 Locale & Date Eastern Front, early 1942.

Camouflage & Markings RLM 74/75/76 with White duster paint over. The A/C has a worn out appearance due to the White color washing off. Yellow lower cowling. Spinner is segmented in 1/2 RLM 25 and White.

A/C Type BF-109F-4.
 Pilot & Unit III. JG.3 "Udet".
 Locale & Date Russian Front, 1942.

Camouflage & Markings RLM 74/75/76 with White duster paint over. The A/C has a worn out appearance due to the White color washing off. Yellow lower cowling, rudder and wing tips. Spinner is segmented in 1/2 RLM 25 and White.

Remarks Notice Yellow fuselage band and rudder.

A/C Type BF-109G-4.
 Pilot & Unit Jan Reznak, Slovakian JG. 52.

Camouflage & Markings RLM 74/75/76 with upper cowling panel RLM 70 and RLM 02 scallops. Yellow fuselage bands and lower wing tips. Black or RLM 70 spinner with rings in Slovakian colors of Red, Blue, and White.

Remarks An ace with 32 victories.

A/C Type BF-109G-6/R6.
 Pilot & Unit Haupt. Alfred Hammer, 6./JG. 53.

Locale & Date Cancelli, Italy, Aug. 1943.

Camouflage & Markings Standard 74/75/76 with Yellow lower cowling and White fuselage band. Black spinner spiraled in White. A/C equipped with underwing gun gondolas.

Remarks Notice patch forward of fuselage cross. Possibly covering an earlier tactical Number.
