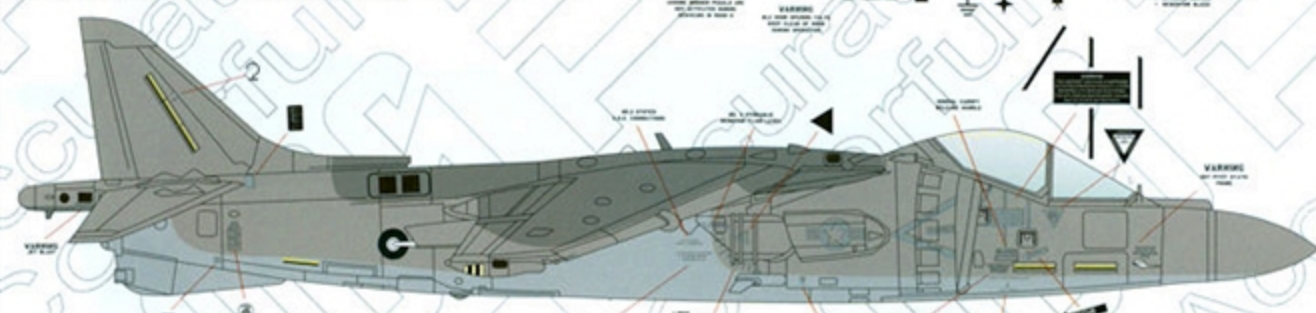


There are two flavors of loadouts that Harriers typically fly with during OIF. These loadouts were carried for 95% of the missions. The loads were optimized for destruction of the enemy and "bring back" capability since they were operating off the ship.

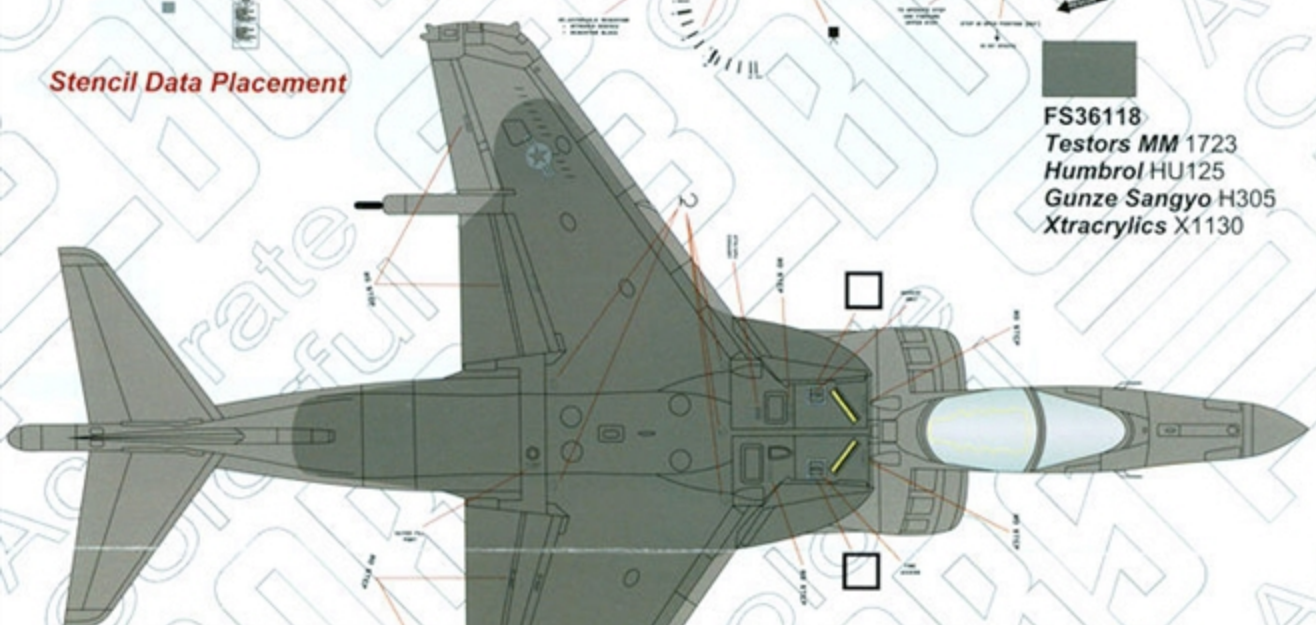
Typically these A/C worked in a four-ship configuration with two of the A/C carrying LiteningII and the other two carrying strictly GBU's.

**Litening II Loadout:** No AIM-9s and no guns; Station 5 - Litening II; Station 2/6 - Wing Tanks; Station 3 - GBU-16 or GBU-12.

**Non Litening II Loadout:** No AIM-9s and no guns; Station 3/5 - Wing Tanks; Station 2/6 - GBU-12 or GBU-16.

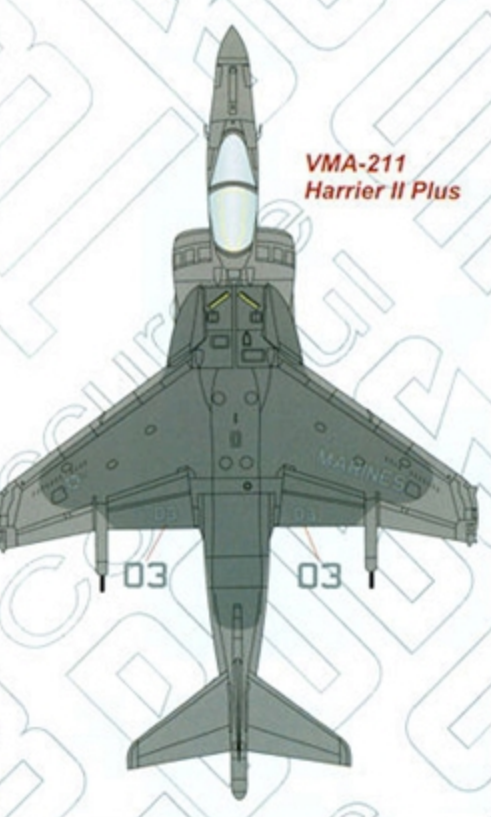
