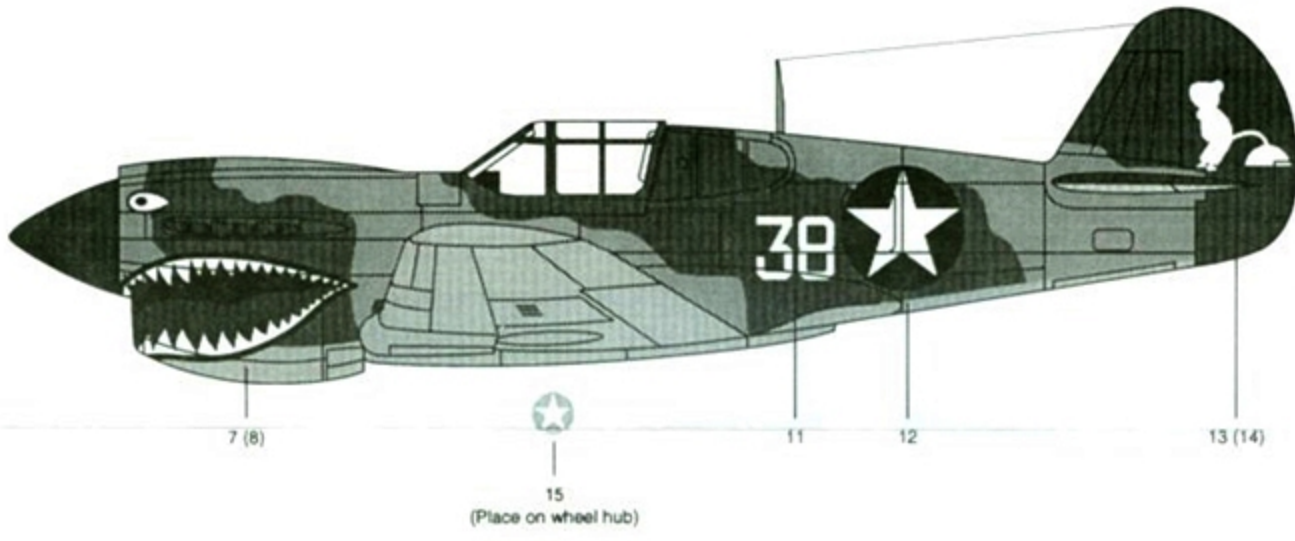

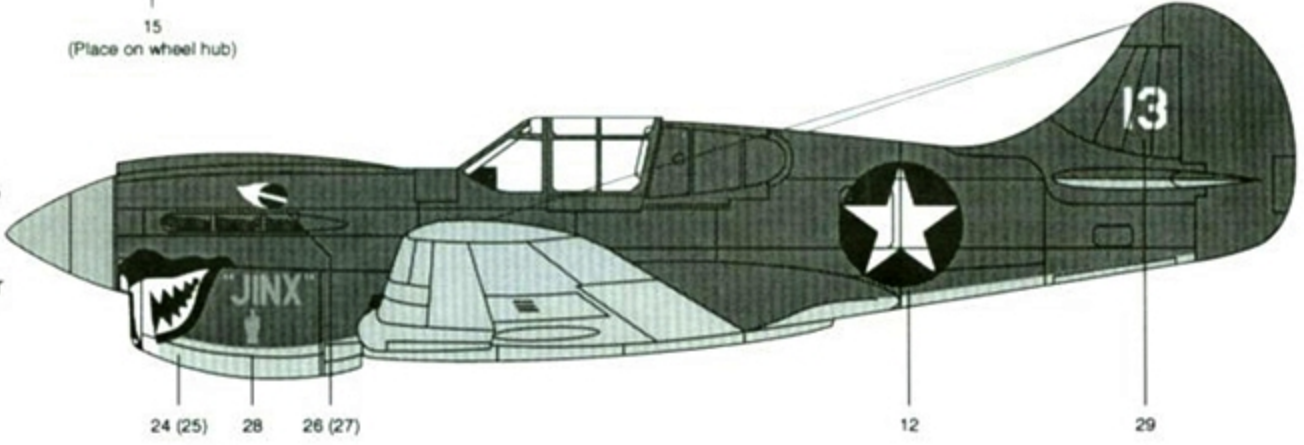
P-40E-1, 11th FS, 343rd FG,  
 Kiska, Alaska, 1942. Olive drab  
 and neutral grey camouflage with  
 white fuselage and rudder  
 stripes. Spinner yellow.



P-40E, 16th FS, 51st FG,  
 Peishihwa, China, October  
 1943. Dark earth (FS 30118),  
 sand (FS 30279) and azure  
 blue (FS 35231) camouflage  
 with red spinner.



P-40K-5 "Jinx", 25th FS, 52nd FG,  
 Dinjan, India, 1943. Neutral grey  
 43 upper surfaces with medium  
 grey (exact shade unknown) lower  
 surfaces. Spinner light blue.



P-40K-20, 42-29985, training aircraft from the AAF  
 Technical Center, Orlando Field, Florida, 1943. Olive  
 drab and neutral grey camouflage with dark green  
 patches on tail. Spinner is yellow, red, blue and white  
 (from front). Note that this is a long tailed P-40K with a  
 P-40N type carburetor intake on the forward cowl.
