



This Fitter K, yellow 546, of JBG77 carried special markings commemorating the last East German Air Force Su-22 flights prior to the reunification of the two German republics. The aircraft wears the standard colors consisting of Dark Green, Light Green, Mid-Brown and dark Earth over Light Blue-Gray. Yellow trim was applied to the vertical fin, leading edge slats, pitot tubes, and foward gear doors, as well as the drop tanks. The fuselage has Blue, Yellow and Red stripes and a Quality Maintenance Award for the ground crew applied to the foward port side (decals 9a+9b). Modelers should note that the port and starboard commemorative markings are not identical as they were hand painted. The aircraft also carries the standard dark green intake shock cone, transponder filter fin aerial, and dielectric fin fairing.

A/C #2

Yellow 13, an East German Fitter K assigned to JBG 77 based at Laage. The Fitter is painted in Dark Green, Light Green, Mid-Brown and Dark Earth over Light Blue-Gray. The aircraft also carries the standard detail colors on the intake shock cone, transponder filter fin aerial, and dielectric fin fairing. Due to the quality of the reference photo, it could not be positively determined if the yellow 13 was or was not stencilled. Two versions are supplied (decals 19 & 20), but we believe that the stencilled variety is the most likely (decal 20).
