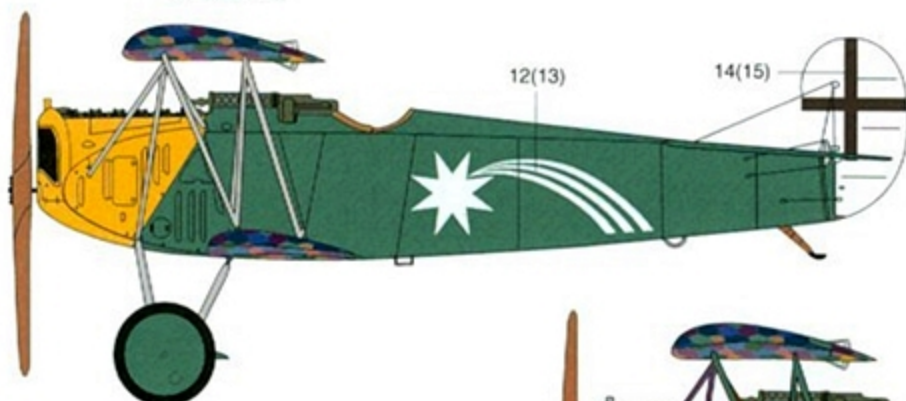
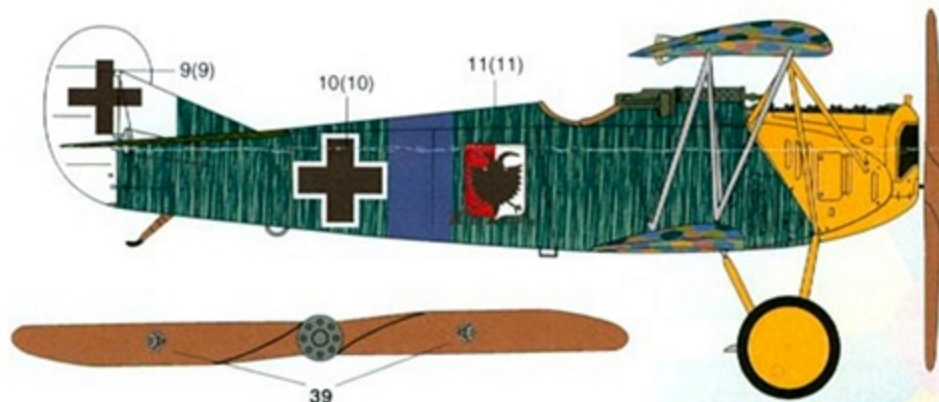
A/C Type	Fokker DVII.
Pilot & Unit	Ltn. R. Hans Schultz, Jasta 18.
Locale & Date	1918.
Camouflage & Markings	Front and Top in Deep Vermilion. Rear portion in White. Lower surfaces of both planes and upper surface of lower plane in 4 color lozenge fabric. Tail planes in Black.



A/C Type	Fokker DVII (Albatross Built).
Pilot & Unit	Unknown pilot, Jasta 18.
Date	1918
Camouflage & Markings	As per A/C 1, except tail planes in Red. All struts are Red.

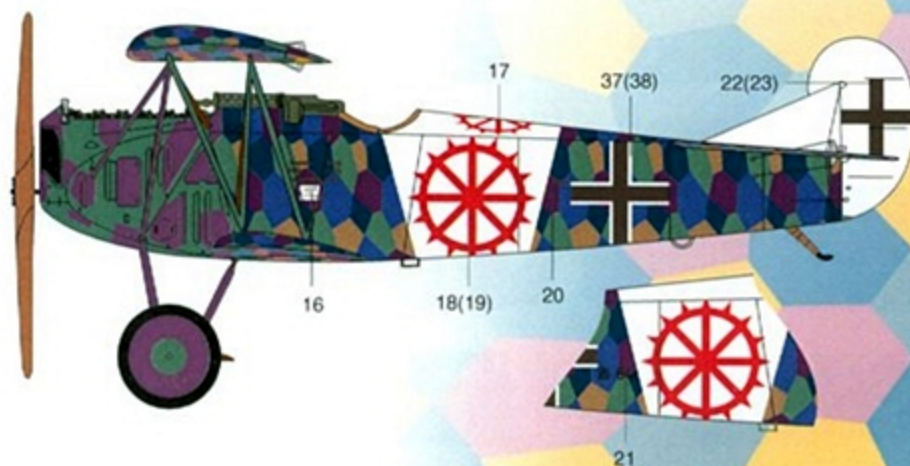
A/C Type	Fokker DVII 309/19.
Pilot & Unit	Ltn. "Fritz" Friedrichs, Jasta 10.
Date	1918.
Camouflage & Markings	Streaky Green fuselage w/ Turquoise undersurfaces. Five color printed fabric on both wings. Chrome yellow on nose panels, wheel covers, and undercarriage struts. Gray wing struts.

Remarks Fuselage cross converted by overpainting and a band ahead of it is shown as blue, but its true color is not known.



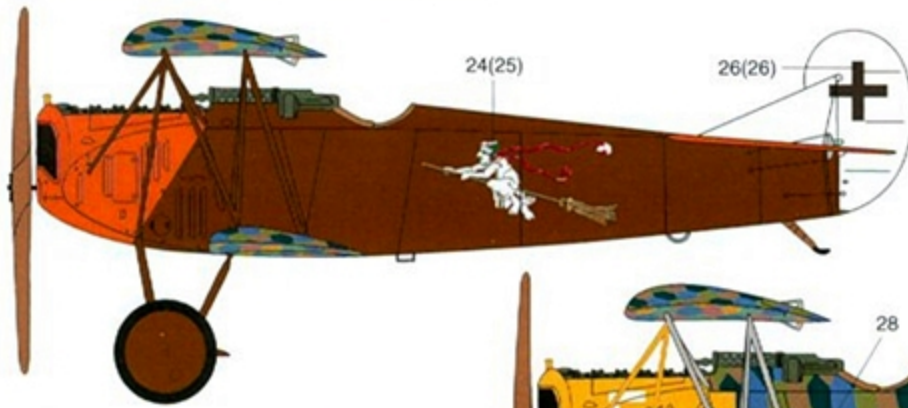
A/C Type	Fokker DVII.
Pilot & Unit	Oblt. Harald Auffahrt, Jasta 29.
Date	1918.
Camouflage & Markings	Green Fuselage and Yellow nose markings. Forward portion of fin painted White in the field. Wings covered in five color lozenge fabric. Wings and landing gear struts are Gray.

A/C Type	Fokker DVII (OAW- Built).
Pilot & Unit	Oblt. Hasso Von Wedel, Jasta 24.
Date	1918.
Camouflage & Markings	Hard-edged Green/ Mauve engine panels. Axel, wing, and A/C are covered with Five color printed fabric overall with White rudder. Mauve and Green wheel covers. Green Wing struts and Mauve intercabane & landing gear struts.

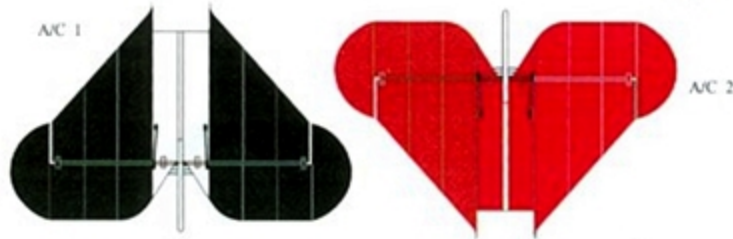

 Camouflage & Markings Brown fuselage. Orange tailplane and cowling. All struts are brown.



A/C Type Fokker DVII (OAW-Built).  
 Pilot & Unit Lt. Karl Kuehn, Jasta 33.  
 Camouflage & Markings Four color printed fabric overall with Yellow applied to forward fuselage and wheels. Gray wing struts and Yellow intercabane & landing gear struts.
