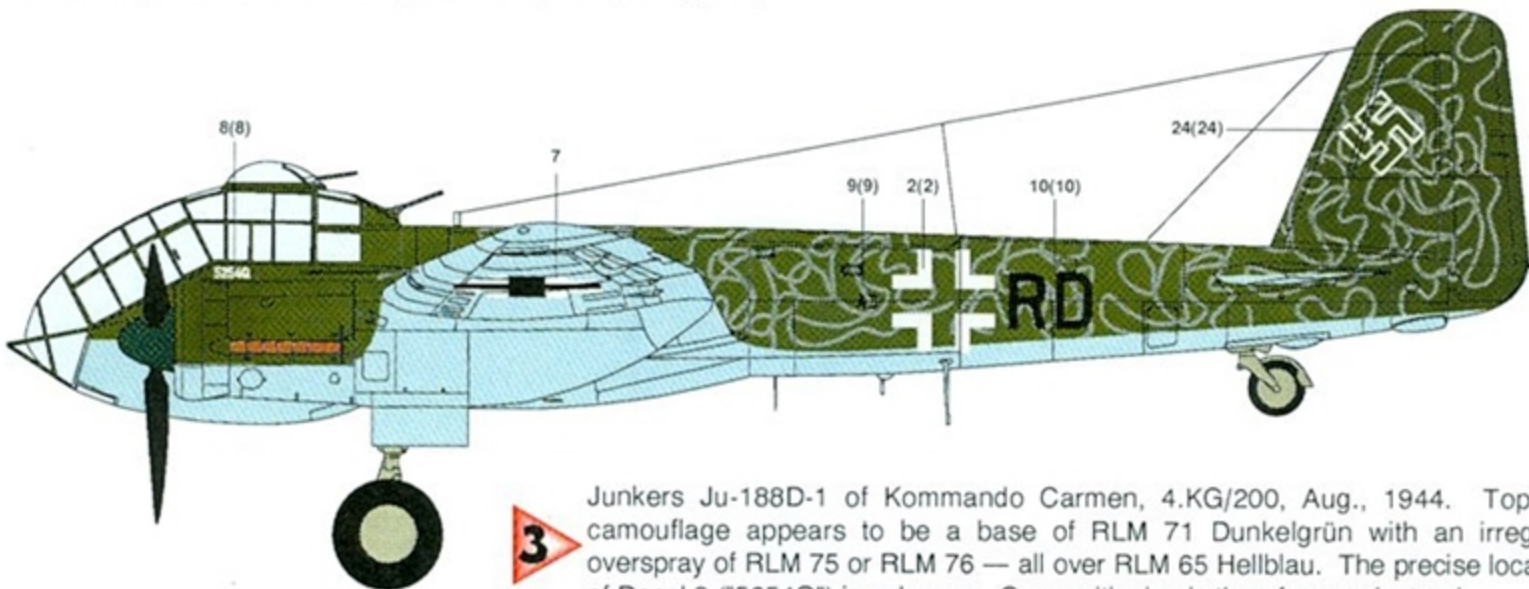

**1** Junkers Ju-188F-2 (W.Nr.280228) of 6.(F)/122, Aug., 1944. Probable colors are a base of RLM 71 Dunkelgrün over RLM 65 Hellblau, with a dense, irregular overspray of RLM 75 or RLM 76 (top) and RLM 66 black or RLM 22 Schwarzgrau beneath.



**2** Junkers Ju-188D-1 (W.Nr.230499) of 4.(F)/122 was the machine in which Vichy Prime Minister Pierre Laval escaped to Spain in May, 1945. Standard night bomber scheme of RLM 70 Schwarzgrün and RLM 71 Dunkelgrün over RLM 22 black. Except for the underwing cross, all original military insignia are painted out — possibly in RLM 66 Schwarzgrau. Note spiral (not supplied).



**3** Junkers Ju-188D-1 of Kommando Carmen, 4.KG/200, Aug., 1944. Topside camouflage appears to be a base of RLM 71 Dunkelgrün with an irregular overspray of RLM 75 or RLM 76 — all over RLM 65 Hellblau. The precise location of Decal 8 ("5254Q") is unknown. Our positioning is therefore conjectural.

**4** An Italian-front rarity, this Arado Ar234B-2 (W.Nr.140142) of Kommando Sommer was shot down in April, 1945. Colors appear to be one of the two standard Arado schemes — RLM 81 Braunviolet and RLM 82 Dunkelgrün over RLM 76 Hellgrau, in this case.
